**SUBJECT:** March Joint Powers Authority Successor Agency Oversight Committee


**RECOMMENDED MOTION:** That the Board of Supervisors appoint Supervisor Marion Ashley to represent the Board of Supervisors and Jamil Dada as a citizen appointee to the March Joint Powers Authority Successor Agency Oversight Committee.

**BACKGROUND:** On January 10, 2011, Governor Brown, as part of the statewide budget process, proposed the elimination of redevelopment agencies throughout California to be effective for Fiscal Year 2011-2012. The Governor's budget proposed stated that, while existing projects would not be affected, the \$1.7 billion that would have gone to redevelopment agencies would be shifted to the State General Fund to backfill the 2011-2012 budget. Future year redevelopment tax increment would be slated for school districts, special districts and other local services.

In anticipation of the potential abolition, through a Joint Powers Agreement amendment the March Joint Powers Commission and its member jurisdictions took the steps necessary to enable the March Joint Powers Authority (March JPA) to assume the March Joint Powers Redevelopment Agency's responsibility as their Successor Agency.

With the March JPA identified as the Successor Agency, March JPA is required to have an Oversight Committee. The Oversight Committee shall consist of seven members, two of which are to be appointed by the County Board of Supervisors.
