

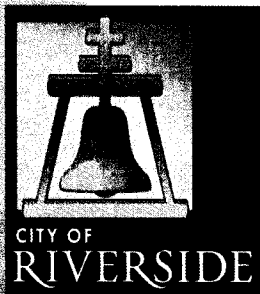

Dear Chairman Buster, Riverside County of Board of Supervisors:

As a Representative who serves a portion of the area in question, I have been following the supervisorial redistricting process and have reviewed the three proposed options before you today. I understand that residents from the Eastside neighborhood wish to remain in the First District and also wish to remain in the same district as the Casa Blanca and Arlanza neighborhoods. I agree that these three distinct neighborhoods should remain in the First District which is why I believe option C is the best alternative before you today.

Option A splits the Arlanza and La Sierra Acres neighborhoods in half and option B splits the Victoria neighborhood. Option C follows long-established Riverside neighborhoods which are clearly delineated by major streets that are easy to understand and follow, which is an important feature to maintaining and producing public trust with our constituents. Thank you for the email and your interest in my opinion. I have reviewed all three proposals and find that "proposal A" would be the proposal that I am selecting. Madam Clerk & Members of the Board,

As representative for the 4th Ward in the City of Riverside, I have been following the recent proposals by both Supervisors Buster and Tavaglione to draw new district lines. Recently a submission has been made by Supervisor Tavaglione that rather baffles and concerns me. His plan is to carve out an "Island" in the form of a shoe, beyond the natural boundary at the 91 freeway at Arlington Ave. By creating such an island within the County district boundary, would split my Ward and Ward 3 in a very awkward manner. In doing so, it will cause great confusion and further desensitizing voters, and in my view, further increasing voter apathy, at a time where we need to increase our electorates confidence in the democratic system. I do not favor this action and would suggest that the members of the Board look at much more cleaner solution and not create any additional voter apathy as mentioned earlier, by drawing such unusual district lines and splitting neighborhoods. In looking at the current district lines and understanding the needs to balance the constituency representation, I would like to recommend considering a plan to simply create clean lines. It would appear that scrapping the plan to move beyond the natural line of the 91 freeway at Arlington Ave, and consider taking the lines from Arlington Ave at the 91 Fwy, West to the Norco city boundary, using Arlington Avenue as a natural district boundary. With such a large thoroughfare, this would seem to be a more obvious choice that will be considerably less impacted to the senses of the voter, allowing the balance that is needed and considerably reducing voter confusion as to representation and again, not splitting any neighborhoods by creating such "Islands" as proposed. Census rolls prove that this will nearly balance the needed take from Supervisor Buster's district and balancing it with District 2 and the remainder of all Supervisory District in Riverside County. Thank you for your consideration and attention to this matter.

Dear John,

I am unable to come to Tuesday's hearing and want to let you know how I feel about an item on your agenda.

It looks like the time has come to readjust our district lines again and I want to give my opinion on the matter. Many years ago my wife Betty served on the planning committee for the entire Temescal canyon under the appointment of Supervisor Walt Abraham. At that time all of us here in El Cerrito were in the 1st District and we came along to you after a census. So I have experience in the matter at hand.

It was brought to my attention that one of the areas being considered on these maps is the Arlanza area of Riverside and that Supervisor Buster would like to divide the community by putting it into two districts all along Arlington Ave. I feel this is a mistake and I urge you to continue your push for Option C on Tuesday.

I looked over the history that was brought to me for Arlanza and it has a lot to be proud of, from Spanish land grants and especially during World War II. And that is where I think we need to take some **county** pride and keep this community whole.

I am a proud veteran of World War II and served at the Battle of the Bulge returning home only after the war's end in 1945. Camp Anza in Arlanza shipped out many of my brother soldiers who gave their lives for our country. I read there were over 20,000 United States soldiers housed there at any one time! And more than 600,000 passed through on their way to the pacific theater. Did you know that the field here in El Cerrito right in front of Liberty St. held a tent city for some of those very same soldiers waiting to pass through camp De Anza?

I think rather than split a community asunder where one neighbor calls you and another neighbor calls Supervisor Buster is just plain nonsense. Instead Supervisor Buster should work with the City of Riverside and call the councilperson for Arlanza so some kind of permanent monument and record can be put up instead of this talk about dividing them because they have a lot to be proud of.

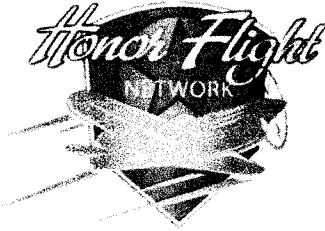

Dear Mr. Altenburger,

I'm delighted to tell you that you have been selected to visit YOUR World War II memorial in Washington DC. You will leave Ontario airport Friday August 19th on Southwest Airlines flight number 3580 at 10:40 AM and you'll arrive at Baltimore Washington International (BWI) at 8:55 PM.

