PIVERSIDE COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS. OUT-17-2011

Document 1: Agenda 10.3, Oct 3rd, 1995. In agenda 10.3 Riverside County Flood Control Director Kenneth Edwards recommended that the board approve resolution no. F95-5 authorization to convey 4 non exclusive easements for ingress and egress purposes over district owned land. Justification-side channel modification has landlocked 4 property owners and these easements will provide new unobstructed access to the property owners. Supervisor Buster and Supervisor Tavaglione voted yes. Supervisor Tavaglione signed the easements. Four easements were received by Kenneth Edwards for recording 10-25-95.

Documents No. 2 & 3: Two letters dated Dec 28th, 2010 and May 4th, 2011 from Riverside County Flood Control Assistant Chief Engineer, Steve Thomas to Robert Mabee stating his easement deed and three other easement deeds to the other property owners were never recorded and can not be found. This is the same Kenneth Edwards that on Agenda 3.30, April 12th, 2011 told the Board of Supervisors that other than Robert Mabee no other property owner has ever complained.

On Friday, July 1st, 2011 the newspaper and channel 9 ran a story about a County official who wants to break away from the state and create a new state.

the same man who skimmed off nearly \$400,000.00 of campaign money to his sister along with a county car and who wants to ration bathroom paper to county employees. The same man who in 1999 when he was mayor of Temecula and a pharmacist agreed to a settlement with the State Board of Pharmacy over 20 accusations they had made that he had operated a unlicensed pharmacy, improperly labeled drugs, and committed dishonesty, fraud, deceit and corruption. Under the settlement he admitted to four of the charges, all of them minor and reimbursed the Pharmacy Board and State Attorney's Generals office a total of \$10,000 for the cost of the investigation. This is the same man who the Press Enterprise Friday, June 10th, 2011 reported paid a \$16,000.00 fine by the State Fair Political Practices Commission. This is the same man who I believe Supervisor Buster as reported in the Press Enterprise Friday, July 1st, 2011 called crazy and out in the sun too long. This sick puppy also known as Supervisor Jeff Stone annears to have broken away from the state of reality.

Several weeks ago I filed a tormat complain taken by Dan Stack in the District Attorney's office. I provided27 public documents proving fraud corruption and misuse of public funds. JUSTIFICATION:

The District's Bautista Creek Channel from Fairview Avenue upstream has experienced vandalism and trespassing. To prevent this and limit potential liabilities, the District fenced the 15-foot wide maintenance road and modified several side channel conveyances. Certain individuals by virtue of being successors in interest to an access easement (Instrument No. 91932) enjoyed the use of the 15-foot wide strip of land adjacent to said channel. Said access easement provided that if at any time a public highway or street was extended to the described lands in Section 22 lying easterly of Bautista Creek Channel said easement shall cease and determine. To this end, the District granted to the County a 40-foot wide strip of land adjacent to the 15-foot wide easement for acceptance in the County's non-maintained road system (Instrument No. 127298),

A portion of the 15-foot wide access easement is located within a drainage wash, making it dangerous and unusable during times of storm flow. In addition, the side channel modification has obstructed physical access to a portion of the 15-foot side easement. The granting of these easements will provide new unobstructed access to the property owners (see attached Exhibit A).
