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3. Award the contract to All American Asphalt and authorize the Chairman of the Board to execute the contract documents; and
4. Authorize an increase of \$75,350 in the use of Development Impact Fee (DIF) Roads, Bridges and Major Improvement Fund for the Temescal Canyon Area (Fund 30512) and an increase of \$81,596 of Development Impact Fee (DIF) Roads, Bridges and Major Improvement Fund for the Greater Lake Elsinore Area (Fund 30521) for costs associated with improvements to the Indian Truck Trail / I-15 Interchange; and
5. Direct the Executive Office to transfer up to \$720,350 from Development Impact Fee (DIF) Roads, Bridges and Major Improvement Fund for the Temescal Canyon Area (Fund 30512) and up to \$681,596 of Development Impact Fee (DIF) Roads, Bridges and Major Improvement Fund for the Greater Lake Elsinore Area (Fund 30521) to the Transportation Department as needed, pursuant to contracts and billings received for improvements to the Indian Truck Trail / I-15 Interchange; and
6. Amend the TIP by approval of the project's proposed budget shown on Attachment "A".

**BACKGROUND:**

By Minute Order dated June 14, 2011 (agenda item 3.57), the Board authorized the Clerk of the Board to advertise for the Interstate 15 (I-15) at Indian Truck Trail Interchange including Temescal Canyon Road Improvements, Sycamore Creek area, upon approval of California Transportation Commission (CTC). The Notice Inviting Bids was published in the newspaper as authorized by the Board, commencing on June 28, 2011.

During the advertisement period, one addendum was issued to all registered plan holders as a supplement to the specifications and special provisions. Bidders are required to acknowledge and to take into account addenda on their Contractor's Proposal. The addendum was issued to clarify and modify the contract documents. The addendum No. 1 is attached.

Bids for the project were opened in the office of the Director of Transportation at 2:00 PM, Wednesday, July 27, 2011. Five bids were received. The basis for the selection of a contractor is the lowest responsive and responsible bid. The lowest responsive and responsible bid was submitted by All American Asphalt of Corona, CA, in the amount of \$5,626,215 which is \$388,269 (7.41%) above the Engineer's Estimate. Bid prices appear to be rising with respect to Engineer's Estimate costs due to inflating prices of construction materials.

The improvements consist of widening the Indian Truck Trail undercrossing from two to four lanes with turning lanes from Campbell Ranch Road to Temescal Canyon Road. The existing northbound on-ramp will be widened to two lanes, and the northbound and southbound off ramps will be widened to three lanes. New traffic signals will be constructed at the freeway ramps and Temescal Canyon intersection. These improvements are needed to accommodate increases in traffic due to residential, commercial and industrial development in the last few years. These improvements will accommodate current and future traffic demand by increasing traffic capacity and enhancing safety within the interchange.

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The County entered into a Construction Cooperative Agreement with Caltrans (Caltrans Agreement No. 08-1294) on December 12, 2006 (agenda item 3.32), which was amended April 26, 2011 (agenda item 3.45) (08-1294 A/1). The Construction Cooperative Agreement authorizes Riverside County to be the lead agency for this project on the State highway system.

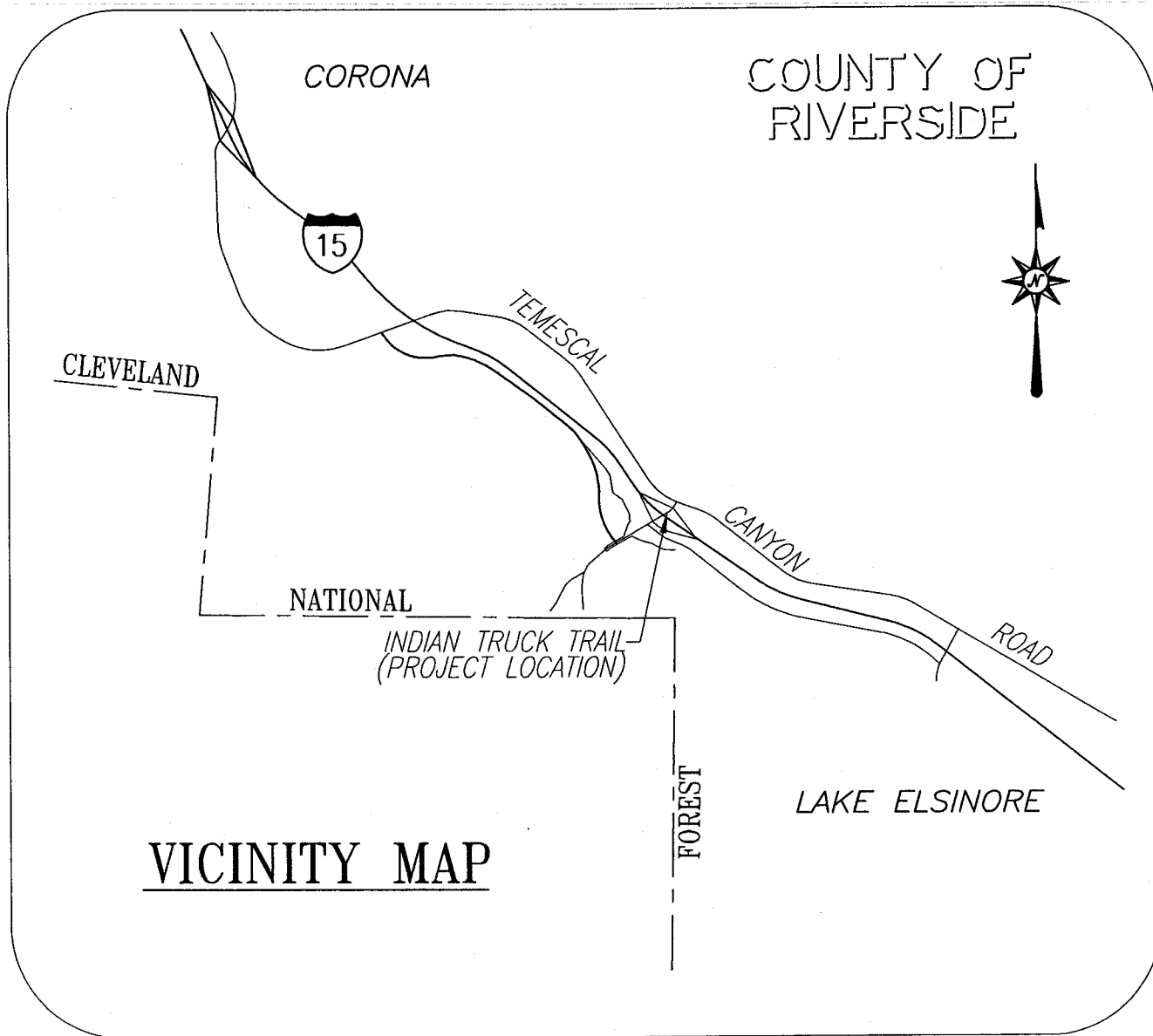
In October 2010, \$1,000,000 from the Proposition 1B State-Local Partnership Program (SLPP) fund was programmed for the project. The Board of Supervisors approved Resolution 2011-089 on April 5, 2011 (agenda item 3.16), which authorized the use of local transportation funds to "front" construction funds in the event that SLPP fund approval be deferred by the CTC at its May 11-12, 2011 meeting. The CTC did defer the allocation of Proposition 1B SLPP funds at its May meeting. A request was submitted to the CTC, supported by Resolution 2011-089, to obtain approval to construct using local transportation funds, at their June 22-23, 2011 meeting. The CTC approved construction of this project with a "fronting" of local funds and to reimburse the project upon availability of Proposition 1B SLPP funds.

Development Impact Fee (DIF) Major Improvement Funds from fund 30512 in the amount of \$645,000 and fund 30521 in the amount of \$600,000 were authorized on June 19, 2007 (agenda item 3.35).

The contractor is qualified.

The Contractor has executed the contract and has provided bonds and insurance, which meet the requirements of the contract.

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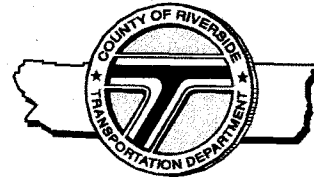

It shall be the responsibility of the Contractor to obtain an Encroachment Permit from the County of Riverside to perform any work in the County right-of-way. The Encroachment Permits are at no cost to the Contractor.

**Item 4: Electrical Line Extension**

The following Special Provisions are added and made part hereof:

The work of installing the necessary electrical line extension shall be performed in accordance with the Southern California Edison Company line extension plans, the current edition of the National Electric Code, these special provisions, and as directed by the Engineer.

The line extension work shall be performed at as follows:

On the south side of Indian Truck Trail, from the NW corner of the south-bound I-15 ramp terminal to SW corner of Temescal Canyon Road and Indian Truck Trail to the designated service points, as shown on the Edison Company's plans.

The Contractor's work shall include, but is not be limited to furnishing, installing and constructing the following, as generally shown on the Edison Company's line extension plans as 'work to be performed by the customer':

Pad-mount transformer foundations, trenching, backfill, compaction, conduit, conduit sweeps, conduit risers to 10 feet above grade, pull rope, pull boxes, vaults, vault pads, pull boxes, and other required equipment.

The contractor shall provide necessary coordination with SCE for all work associated with the electrical line extension.

All work shall be in accordance with the requirements, plans and specifications of the Edison Company.

Unless otherwise required on the Edison plans, pole riser conduit and sweeps shall be Schedule 80, and underground conduit, bends, etc. shall be Schedule 40. All other facilities shown on the Edison Company's plans shall be installed, if and as shown to be installed by the 'customer' or the County of Riverside. The Contractor shall coordinate with the Edison Company's inspector in all matters pertaining to the installation of the line extension, including inspection.

The Edison Company will inspect all work performed by the Contractor, provide and install transformers, provide and install conductors, provide and install conduit above Contractor installed risers (above the 10 foot level), and make final connections.

The Edison Company will be allowed a construction window of 45 working days, or as otherwise specified in the Special Provision entitled "liquidated damages" for their work.