I have already purchased your ticket. And I have reserved a room for you and Butch at the Hilton hotel very close to the BWI airport for Friday and Saturday nights. The hotel is the Hilton Baltimore BWI Airport, 1739 West Nursery Road Linthicum, Maryland 21090 Phone 410 694-0808, Fax 410 691-9092, and the web site is www.baltimoreairport.hilton.com in case anyone wants to contact you.

I have enclosed your ticket and your itinerary. Your confirmation number is **I72W8E**. Please bring your I.D. and confirmation number with you to the airport on Friday morning. When you arrive at the airport please go to the ticket counter to receive your boarding pass. The boarding pass is all you'll need for the flight to BWI.

As a reminder, do not carry any sharp objects, such as a pocket knife or scissors, with you as you must pass through TSA security screening. Also, please bring at least one extra day's medications in case of flight delays or cancellations.

When you arrive at BWI, you will be met by our Official Honor Flight Ground Crew. You will recognize them by their bright neon yellow t-shirts. They will assist you to get to the hotel shuttle.

If you do not see our Ground Crew, please go to the baggage claim area and call the hotel at 410 694-0808 and request the shuttle. The operator will ask you what door number you are close to; the number can be found directly above the exit door.

After you have called for the shuttle, go outside across the first driving lane and wait on the island. The shuttle will say 'Hilton Baltimore BWI Airport' (it is silver with a blue bottom) or it will say 'Aloft' (it is white). It leaves the hotel on the hour and on the half hour. It should show up around 15 minutes later i.e. 10:15 or 10:45, 11:15 or 11:45 etc. I will meet you at the hotel and get you checked into your room.

Once you are checked into your room, and have received your Honor Flight shirt and name tag you are free to do whatever you wish. You will also be given an itinerary of the weekend activities, including the time for a brief informal meeting after dinner.

When you are ready to eat, please wear your Honor Flight shirt to the restaurant. The shirt will identify you as an Honor Flight veteran and guardian. All of your meals will be free when you wear your shirts.

In the morning you are free to visit the breakfast buffet in the hotel, again at no cost.

We will then board the bus at the hotel and your World War II memorable experience will begin!! Be prepared for a very moving day...you will need a clean handkerchief or Kleenex!

We will first drive to Washington DC in our deluxe coach and go to the World War II memorial. Then we will drive to the Lincoln monument, the Korean memorial, and the Viet Nam Wall. We will have an Arby's box lunch after we leave the memorials at a picnic area called Hains Point. Then we will drive to the Navy Memorial and on to Arlington National Cemetery to witness the Changing of the Guard at the Tomb of the Unknowns. From there we will visit the Iwo Jima statue, the Air Force Memorial, and we will stop at a Golden Corral in Hanover Maryland for dinner before we return to the hotel.

After dinner the evening is yours to enjoy. No doubt, many of the folks will be gathering in the lobby, please feel free to come down to share the day's memories with your new friends. You may retire at your leisure.

In the morning you are free to visit the breakfast buffet in the hotel, again at no cost.

Your itinerary provides you with the details of your return flight. The hotel shuttle is available to get you to the airport. Please allow plenty of time to clear security at the airport. Our yellow shirted Ground Crew will meet you at the airport to assist with getting through security.

I sincerely hope (and I'm confident) that you now have at least a hint of how much we at the Honor Flight Network and every other American feel about you and how much you are respected and loved!!


We feel honored and privileged to have had the opportunity to spend time with you and get to know what a true hero you are.

Dear Supervisors,

I object to the inclusion of the City of Menifee (newly incorporated) in Supervisor's Ashley's district for the following reasons:

Menifee has more in common with Temecula, Murrieta, Wildomar and Lake Elsinore (3rd district) than cities to the north on Interstate 215, San Jacinto, Hemet and desert areas.

A conflict of interest is apparent in the Menifee City Council member who is Supervisor Ashley's assistant.

Mt. San Jacinto College proposed plans to split the college district in the future (largest district in the state community college system) so that Menifee Valley campus is part of a new district that includes Temecula, Murrieta, Wildomar and Lake Elsinore, will be complicated by the jurisdictional split between proposed 3rd and 5th districts.

And to that end, future bond measures to assist in financing Mt. San Jacinto College curriculum will confound tax payers approval if Menifee is part of Supervisor's Ashley's 5th district rather than Stone's 3rd district.

