BACKGROUND: Pursuant to the Landscaping and Lighting Act of 1972 and Resolution 2011-238 adopted October 4, 2011, the Board of Supervisors noticed a public hearing for November 22, 2011, to receive testimony regarding the annexation of Zone 162 to Landscaping and Lighting Maintenance District No. 89-1-Consolidated (L&LMD No. 89-1-C). Annexation of Zone 162 will fund the maintenance and servicing of fossil filters and traffic signals, and the provision of electricity for traffic signals within public rights-of-way located westerly of Encanto Rd, northwesterly of Pourroy Rd, northerly of Promontory Pkwy, and southerly of Allen St in the French Valley area and includes 249 single-family residential lots.

BACKGROUND: Adoption of Resolution No. 2011-237 appoints the Director of the Transportation Department as the Engineer to prepare a Report regarding the proposed annexation of Zone 162 to Landscaping and Lighting Maintenance District No. 89-1-Consolidated ("L&LMD No. 89-1-C").

Resolution No. 2011-238 declares the Board's intention of ordering the annexation of Zone 162 to L&LMD No. 89-1-C. Annexation of Zone 162 to L&LMD No. 89-1-C will fund the maintenance and servicing of fossil filters and traffic signals, and the provision of electricity for traffic signals within public right-of-way located westerly of Encanto Rd, northwesterly of Pourroy Rd, northerly of Promontory Pkwy, and southerly of Allen St in the French Valley area and includes 249 single-family residential lots.

The proposed budget for fiscal year 2012-13 for Zone 162 is \$25,915 that will result in an assessment for fiscal year 2012-13 within Zone 162 of \$104.08 per parcel. The annual assessment may be adjusted annually by the greater of 2% or the cumulative percentage increase in the CPI-U, if any, as it stands as of March of each year over the base index for March of 2011.

Consistent with the Board's direction regarding compliance with Article XIIID of the California Constitution and the Landscaping and Lighting Act of 1972, the attached resolutions have been prepared and a public hearing scheduled for 9:30 a.m. on November 22, 2011 to receive testimony for and against the proposed assessment. Each property owner within the proposed Zone 162 will receive a notice of the public hearing and mail-in ballot, an impartial analysis, a copy of Resolution No. 2011-238, and an information sheet.

Ballots must be returned prior to the conclusion of the public hearing. If, at the time designated for the tabulation of the ballots, the ballots submitted in favor of the annexation and levy of the assessment exceed the ballots submitted in opposition of said annexation and levy, Zone 162 will be annexed to L&LMD No. 89-1-C.

There is only one individual/entity which owns all of the property within the proposed boundaries of Zone 162 and said property owner has executed a "Waiver and Consent Regarding Date of Assessment Ballot Election" allowing for the election and public hearing to be held on November 22, 2011.

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors (hereinafter the "Board of Supervisors") of the County of Riverside (hereinafter the "County") has been advised by the Transportation Department (hereinafter "Department") of the County that said Department has received an application from the owner (the "Applicant") of all the property within the unincorporated area of the County (hereinafter "Zone 162"), as shown and described in Exhibit "A", which is attached hereto and made a part hereof, to be annexed to Landscaping and Lighting Maintenance District No. 89-1-Consolidated (hereinafter "L&LMD No. 89-1-C") of the County of Riverside, State of California, and the Board of Supervisors has determined that it is necessary and desirable to initiate proceedings for the annexation of Zone 162 to L&LMD No. 89-1-C pursuant to the Landscaping and Lighting Act of 1972, Part 2 (commencing with Section 22500) of Division 15 of the Streets and Highways Code (hereinafter, respectively, the "Act" and the "Street and Highways Code"); and

WHEREAS, such proceedings shall comply with the requirements of Article XIIID of the California Constitution and Section 4000 of the Elections Code requiring voter approval of the proposed assessment to be levied by L&LMD No. 89-1-C for Zone 162; and

WHEREAS, the Applicant has executed a "Waiver and Consent Regarding Date of Assessment Ballot Election" allowing for the election to be held on November 22, 2011; and

WHEREAS, the Director of the Department, or his designee, is a licensed and registered civil engineer, has expertise with respect to the annexation of territory to landscaping and lighting maintenance districts and the levying of assessments for said purposes and, therefore, is able to serve

as the engineer (hereinafter the "Engineer") for the County with regard to the annexation of Zone 162 to L&LMD No. 89-1-C.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, FOUND, DETERMINED AND ORDERED by the Board of Supervisors of the County of Riverside assembled in regular session on October 4, 2011 as follows:

Section 1. Recitals. The Board of Supervisors hereby finds and determines that all the above recitals are true and correct.

