SUBJECT: Introduction and Adoption of Ordinance No. 911 Establishing Boundaries of Supervisorial Districts

RECOMMENDED MOTION: That Ordinance No. 911 Establishing the Boundaries of Supervisorial Districts be introduced and adopted in successive weeks.

BACKGROUND: On August 16, 2011, after receiving testimony at four public hearing sessions, the Board of Supervisors approved without amendment Supervisorial Redistricting Plan Proposal A adjusting supervisorial district boundaries which had been prepared and recommended by the 2011 Riverside County Redistricting Steering Committee and also directed staff to prepare an implementing ordinance. Such action was taken pursuant to and in compliance with the legal requirements set forth in California Elections Code §§ 21500 et seq. The Board is being asked today to introduce and adopt on successive weeks Ordinance No. 911, which will implement the adjusted supervisorial district boundaries described in Supervisorial Redistricting Plan Proposal A that was approved by the Board on August 16, 2011.

The Board's adoption of Ordinance No. 911 by no later than its regular meeting session of September 27, 2011 will ensure compliance with California Elections Code § 21501 which requires the boundaries to be adjusted prior to November 1, 2011.

Although the supervisory district boundary changes are considered adjusted once a plan proposal has been approved and the necessary implementing ordinance has been adopted, they do not go into effect immediately. California Elections Code § 21506 states in pertinent part:

"The term of office of any supervisor who has been elected and whose term of office has not expired shall not be affected by any change in the boundaries of the district from which he or she was elected.

At the first election for county supervisors in each county following adjustment of the boundaries of supervisory districts, a supervisor shall be elected for each district under the readjusted district plan that has the same district number as a district whose incumbent's term is to expire."

Given the above, the boundary adjustments to District 1 and District 3 will not take effect until the election that is held in 2012 (for elected supervisor taking office in January 2013), and District 2, District 4, and District 5 will not take effect until the election that is held in 2014 (for elected supervisor taking office in January 2015). As a result, voters during the elections held in 2012 and 2014 will vote according to the new adjusted boundary lines. For example, the residents in the City of Canyon Lake will vote in 2012 for a supervisor in District 1, although they will not be represented by the 1st District Supervisor until such elected official takes office in January 2013.

The ordinance has been reviewed and approved as to form by County Counsel.

SUMMARY OF PROPOSED ORDINANCE NO. 911

AN ORDINANCE OF THE COUNTY OF RIVERSIDE ESTABLISHING BOUNDARIES OF SUPERVISORIAL DISTRICTS OF SAID COUNTY

This summary is presented pursuant to California Government Code Section 25124(b); a certified copy of the full text of Ordinance No. 911 may be examined at the Office of the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors of the County of Riverside located at 4080 Lemon Street, 1st Floor, Riverside, California.

Ordinance No. 911 establishes the newly adjusted boundaries of the supervisorial district boundaries consistent with those boundaries described in Supervisorial Redistricting Plan Proposal A that was approved by the Board of Supervisors on August 16, 2011 after receiving testimony at four public hearing sessions. Such action was taken pursuant to and in compliance with the legal requirements set forth in California Elections Code Sections 21500 et seq.

Ordinance No. 911 specifically does each of the following:

Provides for specifically described boundaries of each of the five (5) supervisorial districts located in the territory of the County of Riverside as indicated in the included legal descriptions pertaining to each district.

Includes findings by the Board of Supervisors that the supervisorial district boundaries have been adjusted on the basis of the 2010 decennial federal census, that such boundaries have been adjusted so that the districts are nearly equal in population as may be, that the districts comply with the legal requirements contained in California Election Code Section 21500 and Title 42 United States Code Section 1973.

Repeals Riverside County Ordinance No 813 containing the previous set of supervisorial district boundaries which were based on the 2000 decennial federal census.