Adding the City of Desert Hot Springs (and proposed annexed areas) to Supervisor Benoit's 4th District (as a tradeoff for the City of Menifee) is a disservice to neighboring unincorporated areas of Desert Edge, Sky Valley, Indio Hills and Thousand Palms - north of Interstate 10.

Altogether, this a geopolitical move that has adverse financial and jurisdictional potential to many communities.

Thank you for the maps. It has been my experience in ward 2 that the Eastside and the Canyon Crest area enjoy a unique relation. Many who live in the Canyon Crest area are aware of the needs of the Eastside community and many community organization such as the Rotary and Kiwanis Clubs have been engaged in many events sponsored in the area. Social issues and concerns are often shared by both and often responses are facilitated by myself and staff members. Having both areas in the same district assist and sharing similar public works projects, police patrol, park and recreational facilities, and concerns as UCR continues to grow. I recommend that the areas remain in the same districts.

In looking at the alternative (option B) it would appear to socially isolated the Eastside from both downtown and the rest of the district. They would be divided by the 91 freeway from downtown and separated from the rest of the district which would not appear to be of benefit to the community.

The general goal of the "One Person One Vote Rule" mandated by the Federal and State Constitutions is to produce Districts which shall be as nearly equal in populations as may be, although Federal Court decisions have indicated that a maximum deviation from population equality of less than ten percent between Districts is generally permissible.





California Elections Code § 21500 also requires that the adjustment of Supervisorial District boundaries must comply with the Federal Voting Rights Act as well as give consideration to the following factors: a) topography, b) geography, c) cohesiveness, contiguity, integrity, and compactness of territory, and d) communities of interests of the districts.

Federal Census data released in March 2011, reveal the following population by Supervisorial District: 1st District, 422,327; 2nd District, 407,271; 3rd District, 517,853; 4th District, 396,579; and, 5th District, 445,611. An equal distribution of the County's total population of 2,189,641 would put 437,928 residents in each Supervisorial District.

Per Agenda Item 3.9 on September 28, 2010, the Executive Office created a Redistricting Steering Committee. The Committee is comprised of County Assessor Larry Ward, Assistant CEO Jay Orr, and the chief of staff to each of the five members of the Board of Supervisors. The Committee is supported by staff from the Executive Office, County Counsel, Transportation Land Management Agency (TLMA), Registrar of Voters, and the Economic Development Agency.

Beginning on October 26, 2010, the Committee held a total of fourteen meetings, including three evening public outreach forums. The outreach forums allowed the public who were unable to attend the daytime meetings an opportunity to observe first-hand the progress of the Committee and provide input in-person to the Committee. Moreover, two of the outreach forums were held in outlying communities where it was more convenient for the attendance of members of the public from the Desert and Southwest areas of the County. Input was also provided via email, the redistricting website, the U.S. Postal Service, and in-person at the daytime redistricting meetings held at the County Administrative Center. Additional outreach efforts were conducted through the website, weekly updates by Supervisor Ashley at the Board of Supervisor meetings, and through press releases.

The initial meetings were spent finalizing the work plan, determining which specialized mapping software should be purchased, and discussing the legal criteria governing Supervisorial District boundary changes. The updated census population numbers were received by the County in March 2011. Once the numbers were received and the target population of 437,928 for each district was calculated, the Committee began the task of developing one or more Supervisorial Redistricting Plans that would include new boundary lines.

The Committee decided that each district representative should meet with TLMA:GIS staff and develop individual district maps to present to the entire Committee. Upon the completion of all five individual maps, TLMA:GIS staff was able to combine the individual efforts together into one map which identified areas of agreement and few areas labeled undecided. Draft versions of each individual effort, and the consolidated map, were ultimately presented in the public outreach forums.

After considering public input, the Committee was able to make decisions as to most of the undecided areas. The Committee gave particular emphasis to avoiding the division of cities and other communities of interests throughout the County with the exception of the City of Riverside due to its size and population. Despite the Committee's general consensus from a countywide perspective, the boundary between District 1 and District 2 could not win unanimous approval due primarily to differences as to where the boundary lines are drawn within the City of Riverside. As a result, the Committee decided it was most appropriate to recommend the two attached Supervisorial Redistricting Plan proposals to the Board of Supervisors for its review.

