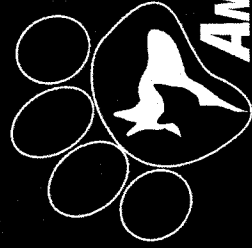

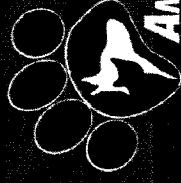

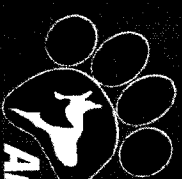

Why establish contract rates by Ordinance?

- Recommendation of Auditor/Controller
- Recommendation of Grand Jury
- Consistency for cities
- Fair & equitable recovery of additional costs incurred by County for providing services to contract jurisdictions

Animal Ordinance 630

Establishing Shelter Contract Rates

- Blythe Shelter - \$76/dog & cat
- CVAC Shelter - \$115/dog & cat
- Western Riverside - \$138/dog & cat

◦ Application of Rates:

- Fixed – based on prior year dog & cat impounds, paid monthly
- Covers sheltering of all, except large animals as currently set by Ordinance 630
- Does not include recovery for spay and neuter clinical costs.
- All Adoption & Impounds, Board & Disposal fees retained by DAS.



Animal Ordinance 630

Impact to Cities

- **Blythe Animal Shelter**
 - Impact to City of Blythe is minimal

- **Coachella Valley Animal Campus**
 - Sheltering Contract expires January 15, 2012
 - Existing Contract did not provide cost recovery
 - Distribution by impounds impacts cities differently
 - Highest impound Cities have highest cost
 - Step-up plan recommended for cities with extreme financial hardship:
Cathedral City, Coachella, Desert Hot Springs

- **Western Riverside County/City Animal Shelter**
 - Cost reduction for City of Riverside
 - Equitable rates for new cities (Eastvale & Jurupa)



Animal Ordinance 630

Establishing Field Services Rates

- **Dedicated, full-time Animal Control Officer:**
\$127,026 fixed annual fee payable monthly
- **Dedicated, half-time Animal Control Officer:**
\$ 63,513 fixed annual fee payable monthly
- **Hourly rate for less than half-time: \$82.00/hr**
7:30 a.m. to 5:00 p.m., M-F, except holidays
- **Hourly overtime rate: \$82.00**
(minimum 2 hour call out)
5:00 p.m. to 7:30 a.m., M-F; 24 hours weekends & holidays



Animal Ordinance 630

Establishing Other Contract Rates

- **Sweep – Flat Rate \$2,460**
 - At request of city – 5 ACOs dedicated to saturate an area for six hours
- **Outreach Event \$2,553**
 - Team of three staff & volunteers at a location in the contract city for nine hours (including animal transport)
- One outreach per 1600 impounds provided at no cost to contracting jurisdiction.

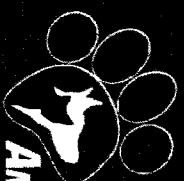

BACKGROUND CONT'D:

Heretofore, standard fees have not been established by ordinance. In keeping with the recommendation of the Auditor-Controller the Department proposes to set established rates in the fee schedule that properly recover the costs associated with Field Services, Sheltering and related services provided to contracted cities.

The proposed fees were developed through a cost analysis performed by the Community Health Agency Fiscal Team, the Department of Animal Services and with assistance and advice from the County Executive Office. Fees have been reviewed by the Auditor-Controller's office and recommended for consideration.

Fees are based on actual departmental expenditures and budgeted staffing levels during the study period, Fiscal Year 09/10. The cost information provided the basis to isolate costs incurred to provide services to contract cities. The resulting fees allow for full and reasonable recovery of those costs.

The amendment to this Ordinance contains fee additions, as outlined in Exhibit "A."

Per Board of Supervisors Policy A-67, the Board issued an initiation order on April 5, 2011 as part of BOS Agenda Item No. 3.4 authorizing the Department to prepare and process the Amendment to RCO No. 630 that is currently under consideration as part of this Form 11.

FINANCIAL DATA:

The approval of this Ordinance Amendment will result in no cost to the County and no budget adjustment is required. City contracts will be brought to the Board of Supervisors for approval with recommendations for reduced contract amounts to allow cities to step up to new contract fees where impact is significant. Department has budgeted for this contingency and no budget adjustment is required.

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE COUNTY OF RIVERSIDE
AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 630.14 RELATING TO DOGS AND CATS**

The Board of Supervisors of the County of Riverside ordains as follows:

Section 1.

