The Colorado River Senior & Community Center provides essential services that include nutritional, health and emergency services to residents in this remote area.

The CVAG Homelessness Committee will be purchasing bus passes from the Sunline Transit Agency for the benefit of local homelessness service providers. The CVAG Homelessness Committee believes that it is necessary for each city and the county to provide financial contribution to create a program that will support the worthwhile work of non-profit service providers. Clients will be able to utilize the Sun Bus to access supportive services, seek employment, and other essential services.

The Parades of Palm Springs will be hosting the 20th Annual Festival of Lights Parade on December 3rd. This is a hugely popular event that entertains thousands of spectators.

I would like to use Fourth District Community Improvement funds to support this event and the organizations providing services in the community.