The action today will set a public hearing for June 28, 2011. At least two public hearings are required to be held on any redistricting plan proposal before it can be adopted. The tentative work plan included the dates of July 12, 2011 and July 26, 2011, for additional public hearings. At the conclusion of the last public hearing, the Board of Supervisors may approve a Supervisorial Redistricting Plan. The county surveyor will then prepare a legal description that conforms to the boundaries of the new supervisorial districts referenced in the approved Supervisorial Redistricting Plan. It is anticipated that Survey's legal description task will be completed by the end of August. An implementing ordinance enacting the approved Supervisorial Redistricting Plan must be adopted by the Riverside County Board of Supervisors no later than September 30, 2011 in order for the necessary boundary adjustments to be effective before November 1, 2011 as required by California Elections Code § 21501.

If the Board of Supervisors fails to complete the redistricting process before November 1, 2011 then a redistricting commission composed of the district attorney, the county assessor, and the county superintendent of schools will have until December 30, 2011 to make the adjustment.

The recommended motion today is for the Board of Supervisors to set for future public hearing the two recommended Supervisorial Redistricting Plan proposals; however, the Board is not limited to these proposals and it may consider alternative redistricting plan proposals to be reviewed as part of the public hearing process.

- Guiding principals of redistricting set in state and federal law

Redistricting Process

- County of Riverside Redistricting Steering Committee established by the County Executive Officer
- Committee Membership
 - Larry Ward, Riverside County Assessor/Clerk-Recorder, Chairman
 - Jay Orr, Assistant County Executive Officer, Co-Chairman
 - All five Supervisorial Chiefs of Staff
 - Staff support from County Counsel, Executive Office, Economic Development Agency, Registrar of Voters, and Transportation and Land Management Agency

Redistricting Timeline

- Steering Committee formed during the Fall of 2010
- March 2011 – U.S. Census data was released
- April 2011 – First sets of draft redistricting scenarios prepared by the Steering Committee
- April 2011 – Public input and outreach on April 20 in Riverside at the County Administrative Center; on April 21 in Menifee at the Kay Ceniceros Senior Center; and on April 27 in Desert Hot Springs at the Carl May Building
- May 26, 2011 – Was the last day to submit comments to the Steering Committee for consideration

Redistricting Timeline

- June 14, 2011 – The presentation of redistricting plans to the Riverside County Board of Supervisors
- June 28, 2011 – Tentative first public hearing with the Board of Supervisors
- July 12 and 26, 2011 – Tentative second and third public hearings with the Board of Supervisors
- Supervisorial redistricting plan to be approved by the Board at the conclusion of the last public hearing

Redistricting Timeline

- July/August 2011 – County Surveyor to draft legal description of boundaries for new supervisorial districts
- August/September 2011 – Introduction and subsequent adoption of Riverside County supervisorial redistricting implementing ordinance by the Board of Supervisors
- Redistricting process must be completed prior to November 1, 2011
- To meet the deadline, the plan must be adopted on or before the September 27, 2011 Board meeting

Legal Overview

Preliminary Considerations

- County redistricting process involves the Board of Supervisors making necessary adjustments every 10 years after U.S. Census data is released
- Focus is on the adjustment of Supervisorial District boundary lines
- Not to be confused with California Citizens Redistricting Commission which has jurisdiction over state legislative and federal congressional district adjustments (per Prop. 11, as approved by voters in November 2008; and Prop. 20, as approved by voters in November 2010)

Legal Overview

California Elections Code § 21500

- 1) Districts “shall be as nearly equal in population as may be”
 - One Person One Vote Rule – based on equal protection principles to ensure substantial equality of population among the various districts so that the vote of any citizen is equal in weight. Current Federal Court decisions provide that a maximum deviation from population equality of less than 10% between County districts is generally permissible

Legal Overview

California Elections Code § 21500

- 2) Districts “shall comply with” the Federal Voting Rights Act – 42 U.S.C. § 1973
 - Literally hundreds of cases interpreting the Act which was originally enacted during the 1960s and has been amended several times since by the U.S. Congress. Section 2 of the Act was amended in 1982 to provide for a “results” test where a challenging party does not need to show discriminatory motive or purpose in order to establish a violation

Legal Overview

California Elections Code § 21500

- 3) In establishing District boundaries “the Board may give consideration to the following factors”
- Topography
 - Geography
 - Cohesiveness, Contiguity, Integrity, and Compactness of Territory
 - Community of Interests of the Districts

Legal Overview

Procedural Considerations

- Minimum of two Public Hearings required to be held on any Redistricting Plan proposal before it can be approved
- Implementing Ordinance enacting the approved Redistricting Plan must be adopted by the Board of Supervisors no later than September 30, 2011, in order for the necessary boundary adjustments to be effective before November 1, 2011, as required by California Elections Code § 21501