A new subsection u. is added to Section 11. of Ordinance No. 630 to read as follows:

- "u. The Director shall charge and collect from any contracted city the County's standard field and sheltering rates for services provided, as set forth below. In addition, the Director shall charge and collect from any contracted city the County's standard community outreach event and enforcement sweep rates for services provided and other related fees, as set forth below. Provided however that, upon a showing of extreme financial hardship by a city currently under contract with the County as of September 15, 2011 as to the impact of the standard rates and fees herein upon the cost of existing services, the Director may negotiate a service contract containing reduced contract rates and fees with such contract subject to the approval of the Riverside County Board of Supervisors. The standard rates and fees shall be as follows:
- (1) An annual contract rate of \$127,026.00 for one (1) Full-Time Animal Control Officer (ACO) working for a total of 2,080 hours annually during regular shifts between the hours of 7:30 a.m. – 5:00 p.m. less County Holidays;
 - (2) An annual contract rate of \$63,513.00 for one (1) Half-Time Animal Control Officer (ACO) working for a total of 1,040 hours annually during regular shifts between the hours of 7:30 a.m.- 5:00 p.m. less County Holidays;
 - (3) A contract hourly rate of \$82.00 per hour for an Animal Control Officer (ACO) with a 2 hour minimum charge per service call;
 - (4) A contract overtime hourly rate of \$82.00 per hour for an Animal Control Officer (ACO) with a 2 hour minimum charge per service call;
 - (5) Where a contract for service provides for six or more officers, an annual contract rate of \$127,026.00 for one (1) dedicated Full-Time Sergeant of Field Services working for a total of 2,080 hours annually during regular shifts between the hours of 7:30 a.m. – 5:00 p.m. less County Holidays;
 - (6) An annual contract rate of \$89,315.00 for one (1) Full-Time License Inspector working for a total of 2,080 hours annually during regular shifts between the hours of 7:30 a.m. – 5:00 p.m. less County Holidays;

 - (9) An annual sheltering contract rate of \$76.00 multiplied by total number of impounded dogs and cats for the most recent prior fiscal year ("FY") for Blythe Shelter;

- (10) An annual sheltering contract rate of \$115.00 multiplied by total number of impounded dogs and cats for the most recent prior FY for Coachella Valley Animal Campus Shelter.
- (11) An annual sheltering contract rate of \$138.00 multiplied by total number of impounded dogs and cats for the most recent prior FY for Riverside Shelter.

Section 2. This Ordinance shall take effect thirty (30) days after its adoption.

Any person affected by the above matter(s) may submit written comments to the Clerk of the Board before the hearing or may appear and be heard in support or opposition to the project at the time of the hearing. If you challenge the above item(s) in court, you may be limited to raising only those issues you or someone else raised at the public hearing described in this notice, or in written correspondence, to the Board of Supervisors at, or prior to, the public hearing.

ORDINANCE NO. 630.15

**AN ORDINANCE OF
THE COUNTY OF RIVERSIDE AMEND-
ING ORDINANCE NO. 630.14 RELATING
TO DOGS AND CATS**

The Board of Supervisors of the County of Riverside ordains as follows:

Section 1. A new subsection u. is added to Section 11. of Ordinance No. 630 to read as follows:
"u. The Director shall charge and collect from any contracted city the County's standard field and sheltering rates for services provided, as set forth below. In addition, the Director shall charge and collect from any contracted city the County's standard community outreach event and enforcement sweep rates for services provided and other related fees, as set forth below. Provided however that, upon a showing of extreme financial hardship by a city currently under contract with the County as of September 15, 2011 as to the impact of the standard rates and fees herein upon the cost of existing services, the Director may negotiate a service contract containing reduced contract rates and fees with such contract subject to the approval of the Riverside County Board of Supervisors. The standard rates and fees shall be as follows:

- (1) An annual contract rate of \$127,026.00 for one (1) Full-Time Animal Control Officer (ACO) working for a total of 2,080 hours annually during regular shifts between the hours of 7:30 a.m. - 5:00 p.m. less County Holidays;
- (2) An annual contract rate of \$63,513.00 for one (1) Half-Time Animal Control Officer (ACO) working for a total of 1,040 hours annually during regular shifts between the hours of 7:30 a.m. - 5:00 p.m. less County Holidays;
- (3) A contract hourly rate of \$82.00 per hour for an Animal Control Officer (ACO) with a 2 hour minimum charge per service call;
- (4) A contract overtime hourly rate of \$82.00 per hour for an Animal Control Officer (ACO) with a 2 hour minimum charge per service call;
- (5) Where a contract for service provides for six or more officers, an annual contract rate of \$127,026.00 for one (1) dedicated Full-Time Sergeant of Field Services working for a total of 2,080 hours annually during regular shifts between the hours of 7:30 a.m. - 5:00 p.m. less County Holidays;
- (6) An annual contract rate of \$89,315.00 for one (1) Full-Time License Inspector working for a total of 2,080 hours annually during regular shifts between the hours of 7:30 a.m. - 5:00 p.m. less County Holidays;
- (7) A contract fee of \$2,460.00 for an enforcement sweep - six (6) hour day;
- (8) A contract fee of \$2,553.00 per community outreach event - full day of service (9 hours), provided however that one (1) outreach event may be included at no charge to a contracting city for each increment of one thousand six hundred (1,600) impounded dogs and cats that are projected for any fiscal year ("FY") covered by the contract;
- (9) An annual sheltering contract rate of \$76.00 multiplied by total number of impounded dogs and cats for the most recent prior fiscal year ("FY") for Biythe Shelter;
- (10) An annual sheltering contract rate of \$115.00 multiplied by total number of impounded dogs and cats for the most recent prior FY for Coachella Valley Animal Campus Shelter;
- (11) An annual sheltering contract rate of \$138.00 multiplied by total number of impounded dogs and cats for the most recent prior FY for Riverside Shelter.

Section 2. This Ordinance shall take effect thirty (30) days after its adoption.
