amount forwarded to all counties was \$25,597,736, or \$9,402,264 less than anticipated \$35 million authorized. Riverside County received a total of \$2,496,498 for FY 2010/11.

Government Code § 29550 allows the county to collect fees at the rate in place on June 30, 2006 escalated by the California Consumer Price Index plus one percent, compounded annually in proportion to the level of under-appropriation. The new structure, funded from a percentage of the VLF, does not specify a set funding level rather it guarantees only a percentage that is dedicated to the local detention facility account. As of the preparation of this submittal, there is no estimate for the FY 2011/2012 funding. Due to changes in the state budget it appears there will be no funding from the VLF and the assumption is that these funds will come from realignment appropriations. The estimated funding from VLF for FY 10/11 was \$30 million. Once the state has delineated the funding for FY 2011/12 the rates will be adjusted to concur with current statutes.

The county has sent letters to all city managers and chiefs of police informing them of the proposed FY 2011/12 fee along with information about how the fee was calculated and the amount distributed from the VLF last year. (Exhibit A) These letters comply with the statutorily required 45-day notice for a public hearing.

The state requires the county to consider the following possible scenarios:

- 1. If the state appropriation is at least \$35 million, cities or arresting entities will not be charged the criminal justice administration fee; or
- 2. If the state appropriates less than \$35 million, cities/arresting entities will be charged an adjusted rate as provided in Government Code §29551 (e). The adjusted rate would be charged upon approval by the Board of Supervisors and the initial calculation will be made following the first quarter disbursement; or,
- 3. If the state does not appropriate the necessary funding the county is able to charge cities/arresting entities its actual cost for booking arrestees into county detention facilities.

Additionally, Government Code § 29550.2 states that any person booked into a county jail pursuant to any arrest by any governmental entity is subject to a criminal justice administration fee if the individual is convicted of a criminal offense relating to the arrest and booking. Regardless of the location of the arrest, funds collected from those convicted of a crime are deposited into the county treasury to support detention costs.

A public hearing will be scheduled for October 4, 2011, regarding the County Criminal Justice Administrative Fee, commonly referred to as the booking fee. The Code requires a 45-day notice period prior to a public hearing when the County proposes increasing this fee. This letter serves as the written notification for the increase.

The Sheriff's Department calculated the actual cost for the administrative and applicable overhead costs incurred in booking or otherwise processing an arrested person. The fee and methodology were reviewed and approved by the Auditor/Controller. The recommended FY 2011/12 fee is \$450.34, an increase of \$35.89 over the \$414.45 approved for FY 2010/11. The current indexed rate that will be charged to agencies is \$35.53. Calculation information is attached for your review.

Government Code Section 29553 states that beginning in FY 2009/10 the payments to counties and cities with detention services are fully funded from the Local Safety and Protection Account in the Transportation Tax Fund authorized by Section 10752.2 of the Revenue and Taxation Code. At this point, it is our understanding that this funding will be forthcoming. There are three possible scenarios for FY 2010/11:

- 1. If the state appropriates at least \$35 million, cities/arresting entities will not be charged the Criminal Justice Administrative Fee; or,
- 2. If the state appropriates less than \$35 million, cities/arresting entities will be charged an adjusted rate as provided in Government Code Section 29551 (e). The adjusted rate shall be charged upon approval by the Board of Supervisors and increased annually by the California Consumer Price Index plus one (1) percent compounded annually; or,

3. If the state does not appropriate funding under Government Code Sections 29552 and 29553, the County is able to charge the cities its actual cost for booking arrestees into County detention facilities.

Government Code Section 29550.2 states that a person booked into a county jail pursuant to any arrest by any governmental entity is subject to a criminal justice administration fee if the person is convicted of any criminal offense relating to the arrest and booking. Regardless of the location of the arrest, the funds collected from convicted persons are deposited into the County treasury to support detention costs.

In FY 2010/11 the state appropriated \$25,597,736, an amount \$9,402,264 less than the \$35 million threshold established by law. As of this date the best information that we have from the California Department of Finance and the California State Association of Counties is that the previous VLF funds are intertwined with the realignment funding and a broader budget resolution making it unclear what the final allocation will be. It is very likely that \$35 million will not be available although at this time it is impossible to estimate how much the County will be allocated. Should the funding received from the state be less than \$35 million and based on first quarter revenues the adjusted fee per booking will be calculated and provided at mid-year. As in past years there will be a vear-end reconciliation.