Section 2. Annexation. The Board of Supervisors proposes to annex Zone 162 to L&LMD No. 89-1-C and to initiate and conduct proceedings therefore pursuant to the Act for the purpose of levying an annual assessment on all parcels within Zone 162 to pay the costs of the following services:

- (a) The maintenance and servicing of fossil filters within the public right-of-way including the removal of petroleum hydrocarbons and other pollutants from water runoff; and
- (b) Providing electricity to, and the maintenance and servicing of, traffic signals within the public right-of-way including incidental costs and expenses.

Section 3. <u>Boundaries and Designation.</u> The boundaries of Zone 162 that are proposed to be annexed to L&LMD No. 89-1-C shall include all of the property as shown and described in Exhibit "A".

Section 4. Report. The Director of the Department of the County, or his designee, is hereby designated Engineer and is ordered to prepare and file a report with the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors in accordance with Sections 22608 and 22585 et. seq. of the Streets and Highways Code and Section 4 of Article XIIID of the California Constitution regarding said annexation and the levy.

Section 5. <u>Effective Date.</u> This Resolution shall take effect from and after its date of adoption.





RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF RIVERSIDE DECLARING ITS INTENT TO ORDER THE ANNEXATION OF ZONE 162 TO LANDSCAPING AND LIGHTING MAINTENANCE DISTRICT NO. 89-1-CONSOLIDATED OF THE COUNTY OF RIVERSIDE PURSUANT TO THE LANDSCAPING AND LIGHTING ACT OF 1972 FOR THE MAINTENANCE AND SERVICING OF FOSSIL FILTERS AND TRAFFIC SIGNALS; ADOPTING THE PRELIMINARY ENGINEER'S REPORT; GIVING NOTICE OF AND SETTING THE TIME AND PLACE OF THE PUBLIC HEARING ON THE ANNEXATION OF ZONE 162; ORDERING AN ASSESSMENT PROCEEDING; ORDERING A MAILED BALLOT ELECTION; AND DIRECTING NOTICE OF THE PUBLIC HEARING AND THE ASSESSMENT BALLOT TO BE MAILED PURSUANT TO ARTICLE XIIID OF THE CALIFORNIA CONSTITUTION AND SECTION 4000 OF THE ELECTIONS CODE

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors (hereinafter the "Board of Supervisors") of the County of Riverside (hereinafter the "County") has adopted Resolution No. 2011-237 on October 4, 2011 initiating proceedings for the annexation of Zone 162 (hereinafter "Zone 162"), as described and shown in Exhibit "A", which is attached hereto and incorporated herein, to Landscaping and Lighting Maintenance District No. 89-1-Consolidated of the County of Riverside, State of California, (hereinafter "L&LMD No. 89-1-C") pursuant to the Landscaping and Lighting Act of 1972 (hereinafter the "Act"), which is Part 2 (commencing with Section 22500) of Division 15 of the Streets and Highways Code (hereinafter the "Street and Highways Code"), and ordering the preparation of a report (hereinafter the "Report") regarding the proposed annexation of Zone 162 and the assessments to be levied within Zone 162 each fiscal year beginning fiscal year 2012-13 for the the maintenance and servicing of fossil filters and traffic signals, and the provision of electricity for traffic signals within the public right-of-way within said Zone; and

WHEREAS, such proceedings shall comply with the requirements of Article XIIID of the California Constitution (hereinafter "Article XIIID:"), the Act, and Section 4000 of the Elections Code requiring voter approval of the proposed assessment to be levied by L&LMD No. 89-1-C for Zone 162; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors by Resolution No. 2011-237 directed the Director of the Transportation Department, or his designee (hereinafter the "Engineer"), to prepare and file the Report

with the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors in accordance with Sections 22608 and 22585 et. seq. of the Street and Highways Code and Section 4 of Article XIIID; and

