

ORDINANCE NO. 452.230

AN ORDINANCE OF THE COUNTY OF RIVERSIDE
AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 452
RELATING TO PRIMA FACIE SPEED LIMITS

The Board of Supervisors of the County of Riverside ordains as follows:

Section 1. Section 2.2 of Ordinance No. 452, entitled "Thirty miles per hour," is amended to add new subsection 21 thereto to read as follows:

"21. On Vista Del Valle between the centerline of Crest Drive and a point 2,560 feet south of Vermont Street, a total distance of approximately 1.00 mile, in the Hemet area."

Section 2. Section 2.3 of Ordinance No. 452, entitled "Thirty-five miles per hour," is amended to add new subsection 107 thereto to read as follows:

"107. On Acacia Avenue between a point 230 feet east of San Jacinto Street and the centerline of Cornell Street, a total distance of approximately 0.9 miles, in the Hemet area."

Section 3. Section 2.4 of Ordinance No. 452, entitled "Forty miles per hour," is amended to add new subsections 125, 126, 127, 128, and 129 thereto to read as follows:

"125. On Calle Contento between the centerline of Rancho California Road and the centerline of Vista Del Monte Road, a total distance of approximately 1.07 miles, in the Temecula area."

146. On the southerly half full width of Camino Campanero between the centerline of Avenida Descanso and the centerline of Bubbling Wells Road, a total distance of approximately 0.74 miles, in the Desert Hot Springs area."

147. On Clark Street between the centerline of Rider Street and the centerline of Nandina Avenue, a total distance of approximately 2.5 miles, in the Perris area."

148. On Jurupa Road between the centerline of Valley Way and the centerline of Mission Boulevard, a total distance of approximately 0.4 miles, in the Glen Avon area."

149. On San Jacinto Avenue between the centerline of Marshall Street and the centerline of Lukens Lane, a total distance of approximately 1.00 mile, in the Perris area."

Section 4. Section 2.5 of Ordinance No. 452, entitled "Forty-five miles per hour," is amended to add new subsections 150 and 151 thereto to read as follows:

"150. On Crestmore Road between a point 915 feet west of Jurupa Park entrance to the centerline of Capary Road, a total distance of approximately 1.15 miles, in the Rubidoux area."

151. On Pauba Road between the centerline of Anza Road and the centerline of Deportola Road, a total distance of approximately 1.86 miles, in the Temecula area."

Section 5. Section 2.7 of Ordinance No. 452, entitled "Fifty-five miles per hour," is amended to add new subsection 26 thereto to read as follows:

"26. On Washington Street between the centerline of 38th Street and the centerline of Coyote Song Way, a total distance of approximately 1.75 miles, in the Palm Desert area."

Section 6. Subsection 78 of Section 2.3 of Ordinance No. 452 adopted on March 29, 2005, pursuant to Ordinance No. 452.220 is repealed in its entirety. Subsection 78 of Section 2.3 established a thirty-five miles per hour speed limit on Jurupa Road between Valley Way and Mission Boulevard.

Subsection 91 of Section 2.3 of Ordinance No. 452 adopted on June 2, 2009, pursuant to Ordinance No. 452.225 is repealed in its entirety. Subsection 91 of Section 2.3 established a thirty-five miles per hour speed limit on Acacia Avenue between the City of Hemet city limits and the centerline of Cornell Street.

Subsection 50 of Section 2.5 of Ordinance No. 452 adopted on February 4, 2003, pursuant to Ordinance No. 452.214 is repealed in its entirety. Subsection 50 of Section 2.5 established a forty-five miles per hour speed limit on Clark Street between the centerline of Rider Street and the centerline of Nandina Avenue.

Subsection 52 of Section 2.5 of Ordinance No. 452 adopted on February 4, 2003, pursuant to Ordinance No. 452.214 is repealed in its entirety. Subsection 52 of Section 2.5 established a forty-five miles per hour speed limit on San Jacinto Avenue between the centerline of Marshall Street and the centerline of Lukens Lane.

Section 7. This ordinance shall take effect 30 days after its adoption.

SUMMARY OF ORDINANCE NO. 875.1 AN ORDINANCE OF THE COUNTY OF RIVERSIDE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 875 ESTABLISHING A LOCAL DEVELOPMENT MITIGATION FEE FOR FUNDING THE PRESERVATION OF NATURAL ECOSYSTEMS IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE COACHELLA VALLEY MULTIPLE SPECIES HABITAT CONSERVATION PLAN

This summary is presented pursuant to California Government Code Section 25124(b): a certified copy of the full text of Ordinance No. 875.1 may be examined at the Office of the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors of the County of Riverside, located at 4080 Lemon Street, 1st Floor, Riverside, California.

Ordinance No. 875.1 amends Ordinance No. 875 to reduce the Local Development Mitigation Fee (LDMF) for funding the preservation of natural ecosystems in accordance with the requirements of the Coachella Valley Multiple Species Habitat Conservation Plan. Additionally, this amendment revises Ordinance No. 875 to allow the LDMF collected to be used for management and monitoring; includes a new LDMF boundary exhibit; changes the guest dwelling exemption to a guest quarter exemption; incorporates revisions to the fee credit provisions of the ordinance; and corrects minor typographical errors.

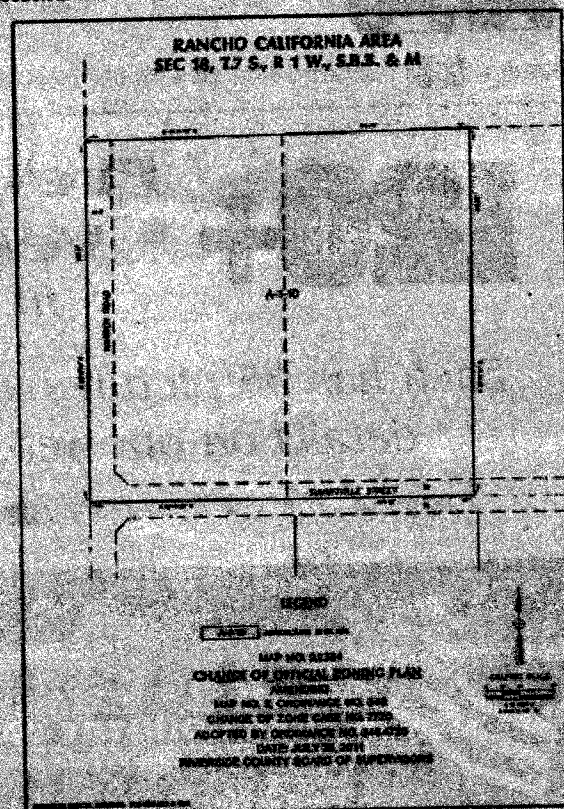
