ORDINANCE NO. 911
AN ORDINANCE OF THE COUNTY OF RIVERSIDE
ESTABLISHING BOUNDARIES OF SUPERVISORIAL DISTRICTS OF SAID COUNTY

The Board of Supervisors of the County of Riverside Ordains as Follows:

Section 1. **SUPERVISORIAL DISTRICT NO. 1** shall consist of territory in the County of Riverside included within the following described boundaries:

1. Beginning at the West one-quarter corner of Section 16, T2S, R4W, SBM;
2. Thence East along the West-East center Section lines of Sections 16 and 15 to a point of intersection with the centerline of Pigeon Pass Road;
3. Thence Southeasterly along the centerline of Pigeon Pass Rd. to a point of intersection with the Northerly city boundary line of the City of Moreno Valley as it exists today;
4. Thence Southeasterly, Westerly, Southerly, Westerly, and Southerly along the city boundary line of the City of Moreno Valley to a point 119.25 feet southerly of, as measured along the West line of Section 3, T3S, R4W, from the Northwest corner of said Section 3 also being the Northeasterly point common to the City of Moreno Valley and the City of Riverside as it exists today;
5. Thence Southeasterly, Southerly, Westerly, and Southerly along said city boundary of the City of Riverside as it exists today to the Southeasterly point common to the City of Riverside and the City of Moreno Valley as it exists today said point being the intersection of the centerline of Alessandro Boulevard with the Westerly right of way line of Old 215 Frontage Road;
6. Thence Southeasterly along the Westerly right of way line of Old 215 Frontage Road also being the Westerly city boundary line of the City of Moreno Valley to a point of intersection with the centerline of Cactus Avenue;
7. Thence Westerly along the centerline of Cactus Avenue to a point of intersection with the centerline of Interstate 215;
8. Thence Southerly along the centerline of Interstate 215 to a point of intersection with the

centerline of Van Buren Boulevard;

9. Thence Easterly along the centerline of Van Buren Boulevard to a point of intersection with the Easterly right of way line of Interstate 215;

10. Thence Southeasterly along said Easterly right of way line of Interstate 215 to a point of intersection with the Northerly city boundary line of the City of Perris;

11. Thence southeasterly along Westerly city boundary line of the City of Perris to a point of intersection with the centerline of Nuevo Road, also being the South line of Section 19, T4S, R3W;

12. Thence West along said South line of Section 19 and the South line of Section 24, T4S, R3W, also being the centerline of Nuevo Road to the Southeast corner of the Southwest one-quarter of the Southeast one-quarter of Section 24, T4S, R4W;

13. Thence North to the Northeast corner of the Southwest one-quarter of the Southeast one-quarter of said Section 24;

14. Thence West to the Northwest corner of the Southwest one-quarter of the Southeast one-quarter of said Section 24;

15. Thence North to the Center one-quarter corner of said Section 24;

16. Thence West to the West one-quarter corner of said Section 24, said corner being an angle point in the Westerly boundary line of the City of Perris as it exists today;

17. Thence Southerly along the Westerly city boundary line of the City of Perris as it exists today to the Northwest corner of Section 25, T5S, R4W, said corner being the point common to the City of Canyon Lake, the City of Menifee, and the City of Perris as it exists today;

18. Thence Southerly, Easterly, and Southerly along the boundary line common to the City of Canyon Lake and the City of Menifee to the Southwest corner of Section 6, T6S, R3W, said corner being the point common to the City of Lake Elsinore, the City of Menifee, and the City of Canyon Lake as it exists today;

19. Thence Easterly and Southerly along the boundary line common to the City of Lake Elsinore and the City of Menifee as it exists today to the Southwest corner of Section 8,

1 T6S, R3W, said corner being the point common to the City of Wildomar, the City of
2 Menifee, and the City of Lake Elsinore;

3 20. Thence Southerly, Easterly and Southerly along the city boundary line of the City of
4 Wildomar as it exists today to the Southwest corner of Section 28, T6S, R3W being the
5 Northwesterly point common to the City of Murrieta and the City of Wildomar;

6 21. Thence Southerly, Southwesterly, Northwesterly, Southwesterly and Southeasterly
7 along the city boundary line of the City of Murrieta as it exists today to the intersection of
8 the centerline of Cherry Street with the boundary line of Rancho Temecula being the
9 southwesterly point common to the City of Temecula and the City of Murrieta;

10 22. Thence Southeasterly, Southwesterly, Southerly, Easterly, Southerly, Westerly and
11 Southerly along the city boundary of the City of Temecula as it exists today to a point of
12 intersection with the Southerly boundary of the County of Riverside;

13 23. Thence Westerly and Northerly along the Southerly and Westerly boundary of the
14 County of Riverside to a point of intersection with the centerline of Bedford Canyon Road;

15 24. Thence Northeasterly along said centerline to a point of intersection with the Westerly
16 boundary line of Tract 30241 as shown by map on file in Book 410, Pages 27 through 30,
17 inclusive, of Maps, records of the Recorder of Riverside County, California;