WHEREAS, said Engineer has filed the Report with the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors and the Report has been presented to and considered by the Board of Supervisors; and

WHEREAS, the Applicant has executed a "Waiver and Consent Regarding Date of Assessment Ballot Election" allowing for the election to be held on November 22, 2011; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary that the Board of Supervisors adopt a resolution of intention pursuant to Section 22624 of the Streets and Highways Code, which fixes and gives notice, pursuant to Section 22626 of the Streets and Highways Code, of the time and place of a public hearing on said Report, the annexation of Zone 162, and the assessments to be levied on parcels within Zone 162 beginning in fiscal year 2012-13;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, FOUND, DETERMINED AND ORDERED by the Board of Supervisors in regular session assembled on October 4, 2011 as follows:

Section 1. Findings. The Board of Supervisors, after reviewing the Report, finds that:

- (a) The foregoing recitals are true and correct;
- (b) The Report contains all matters required by Sections 22565 through 22574 of the Streets and Highways Code and Section 4 of Article XIIID and may, therefore, be approved by the Board of Supervisors;
- (c) The annual assessment for fiscal year 2012-13 on all parcels within Zone 162 proposed to be annexed to L&LMD No. 89-1-C will be \$104.08 per parcel.

Section 2. Intent. The Board of Supervisors hereby declares its intention to order the annexation of Zone 162, as described and shown in Exhibit "A", to L&LMD No. 89-1-C, and to levy and collect an annual assessment on all assessable lots and parcels of property within Zone 162 commencing with the fiscal year 2012-13 as set forth in the Report. The Report expressly states that there are no parcels or lots within Zone 162 that are owned by a federal, state or other local governmental agency that will benefit from the services to be financed by the annual assessments. The

annual assessments will be collected at the same time and in the same manner as property taxes are collected, and all laws providing for the collection and enforcement of property taxes shall apply to the collection and enforcement of said assessments.

- Section 3. <u>Boundaries.</u> All the property within boundaries of Zone 162 is proposed to be annexed into L&LMD No. 89-1-C and shall include that property in the unincorporated area of the County as described and shown in Exhibit "A".
- **Section 4.** Description of Services to be Provided. The maintenance and servicing of fossil filters and traffic signals, and the provision of electricity for traffic signals authorized for Zone 162 of L&LMD No. 89-1-C are:
 - (a) The maintenance and servicing of fossil filters within the public right-of-way including the removal of petroleum hydrocarbons and other pollutants from water runoff; and
 - (b) Providing electricity to and the maintenance and servicing of traffic signals within the public right-of-way including incidental costs and expenses.

Section 5. Amount to be Levied. The assessment to be levied upon each parcel that benefits from the annexation of Zone 162 of L&LMD No. 89-1-C will be \$104.08 per parcel for fiscal year 2012-13. As stated in the Report, the total budget for Zone 162 for the fiscal year 2012-13 is \$25,915; there are 249 parcels that are to be assessed. The annual assessment may be increased by the greater of two percent (2.0%) or the cumulative percentage increase, if any, in the Consumer Price Index for all Urban Consumers ("CPI-U") for the Los Angeles-Riverside-Orange County California Standard Metropolitan Statistical area ("Index") published by the Bureau of Labor Statistics of the United States Department of Labor. The annual CPI-U adjustment will be based on the cumulative increase, if any, in the Index as it stands on March of each year over the base Index for March of 2011. Any increase larger than the greater of 2.0% or the CPI-U annual adjustment requires a majority approval of all the property owners within Zone 162. The Board of Supervisors will levy the assessment in each subsequent fiscal year until the Board of Supervisors undertakes proceedings for the dissolution of Zone 162 of L&LMD No. 89-1-C. The annual assessment will fund the services described

in Section 4 of this Resolution. For further particulars, reference is to be made to the Report on file in the Office of the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors.

Section 6. The Property to be Annexed. The property to be annexed into L&LMD No. 89-1-C is Zone 162. The boundaries of Zone 162 are located within the unincorporated area of the County and are described and shown in the Report and Exhibit "A".

