FOURTH AMENDMENT TO AGREEMENT FOR LAW ENFORCEMENT SERVICES BETWEEN COUNTY OF RIVERSIDE AND CITY OF MORENO VALLEY

IT IS MUTUALLY AGREED that the Agreement for Law Enforcement Services between the County of Riverside, a political subdivision of the State of California, on behalf of its Sheriff's Department, and the City of Moreno Valley, a General Law City, approved by the Board of Supervisors on December 16, 2008, for services effective July 1, 2008 through June 30, 2013, as amended on December 1, 2009, November 2, 2010 and November 30, 2010, is hereby amended in the following respects, and all other terms and conditions of the Agreement remain in full force and effect:
