

SUBJECT: Riverside County Red Ribbon Week Proclamation

RECOMMENDED MOTION: Move that the Riverside County Board of Supervisors support the National and State recognized "Red Ribbon" Campaign"; and proclaim the week of October 23 thru October 31, 2011 as Riverside County Red Ribbon Week.

BACKGROUND: On October 19, 2010, Agenda Item 2.26, the Riverside County Board of Supervisors approved October 23 through October 31, 2010 as Riverside County's 25th year celebration of Red Ribbon Week. The Red Ribbon Week Celebration began when drug traffickers in Mexico murdered the Drug Enforcement Administration (DEA) Agent Enrique Camarena, in 1985. Now in its twenty-sixth year, the Red Ribbon Campaign enables communities to reinforce positive peer pressure by visibly encouraging drug-free choices and promoting the standards held by the majority of the people in our county, state and nation: "NO USE OF ILLEGAL DRUGS AND NO ILLEGAL USE OF LEGAL DRUGS."