Section 7. Report. The Report, which is on file with the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors and which has been presented to the Board of Supervisors, is hereby approved. Reference is made to the Report for a full and detailed description of the services, the boundaries of Zone 162, and the annual assessment to be levied upon assessable lots and parcels within Zone 162 proposed to be annexed to L&LMD No. 89-1-C.

Section 8. <u>Public Hearing.</u> The question of whether Zone 162 shall be annexed into L&LMD No. 89-1-C and an annual assessment levied beginning with fiscal year 2012-13 shall be considered at a public hearing (hereinafter the "Public Hearing") to be held on November 22, 2011, at 9:30 a.m. at the meeting room of the Board of Supervisors of the County at 4080 Lemon Street, 1st Floor, Riverside, California.

Section 9. <u>Majority Protest.</u> Each owner of record of property within Zone 162 is to receive by mail an assessment ballot that shall conform to the requirements of Section 4 of Article XIIID and Section 4000 of the California Elections Code. The assessment ballots are to be returned prior to the Public Hearing. L&LMD No. 89-1-C shall not impose assessments on property within the boundaries of Zone 162 if there is a majority protest with regard to the annexation of Zone 162. A majority protest exists if, upon the conclusion of the Public Hearing, the tabulation of the assessment ballots submitted in opposition to the annexation and assessment of Zone 162 exceeds the assessment ballots in favor of the annexation and assessment of Zone 162.

Section 10. <u>Information.</u> Any property owner desiring additional information regarding Zone 162 of L&LMD No. 89-1-C, the Report, or the proposed assessment is to contact Ms. Joan

Pickering, Engineering Technician II, Transportation Department of the County of Riverside, 4080 Lemon Street, 8th Floor, Riverside, California, 92501 or by telephone at 951-955 6748.

Section 11. Notice of the Public Hearing. Notice of Public Hearing with regard to the annexation of Zone 162 to L&LMD No. 89-1-C shall be given consistent with Section 22626 of the Streets and Highways Code and Section 4 of Article XIIID. The Clerk of the Board of Supervisors shall give notice of the Public Hearing by causing a certified copy of this Resolution to be published once in an appropriate newspaper at least ten (10) days prior to the date of the Public Hearing that is November 22, 2011. Publication of this Resolution is to be effected by the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors. Notice shall also be given by mailing first-class, postage prepaid, those notices, as prepared by County Counsel, assessment ballot and information sheets as required by Section 4 of Article XIIID and Section 4000 of the California Elections Code to all owners of record of property within Zone 162 as shown on the last equalized assessment roll of the County. Mailing is to be made by the Engineer and deposited with the U. S. Post Office at least forty-five (45) days prior to the Public Hearing on November 22, 2011.





Pursuant to the provisions of Section 22565 through 22574 of the Landscaping and Lighting Act of 1972, said act being Part 2 of Division 15 of the Streets and Highways Code of the State of California, Section 4 of Article XIIID of the California Constitution, and direction from the Board of Supervisors of Riverside County, California submitted herewith is the Report for Landscaping and Lighting Maintenance District No. 89-1-Consolidated - Zone 162 Annexation consisting of four (4) parts as follows:

PART I

A general description and plans of the fossil filter and traffic signal improvements proposed to be funded.

PART II

An estimate of the cost of the fossil filter and traffic signal improvements and maintenance including incidental costs and expenses in connection therewith for fiscal year 2012-13, is as set forth on the lists thereof, attached hereto.

PART III

A diagram showing Landscaping and Lighting Maintenance District No. 89-1-Consolidated, Zone 162 Annexation, the lines and dimensions of each parcel of land within said Zone 162, as the same exists on the maps of the Assessor of Riverside County for fiscal year 2012-13 is filed in the Office of the Riverside County Transportation Department. A reduced copy thereof is filed herewith and made a part hereof. Any changes in organization for said District (i.e. annexation) is discussed in this part.







