Upon graduation, he returned to Riverside and joined his father at JF Davidson Associates which he increased to five offices and three hundred employees. He also oversaw the expansion of Riverside Blueprint and established RB Graphics and Prefect Impressions, as well as many other successful business ventures including JF Davidson Investments. As a true humanitarian, Jim was involved with numerous organizations including the Riverside Rotary Club, Riverside Chamber of Commerce, RCC Foundation, and the Cancer Society Great American Smoke Out.

Jim was a loving husband to his wife Gerri of 22 years and a devoted family man who enjoyed the ocean, deep sea fishing, farming citrus, and gardening. His "tireless service" to the community and passionate spirit will live forever in the hearts of those who knew and loved him. He will be dearly missed.
