BACKGROUND/APPOINTEE INFORMATION:

On December 29, 2011, the California Supreme Court delivered its decision in California Redevelopment Association v. Matosantos case, finding AB1x26 (Dissolution Act) constitutional and AB1x27 unconstitutional. The Dissolution Act dissolves redevelopment agencies and creates successor agencies and oversight boards to continue to satisfy enforceable obligations of each former RDA, and administer the dissolution and wind down of each dissolved RDA.

The Oversight Board will supervise the activities of the Successor Agency. One of the seven members on this board is to be a public member appointed by the Board of Supervisors. I would like to recommend appointment of Mallory Sutterfield, Michael O'Keefe, Ward Fredericks, and David Ready to serve on the oversight boards for the respective cities listed above.