"LANDSCAPING AND LIGHTING ACT OF 1972", DIVISION 16 OF THE STREETS AND HIGHWAYS CODE OF THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA

WHEREAS, on October 4, 2011 the Board of Supervisors of the County of Riverside, State of California, did, pursuant to the provisions of the "Landscaping and Lighting Act of 1972", being Division 15 of the Streets and Highways Code of the State of California, adopt Resolution No. 2011-237 ordering the preparation of the engineer's report for a special assessment district known and designated as:

Landscaping and Lighting Maintenance District No. 89-1-Consolidated, Zone 162 (herein referred to as "District"); and,

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors, did direct the appointed Engineer to make and file a "Report", in accordance with Article 4 (commencing with Section 22565) of Chapter 1 of Part 2 of Division 15 of the Streets and Highways Code, being an article of the aforementioned Landscaping and Lighting Act of 1972.

WHEREAS, Section 22567 of said Article 4 states the "Report" shall consist of the following;

- a. Maintenance plans for the fossil filter and traffic signal improvements
- An estimate of the costs of servicing fossil filter and traffic signal improvements
- c. A diagram for the assessment district
- d. An assessment of the estimated costs of maintenance of the improvements

NOW, THEREFORE, I, the appointed ENGINEER, pursuant to the 'Landscaping Act of 1972", do hereby submit the following:

- 1. Pursuant to the provisions of law the costs and expenses of the District have been assessed upon the parcels of land in the District benefited thereby in direct proportion and relation to the estimated benefits to be received by each of said parcels. For particulars as to the identification of said parcel, reference is made to the Assessment Diagram, a reduced copy of which is included herein.
- 2. As required by law, a Diagram is filed herewith, showing the District, as well as the boundaries and dimensions of the respective parcels and subdivisions of land within said District as the same exist each of which subdivisions of land or parcels or lots, respectively, have been given a separate number upon said Diagram and in the Assessment Roll contained herein.
- 3. The separate numbers given the subdivisions and parcels of land, as shown on said Assessment Diagram and Assessment Roll, correspond with the numbers assigned to each parcel by the Riverside County Assessor. Reference is made to the County Assessment Roll for a description of the lots or parcels.
- 4. There are no parcels or lots within Zone 162 that are owned by a federal, state or other local governmental agency that will benefit from the services to be provided by the assessments to be collected.

Method of Assessment Apportionment

The law requires and the statutes provide that assessments, as levied pursuant to the "Landscaping and Lighting Act of 1972" be based on the benefit properties receive. The statutes do not specify the method or formula that should be used to apportion the assessment in any special assessment district proceedings.

The maintenance of fossil filters and traffic signals provides direct and special benefit to those properties located within Zone 162 in Landscaping and Lighting Maintenance District No. 89-1-Consolidated (DISTRICT). Fossil filters and traffic signals enhance the properties within the DISTRICT, improve water quality control, increase public safety, improve neighborhood aesthetics, allow traffic into and out of the development, and provide an enhanced quality of life and sense of well being for properties within the DISTRICT.

The fossil filter improvements maintained by the DISTRICT provide no general public benefit in that the properties within Zone 162 are discrete neighborhoods or communities for which the fossil filter improvements were installed. Fossil filter improvements do not extend beyond the perimeter of the boundary of each of those discrete neighborhoods or communities. It is therefore determined that all properties within the DISTRICT benefit equally from the financed improvements. The costs and expenses for the traffic signal improvements do not exceed 16% per signal of the total maintenance cost. The costs and expenses for the fossil filter and traffic signal improvements maintenance and services are apportioned on a per parcel basis.

The dollar per parcel value for Fiscal Year 2012-13 for Zone 162 is as follows:

<u>Total Budget</u> = \$25,915 Total No. Parcels 249 = \$104.08/parcel

The assessment for Fiscal Year 2012-13 for Zone 162 that is to be annexed into Landscaping and Lighting Maintenance District No. 89-1-Consolidated will be \$104.08 per parcel. The annual assessment may be increased by the greater of two percent (2.0%) or the cumulative percentage increase, if any, in the Consumer Price Index for all Urban Consumers ("CPI-U") for the Los Angeles-Riverside-Orange County California Standard Metropolitan Statistical area ("Index") published by the Bureau of Labor Statistics of United States Department of Labor. The annual "CPI-U" adjustment will be based on the cumulative increase, if any, in the Index as it stands on March of each year over the base Index for March of 2011. Any increase larger than the greater of

2.0% or the "CPI-U" annual adjustment requires a majority approval of all the property owners within Zone 162.

