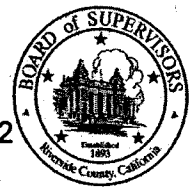

BACKGROUND/APPOINTEE INFORMATION:

On December of 29, 2011, the California Supreme Court delivered its decision in California Redevelopment Association v. Matosantos case, finding AB 1x26 (Dissolution Act) constitutional and AB 1x27 unconstitutional. The Dissolution Act dissolves redevelopment agencies and creates successor agencies (RDA) and oversight boards to continue to satisfy obligations of each former RDA; and administer the dissolution and wind down of each dissolved RDA.

The Oversight Board will supervise the activities of the Successor Agency. One of the seven members on this board is to be a Riverside County Appointee designated by the Board of Supervisors.
