SUBJECT: Clean Money Youth-Based Fundraising Program

RECOMMENDED MOTION: That the Board of Supervisors receive and file the transfer of the Clean Money Youth-Based Fundraising program to the Economic Development Agency.

BACKGROUND: On March 1, 2011, the Board approved the extension of the Clean Money to the current fiscal year starting July 1, 2011, through a collaborative effort between Code Enforcement and Waste Management. However, the specific Code Enforcement program and staff that administered the Clean Money Program were transferred to the Economic Development Agency on July 14, 2011. Consequently, EDA will continue to operate the Clean Money Program and its associated activities.
