**SUBJECT:** Acceptance of a Grant Award from Boston University Medical Campus for Study of Attitudes and Factors Affecting Infant Care

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**BACKGROUND:**

Boston University Medical Campus is the prime recipient and RCRMC is the sub grantee that will administer the project. RCRMC will be participating in a study of attitudes and factors affecting infant care.
