BACKGROUND (continued)

On June 7, 2011 (3.64), the Board accepted the award and authorized budget adjustments for FY 2010 / 2011. The Sheriff's Department is now reappropriating the remainder of the grant funds to complete the project.

OPSG within Riverside County, California is conducted by local law enforcement agencies in collaboration with the United States Border Patrol-Yuma Sector. The focus of the operation is to increase law enforcement presence in areas identified through intelligence information as "high-entry" points and routes of egress used by narcotic smuggling and human trafficking organizations, or as central transportation hubs. Through the enforcement of the California Penal Code, Stonegarden officers act as a second tier of Homeland Security operations in direct support of the National Border Patrol Strategy.

OPSG does not extend Federal authority to County or Local law enforcement agencies to enforce Federal immigration laws. Riverside County Sheriff's Department and Blythe Police Department are focusing on criminal suppression through identified ingress corridors pre-determined by intelligence based planning. Riverside County Sheriff's Department and Blythe Police Department do not enforce immigration violations but concentrate on enforcing California Penal Codes along said ingress routes.