18 25. Thence Northerly along said Westerly boundary line of Tract 30241 to the North line of
19 Section 29, T4S, R6W also being a point on the Southerly city boundary line of the City of
20 Corona as it exists today;

21 26. Thence Easterly, Northerly, Easterly, Southerly, Easterly and Northerly along said city
22 boundary of the City of Corona to a point of intersection with the West line of Section 15,
23 T4S, R6W;

24 27. Thence Northerly along the West lines of Sections 15 and 10, T4S, R6W, to a point of
25 intersection with the city boundary of the City of Corona;

26 28. Thence Easterly and Northerly along said city boundary of the City of Corona to a point
27 of intersection with the North line of Section 34, T3S, R6W;

28 29. Thence West along said North line, also being the Northerly city boundary of the City

1 of Corona to the Southwest corner of Parcel 2 as shown by Map on file in Book 103, Pages
2 1 through 5, inclusive, of Parcel Maps, records of the Recorder of Riverside County,
3 California;

4 30. Thence Northerly along the Westerly lines of Parcels 1 and 2 of said Parcel Map to a
5 point of intersection with the centerline of Indiana Avenue;

6 31. Thence Southwesterly along said centerline of Indiana Avenue to a point of intersection
7 with the Westerly city boundary line of the City of Riverside;

8 32. Thence Northerly along said Westerly city boundary of the City of Riverside as it exists
9 today, through all its various courses to a point of intersection with the centerline of
10 Arlington Avenue;

11 33. Thence Easterly along said centerline of Arlington Avenue to a point of intersection
12 with the centerline of Adams Street;

13 34. Thence Southeasterly along said centerline of Adams Street to a point of intersection
14 with the centerline of State Highway 91;

15 35. Thence Northeasterly along said centerline of State Highway 91 and the centerline of
16 Interstate 215 to a point of intersection with the centerline of Columbia Avenue;

17 36. Thence Easterly along the centerline of Columbia Avenue to a point of intersection with
18 the centerline of Northgate Street;

19 37. Thence Southerly along the centerline of Northgate Street to a point of intersection with
20 the centerline of Marlborough Avenue;

21 38. Thence Easterly along the centerline of Marlborough Avenue to a point of intersection
22 with the centerline of Gage Canal;

23 39. Thence Southwesterly along the centerline of Gage Canal to a point of intersection with
24 the city boundary line of the City of Riverside;

25 40. Thence Northeasterly and Southerly along the city boundary line of the City of
26 Riverside to the Point of Beginning.

1 **Section 2.** **SUPERVISORIAL DISTRICT NO. 2** shall consist of territory in the County of
2 Riverside included within the following described boundaries:

- 3 1. Beginning at the point of intersection of the Westerly boundary of the County of
4 Riverside and the centerline of Bedford Canyon Road;
- 5 2. Thence Northeasterly along said centerline to a point of intersection with Westerly
6 boundary line of Tract 30241 as shown by map on file in Book 410, Pages 27 through 30,
7 inclusive, of Maps, records of the Recorder of Riverside County, California;
- 8 3. Thence Northerly along said Westerly boundary line of Tract 30241 to the North line of
9 Section 29, T4S, R6W, SBM. also being a point on the Southerly city boundary line of the
10 City of Corona as it exists today;
- 11 4. Thence Easterly, Northerly, Easterly, Southerly, Easterly and Northerly along said city
12 boundary of the City of Corona to a point of intersection with the West line of Section 15,
13 T4S, R6W;
- 14 5. Thence Northerly along the West lines of Sections 15 and 10, T4S, R6W, to a point of
15 intersection with the city boundary of the City of Corona;
- 16 6. Thence Easterly and Northerly along said city boundary of the City of Corona to a point
17 of intersection with the North line of Section 34, T3S, R6W;
- 18 7. Thence West along said North line, also being the Northerly city boundary of the City of
19 Corona to the Southwest corner of Parcel 2 as shown by Map on file in Book 103, Pages 1
20 through 5, inclusive, of Parcel Maps, records of the Recorder of Riverside County,
21 California;
- 22 8. Thence Northerly along the Westerly lines of Parcels 1 and 2 of said Parcel Map to a
23 point of intersection with the centerline of Indiana Avenue;
- 24 9. Thence Southwesterly along said centerline of Indiana Avenue to a point of intersection
25 with the Westerly city boundary line of the City of Riverside;
- 26 10. Thence Northerly along said Westerly city boundary of the City of Riverside as it exists
27 today, through all it various courses to a point of intersection with the centerline of
28 Arlington Avenue;

