BACKGROUND: On March 23, 2010 (3.34), the Board of Supervisor approved a three (3) year agreement with the option of two (2) one-year renewal periods with Systems Integration Corporation (SI) to provide Integrated Security and Electronics Maintenance at all five County jails. The final cost over the five (5) year contract period was set at \$4,031,900.

On May 24, 2011 (3.46), the Board approved a \$521,964 increase to the SI agreement to cover jail security up-grades and maintenance fees associated with the upgrades.

Now, Sheriff's Corrections staff is recommending Board approval of the SI agreement's second amendment, which recognizes the closure of the "Old Jail" in downtown Riverside and reduces agreement fees by \$147,742.

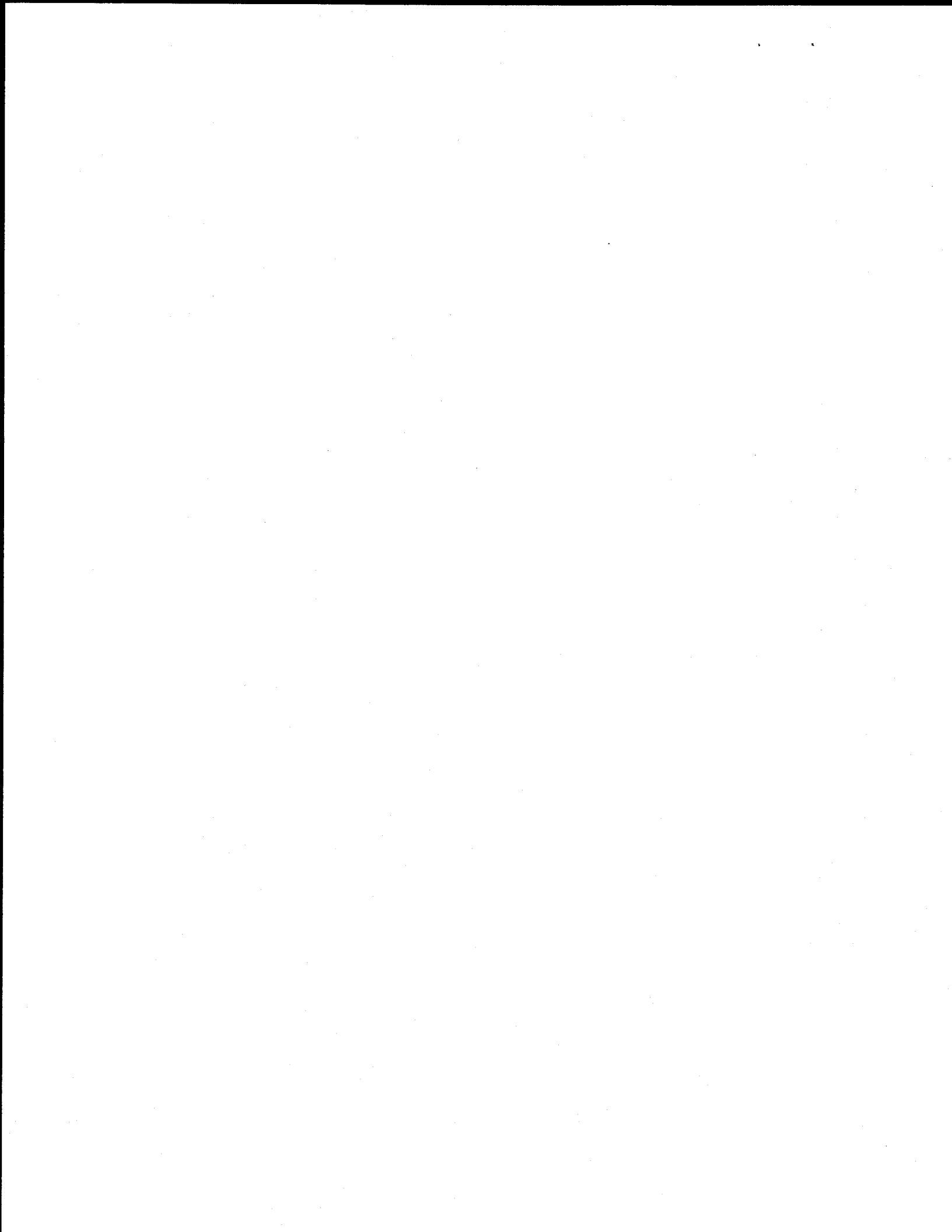
In addition, Sheriff's Corrections staff is recommending approval of the agreement's third amendment, which incorporates equipment maintenance costs for security electronic and fire alarm systems at the new Smith Correctional Facility (SCF) Expansion.

The new SCF housing units require a preventive maintenance schedule for each of the following electronic systems: network video recorders, security doors, fire alarms and the public video visitation center.

The SCF security maintenance cost increase will total \$674,151 over the term of the agreement, but will be off-set by the cost reduction of \$147,742, resulting from the closure of the Old Jail. So the maintenance cost increase for agreement years two-five is \$526,409.

Price Reasonableness

The cost for added preventative maintenance schedules at SCF was negotiated between Sheriff's Corrections staff and SI. Further, per the agreement with SI, the County reserves the right to add, update, modify and improve any system using the contractor of its choice. However, Department staff does not believe it is sensible to piecemeal maintenance efforts for the security equipment among a number of contractors

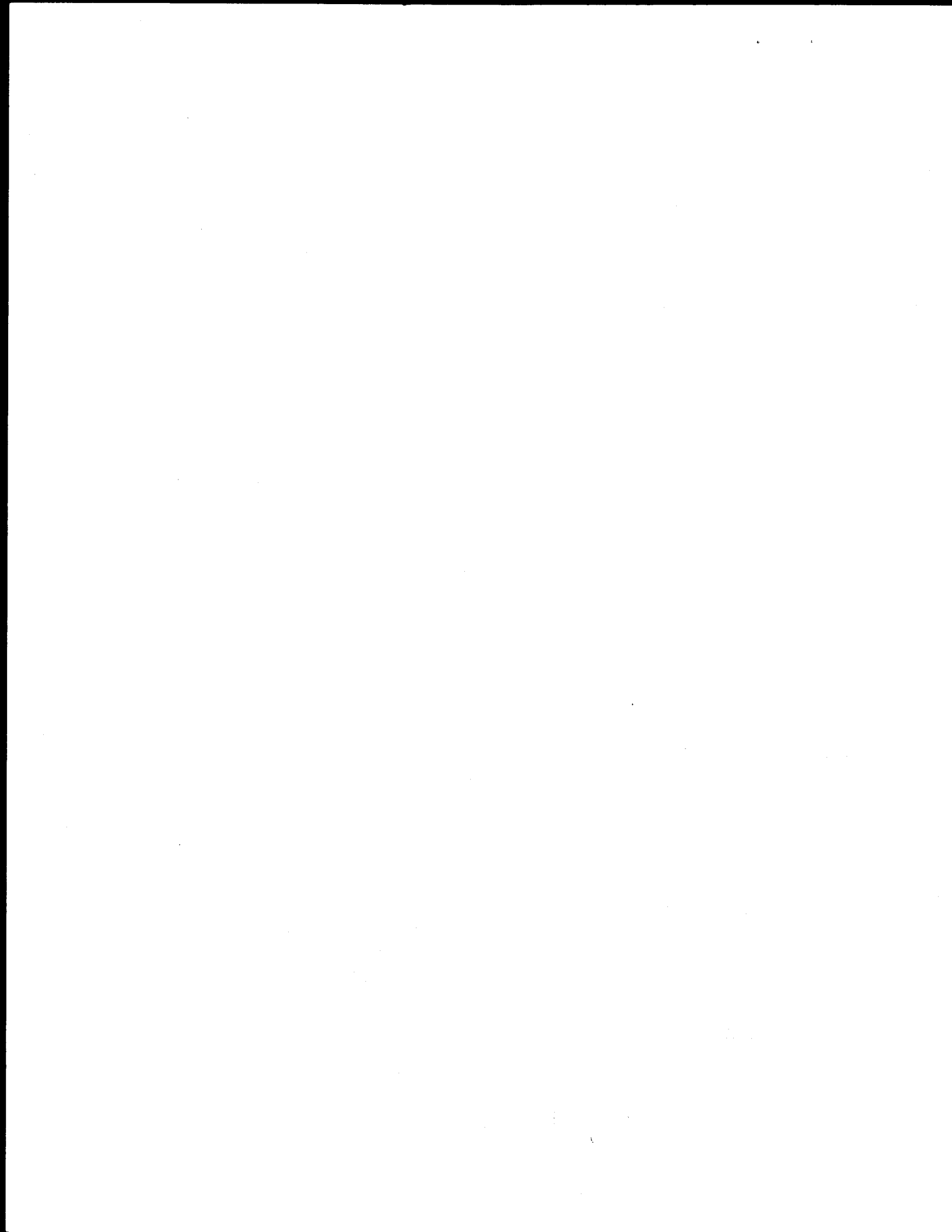