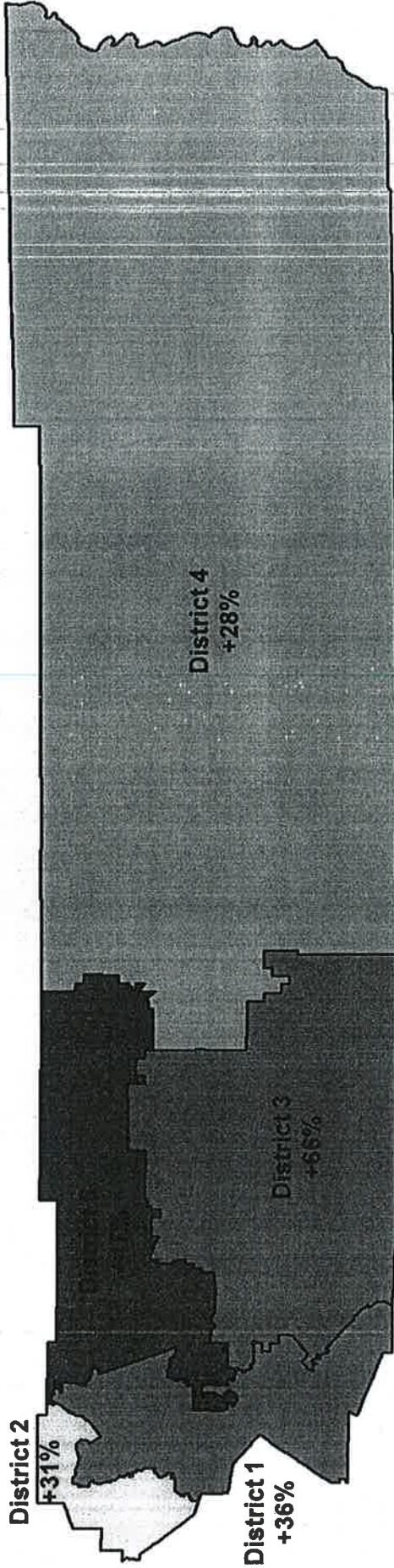
Legal Overview

Procedural Considerations (continued)

- In the event that the Board of Supervisors fails to complete the redistricting process before November 1, 2011, then a supervisory redistricting commission composed of the district attorney, the county assessor, and the county superintendent of schools will have until December 30, 2011 to make any necessary boundary adjustments