Waiver and Consent Regarding Date of Assessment Ballot Election

There is only one individual/entity which owns all of the property within the proposed boundaries of Zone 162 and said property owner has executed a "Waiver and Consent Regarding Date of Assessment Ballot Election" allowing for the election and public hearing to be held on November 22, 2011; a copy of said waiver is filed herewith and made a part hereof.

In conclusion, it is my opinion that the assessments for Landscaping and Lighting Maintenance District No. 89-1-Consolidated, Zone 162 have been spread in direct accordance with the benefits that each parcel receives from the items being financed.

RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF RIVERSIDE DECLARING ITS INTENT TO ORDER THE ANNEXATION OF ZONE 162 TO LANDSCAPING AND LIGHTING MAINTENANCE DISTRICT NO. 89-1-CONSOLIDATED OF THE COUNTY OF RIVERSIDE PURSUANT TO THE LANDSCAPING AND LIGHTING ACT OF 1972 FOR THE MAINTENANCE AND SERVICING OF FOSSIL FILTERS AND TRAFFIC SIGNALS; ADOPTING THE PRELIMINARY ENGINEER'S REPORT; GIVING NOTICE OF AND SETTING THE TIME AND PLACE OF THE PUBLIC HEARING ON THE ANNEXATION OF ZONE 162; ORDERING AN ASSESSMENT PROCEEDING; ORDERING A MAILED BALLOT ELECTION; AND DIRECTING NOTICE OF THE PUBLIC HEARING AND THE ASSESSMENT BALLOT TO BE MAILED PURSUANT TO ARTICLE XIIID OF THE CALIFORNIA CONSTITUTION AND SECTION 4000 OF THE ELECTIONS CODE

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors (hereinafter the "Board of Supervisors") of the County of Riverside (hereinafter the "County") has adopted Resolution No. 2011-237 on October 4, 2011 initiating proceedings for the annexation of Zone 162 (hereinafter "Zone 162"), as described and shown in Exhibit "A", which is attached hereto and incorporated herein, to Landscaping and Lighting Maintenance District No. 89-1-Consolidated of the County of Riverside, State of California, (hereinafter "L&LMD No. 89-1-C") pursuant to the Landscaping and Lighting Act of 1972 (hereinafter the "Act"), which is Part 2 (commencing with Section 22500) of Division 15 of the Streets and Highways Code (hereinafter the "Street and Highways Code"), and ordering the preparation of a report (hereinafter the "Report") regarding the proposed annexation of Zone 162 and the assessments to be levied within Zone 162 each fiscal year beginning fiscal year 2012-13 for the the maintenance and servicing of fossil filters and traffic signals, and the provision of electricity for traffic signals within the public right-of-way within said Zone; and

WHEREAS, such proceedings shall comply with the requirements of Article XIIID of the California Constitution (hereinafter "Article XIIID:"), the Act, and Section 4000 of the Elections Code requiring voter approval of the proposed assessment to be levied by L&LMD No. 89-1-C for Zone 162; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors by Resolution No. 2011-237 directed the Director of the Transportation Department, or his designee (hereinafter the "Engineer"), to prepare and file the Report with the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors in accordance with Sections 22608 and 22585 et. seq. of the Street and Highways Code and Section 4 of Article XIIID; and

WHEREAS, said Engineer has filed the Report with the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors and the Report has been presented to and considered by the Board of Supervisors; and

WHEREAS, the Applicant has executed a "Waiver and Consent Regarding Date of Assessment Ballot Election" allowing for the election to be held on November 22, 2011; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary that the Board of Supervisors adopt a resolution of intention pursuant to Section 22624 of the Streets and Highways Code, which fixes and gives notice, pursuant to Section 22626 of the Streets and Highways Code, of the time and place of a public hearing on said Report, the annexation of Zone 162, and the assessments to be levied on parcels within Zone 162 beginning in fiscal year 2012-13;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, FOUND, DETERMINED AND ORDERED by the Board of Supervisors in regular session assembled on October 4, 2011 as follows:

Section 1. Findings. The Board of Supervisors, after reviewing the Report, finds that:

- (a) The foregoing recitals are true and correct;
- (b) The Report contains all matters required by Sections 22565 through 22574 of the Streets and Highways Code and Section 4 of Article XIIID and may, therefore, be approved by the Board of Supervisors;

- (c) The annual assessment for fiscal year 2012-13 on all parcels within Zone 162 proposed to be annexed to L&LMD No. 89-1-C will be \$104.08 per parcel.
- **Section 2.** <u>Intent.</u> The Board of Supervisors hereby declares its intention to order the annexation of Zone 162, as described and shown in Exhibit "A", to L&LMD No. 89-1-C, and to levy and collect an annual assessment on all assessable lots and parcels of property within Zone 162 commencing with the fiscal year 2012-13 as set forth in the Report. The Report expressly states that there are no parcels or lots within Zone 162 that are owned by a federal, state or other local governmental agency that will benefit from the services to be financed by the annual assessments. The annual assessments will be collected at the same time and in the same manner as property taxes are collected, and all laws providing for the collection and enforcement of property taxes shall apply to the collection and enforcement of said assessments.
- **Section 3.** Boundaries. All the property within boundaries of Zone 162 is proposed to be annexed into L&LMD No. 89-1-C and shall include that property in the unincorporated area of the County as described and shown in Exhibit "A".
- **Section 4.** Description of Services to be Provided. The maintenance and servicing of fossil filters and traffic signals, and the provision of electricity for traffic signals authorized for Zone 162 of L&LMD No. 89-1-C are:
- (a) The maintenance and servicing of fossil filters within the public right-of-way including the removal of petroleum hydrocarbons and other pollutants from water runoff; and
- (b) Providing electricity to and the maintenance and servicing of traffic signals within the public right-of-way including incidental costs and expenses.
- **Section 5.** Amount to be Levied. The assessment to be levied upon each parcel that benefits from the annexation of Zone 162 of L&LMD No. 89-1-C will be \$104.08 per parcel for fiscal year 2012-13. As stated in the Report, the total budget for Zone 162 for the fiscal year 2012-13 is \$25,915; there are 249 parcels that are to be assessed. The annual assessment may be increased by the greater of two percent (2.0%) or the cumulative percentage increase, if any, in the Consumer Price Index for all Urban Consumers ("CPI-U") for the Los Angeles-Riverside-Orange County California Standard Metropolitan Statistical area ("Index") published by the Bureau of Labor Statistics of the United States Department of Labor. The annual CPI-U adjustment will be based on the cumulative increase, if any, in the Index as it stands on March of each year over the base Index for March of 2011. Any increase larger than the greater of 2.0% or the CPI-U annual adjustment requires a majority approval of all the property owners within Zone 162. The Board of Supervisors will levy the assessment in each subsequent fiscal year until the Board of Supervisors undertakes proceedings for the dissolution of Zone 162 of L&LMD No. 89-1-C. The annual assessment will fund the services described in Section 4 of this Resolution. For further particulars, reference is to be made to the Report on file in the Office of the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors.
- **Section 6.** <u>The Property to be Annexed.</u> The property to be annexed into L&LMD No. 89-1-C is Zone 162. The boundaries of Zone 162 are located within the unincorporated area of the County and are described and shown in the Report and Exhibit "A".
- **Section 7.** Report. The Report, which is on file with the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors and which has been presented to the Board of Supervisors, is hereby approved. Reference is made to the Report for a full and detailed description of the services, the boundaries of Zone 162, and the annual assessment to be levied upon assessable lots and parcels within Zone 162 proposed to be annexed to L&LMD No. 89-1-C.
- **Section 8.** Public Hearing. The question of whether Zone 162 shall be annexed into L&LMD No. 89-1-C and an annual assessment levied beginning with fiscal year 2012-13 shall be considered at a public hearing (hereinafter the "Public Hearing") to be held on November 22, 2011, at 9:30 a.m. at the meeting room of the Board of Supervisors of the County at 4080 Lemon Street, 1st Floor, Riverside, California.




PORTION OF SECTION 17, T.7S., R.2W. TRACT MAP NO. 31871 249 PARCELS