11. Thence Easterly along said centerline of Arlington Avenue to a point of intersection with the centerline of Adams Street;
12. Thence Southeasterly along said centerline of Adams Street to a point of intersection with the centerline of State Highway 91;
13. Thence Northeasterly along said centerline of State Highway 91 and the centerline of Interstate 215 to a point of intersection with the centerline of Columbia Avenue;
14. Thence Easterly along the centerline of Columbia Avenue to a point of intersection with the centerline of Northgate Street;
15. Thence Southerly along the centerline of Northgate Street to a point of intersection with the centerline of Marlborough Avenue;
16. Thence Easterly along the centerline of Marlborough Avenue to a point of intersection with the centerline of Gage Canal;
17. Thence Southwesterly along the centerline of Gage Canal to a point of intersection with the city boundary line of the City of Riverside;
18. Thence Northeasterly and Southerly along the city boundary line of the City of Riverside to the West one-quarter corner of Section 16, T2S, R4W;
19. Thence East along the West-East center Section lines of Sections 16 and 15 to a point of intersection with the centerline of Pigeon Pass Road;
20. Thence Northwesterly along the centerline of Pigeon Pass Road to a point of intersection with the South line of Section 10, T2S, R4W;
21. Thence East along the South line of said Section 10 to the Southeast corner of said Section 10;
22. Thence North along the East line of said Section 10 to a point of intersection with the centerline of Center Street;
23. Thence Northwesterly along the centerline of Center Street to a point of intersection with the centerline of Pope Kirolos Avenue;
24. Thence Northerly along the centerline of Pope Kirolos Avenue to a point of intersection with the North boundary line of the County of Riverside;

25. Thence Westerly, Northerly, Westerly, Southwesterly and Southeasterly along said boundary of the County of Riverside to the Point of Beginning.

Section 3. **SUPERVISORIAL DISTRICT NO. 3** shall consist of territory in the County of Riverside included within the following described boundaries:

4. Thence North along the West line of said Section 28 to the Southwest corner of Section 21, T6S, R3W, said corner being a point on the southerly city boundary line of the City of Menifee as it exists today;
5. Thence Easterly and Northerly along the boundary line of the City of Menifee to the Northwest corner of Section 7, T5S, R2W, SBM, said corner also being the Northeasterly corner of said city boundary;
6. Thence East along section lines to the Southeast corner of Section 3, T5S, R2W;
7. Thence North along the East line of said Section 3 to a point of intersection with the South line of Section 35, T4S, R2W;
8. Thence East along said South line to the South one-quarter corner of said Section 35;
9. Thence North along the North-South center Section line of said Section 35 to the North one-quarter corner of said Section 35;
10. Thence East along the North line of said Section 35 to the Southeast corner of Section 26, T4S, R2W;

11. Thence North along the East line of said Section 26 to a point of intersection with the Westerly boundary of the City of San Jacinto as it exists today;
12. Thence Northerly, Northwesterly, Northerly and Southeasterly along said boundary of the City of San Jacinto to a point of intersection with the West line of Section 12, T4S, R2W;
13. Thence North along said West line of Section 12 to a point of intersection with the Southwesterly line of the San Jacinto River;
14. Thence Southeasterly along said Southwesterly line of the San Jacinto River to a point of intersection with the centerline of Sanderson Avenue (State Highway 79);
15. Thence Northerly along said centerline of Sanderson Avenue (State Highway 79) to a point of intersection with the North line of Section 8, T4S, R1W;
16. Thence East along the North line of said Section 8 to the Southwest corner of Section 4, T4S, R1W;
17. Thence North along the West line of said Section 4 to a point of intersection with the Westerly city boundary of the City of Beaumont as it exists today;
18. Thence Easterly, Southerly, Easterly and Northerly along said city boundary of the City of Beaumont to a point of intersection with the South line of Section 31, T3S, R1E;
19. Thence East along the Township line to the Southeast corner of Section 36, T3S, R1E;
20. Thence North along the Range line to the Northwest corner of Section 30, T3S, R2E;
21. Thence East along Section Lines to the Northeast corner of Section 25, T3S, R2E;
22. Thence North along the Range line to the Northwest corner of Section 30, T3S, R3E;
23. Thence East along Section lines to the Northeast corner of Section 29, T3S, R3E;
24. Thence South along Section lines to the Southwest corner of Section 33, T3S, R3E;

The Board's adoption of Ordinance No. 911 by no later than its regular meeting session of September 27, 2011 will ensure compliance with California Elections Code § 21501 which requires the boundaries to be adjusted prior to November 1, 2011.

Although the supervisory district boundary changes are considered adjusted once a plan proposal has been approved and the necessary implementing ordinance has been adopted, they do not go into effect immediately. California Elections Code § 21506 states in pertinent part:

"The term of office of any supervisor who has been elected and whose term of office has not expired shall not be affected by any change in the boundaries of the district from which he or she was elected.

At the first election for county supervisors in each county following adjustment of the boundaries of supervisory districts, a supervisor shall be elected for each district under the readjusted district plan that has the same district number as a district whose incumbent's term is to expire."

Given the above, the boundary adjustments to District 1 and District 3 will not take effect until the election that is held in 2012 (for elected supervisor taking office in January 2013), and District 2, District 4, and District 5 will not take effect until the election that is held in 2014 (for elected supervisor taking office in January 2015). As a result, voters during the elections held in 2012 and 2014 will vote according to the new adjusted boundary lines. For example, the residents in the City of Canyon Lake will vote in 2012 for a supervisor in District 1, although they will not be represented by the 1st District Supervisor until such elected official takes office in January 2013.

The ordinance has been reviewed and approved as to form by County Counsel.