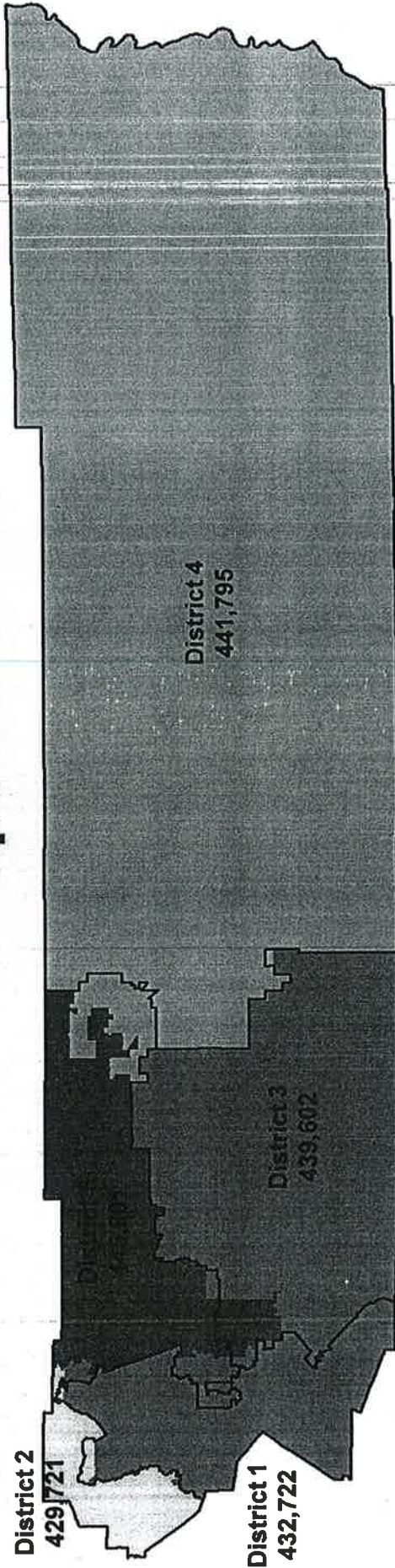

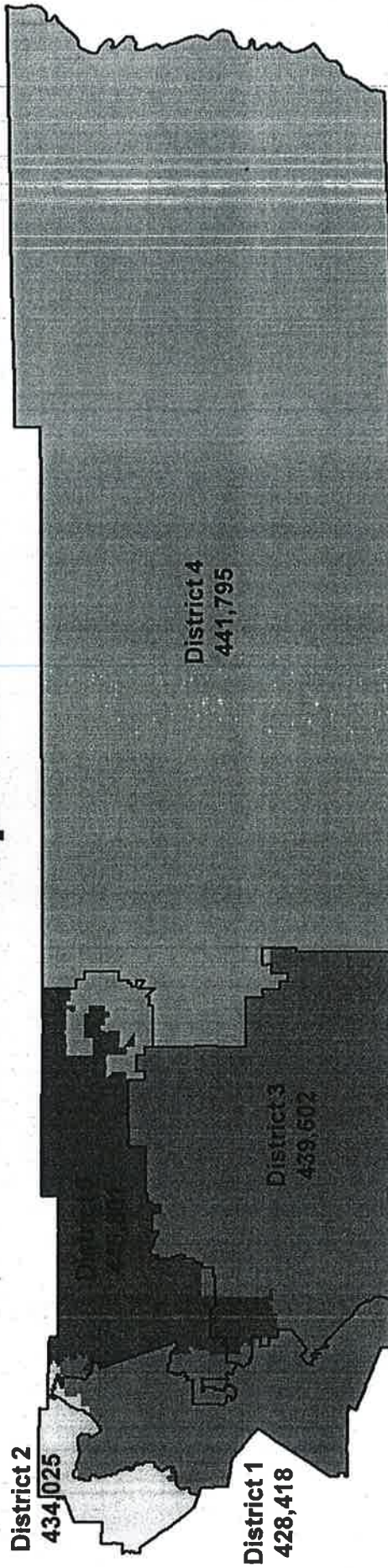