Bidding Contractors are advised to carefully review the Edison Company's plans prior to bidding to ensure that the bidding contractor and specialty sub-contractor, if utilized, understands the Contractor's responsibilities.

The Edison Company's line extension plan is included in the final plans as part of these bid documents. Estimated line extension length: 340 feet.

The County of Riverside will pay all fees required by the Edison Company.



The work of installing the necessary electrical line extension shall be performed in accordance with the Southern California Edison Company line extension plans, the current edition of the National Electric Code, these special provisions, and as directed by the Engineer.

The line extension work shall be performed at as follows:

On the south side of Indian Truck Trail, from the NW corner of the south-bound I-15 ramp terminal to SW corner of Temescal Canyon Road and Indian Truck Trail to the designated service points, as shown on the Edison Company's plans.

The Contractor's work shall include, but is not be limited to furnishing, installing and constructing the following, as generally shown on the Edison Company's line extension plans as 'work to be performed by the customer':

Pad-mount transformer foundations, trenching, backfill, compaction, conduit, conduit sweeps, conduit risers to 10 feet above grade, pull rope, pull boxes, vaults, vault pads, pull boxes, and other required equipment.

The contractor shall provide necessary coordination with SCE for all work associated with the electrical line extension.

All work shall be in accordance with the requirements, plans and specifications of the Edison Company.

Unless otherwise required on the Edison plans, pole riser conduit and sweeps shall be Schedule 80, and underground conduit, bends, etc. shall be Schedule 40. All other facilities shown on the Edison Company's plans shall be installed, if and as shown to be installed by the 'customer' or the County of Riverside. The Contractor shall coordinate with the Edison Company's inspector in all matters pertaining to the installation of the line extension, including inspection.

THIS ESCROW AGREEMENT FOR SECURITY DEPOSITS IN LIEU OF RETENTION (hereinafter called the "Agreement") is made and entered into on this **27th** day of **September, 2011**, by and between **County of Riverside DOT**, whose address is 3525 14<sup>th</sup> Street, Riverside, CA 92501 (hereinafter called "Owner"), **All American Asphalt**, whose address is P.O. Box 2229, Corona, CA 92878 (hereinafter called "Contractor"), and **Community Bank**, a California banking corporation, whose address is 505 E. Colorado Boulevard, Pasadena, California 91101 (hereinafter called "Escrow Agent").

WHEREAS, the parties desire to establish an escrow account with Escrow Agent (the "Escrow Account") pursuant to the provisions of Section 22300 of the California Public Contract Code.

NOW, THEREFORE, for the consideration hereinafter set forth, the Owner, Contractor, and Escrow Agent agree as follows:

1. Pursuant to Section 22300 of the Public Contract Code of the State of California, the Contractor has the option to deposit securities with Escrow Agent as a substitute for retention earnings required to be withheld by the Owner pursuant to the Construction Contract entered into between the Owner and the Contractor, for **Interstate-15 (I-15) at Indian Truck Trail Interchange Including Temescal** in the amount of **\$5,626,214.00** (hereinafter referred to as the "Contract"). Alternatively, **on written request of the Contractor, the Owner shall make payments of the retention earnings directly to the Escrow Agent.** When the Contractor deposits the securities as a substitute for Contract earnings, the Escrow Agent shall notify the Owner within ten (10) days of the deposit. The market value of the securities at the time of the substitution shall be at least equal to the cash amount then required to be withheld as retention under the terms of the Contract between the Owner and the Contractor. Securities shall be held in the name of **County of Riverside DOT**, and shall designate the Contractor as the beneficial owner.

2. The Owner shall make progress payments to the Contractor for those funds which otherwise would be withheld from progress payments pursuant to the Contract provisions, provided that the Escrow Agent holds securities in the form and amount specified above.

3. When the Owner makes payment of the retentions earned directly to the Escrow Agent, the Escrow Agent shall hold them for the benefit of the Contractor until the time that the escrow created under this Agreement is terminated. The Contractor may direct the investment of the payments into securities. All terms and conditions of this Agreement and the rights and responsibilities of the parties shall be equally applicable and binding when the Owner pays the Escrow Agent directly.

4. The Contractor shall be responsible for paying all fees for the expenses incurred by the Escrow Agent in administering the Escrow Account and all expenses of the Owner. These expenses and payment terms shall be determined by the Owner, the Contractor and the Escrow Agent.

5. The interest earned on the securities or the money market accounts held in escrow and all interest earned on that interest shall be for the sole account of the Contractor and shall be subject to withdrawal by the Contractor at any time and from time to time without notice to the Owner.
6. The Contractor shall have the right to withdraw all or any part of the principal in the Escrow Account only by written notice to the Escrow Agent accompanied by written authorization from the Owner to the Escrow Agent that the Owner consents to the withdrawal of the amount sought to be withdrawn by the Contractor.
7. The Owner shall have a right to draw upon the securities in the event of default by the Contractor. Upon seven days' written notice to the Escrow Agent from the Owner of the default, the Escrow Agent shall immediately convert the securities to cash and shall distribute the cash as instructed by the Owner.