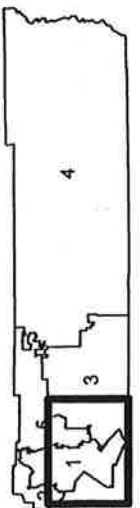

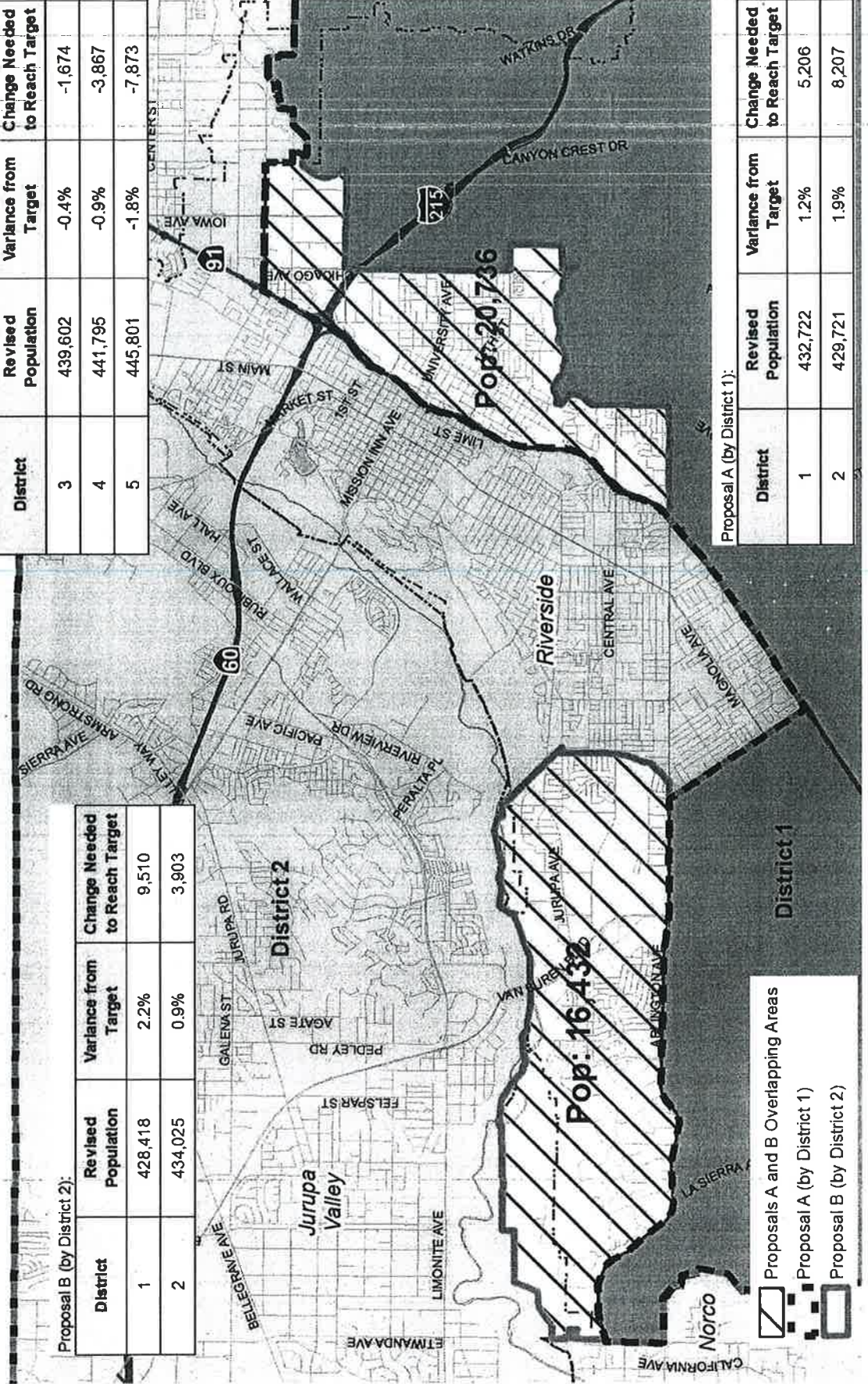

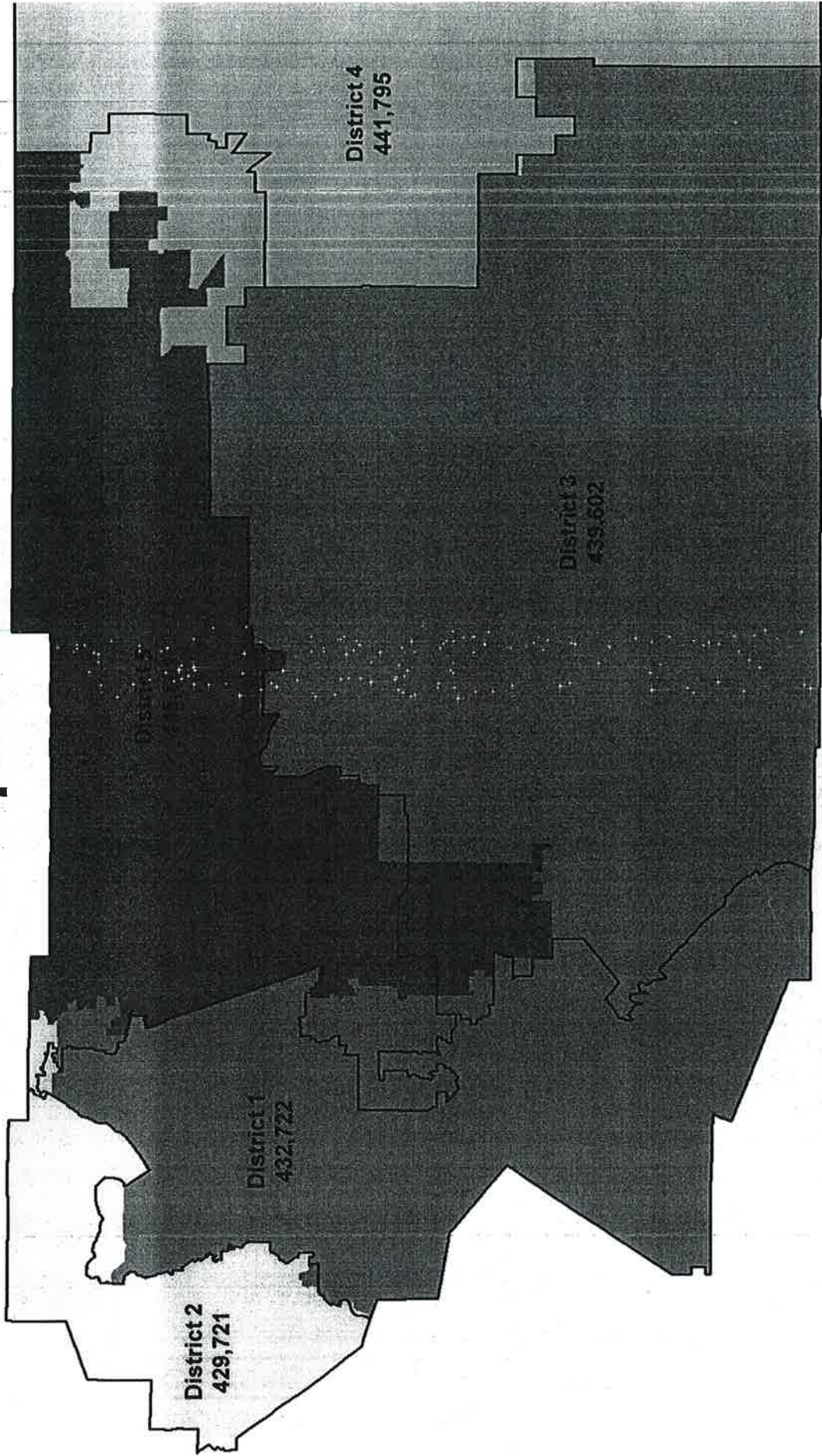

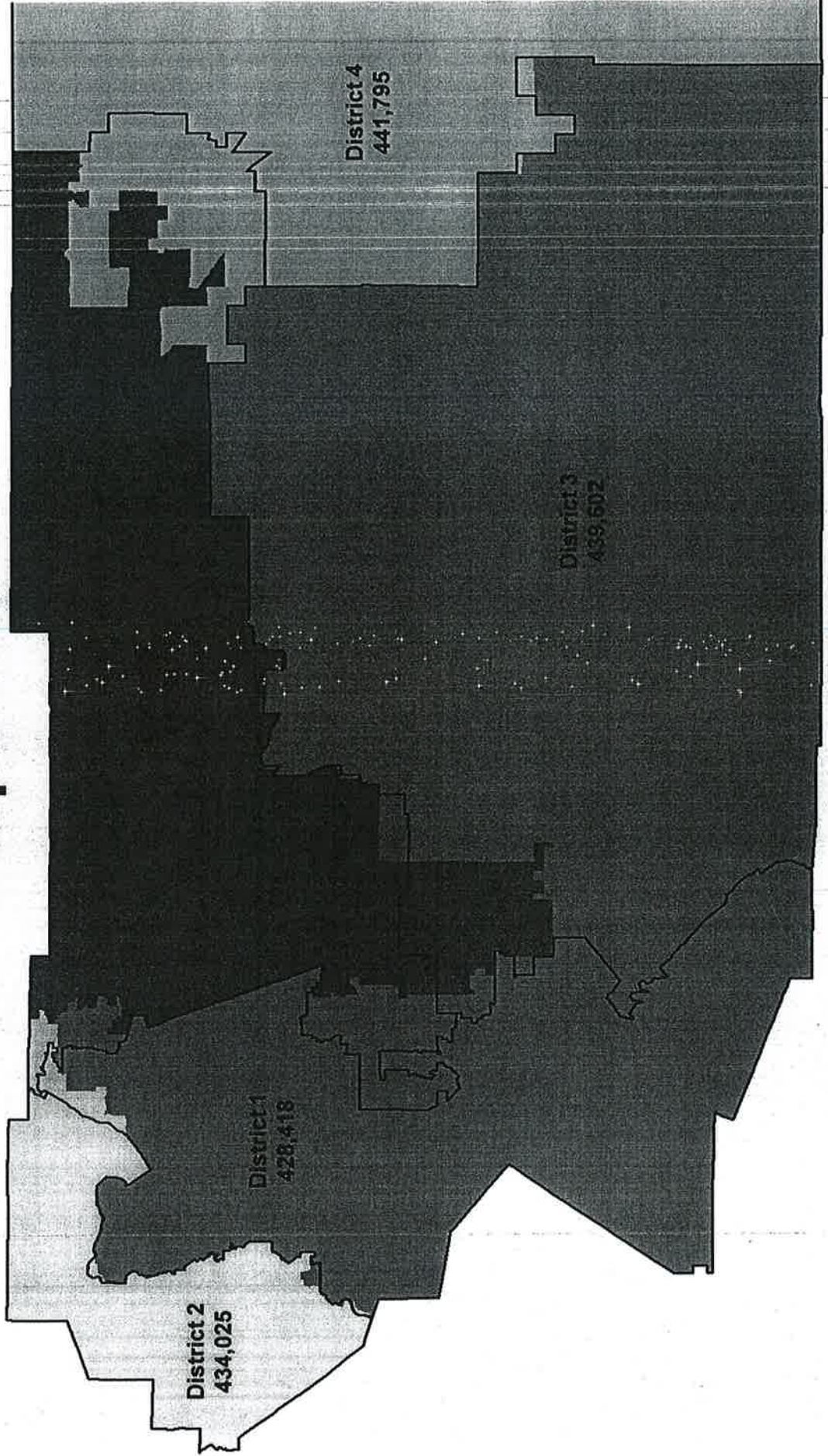
