SUBJECT: Approve the First Amendment to Agreement No.11-128 with Animal Samaritans SPCA, Inc. for Spay/Neuter and other Clinical Services

RECOMMENDED MOTION: That the Board of Supervisors:

- 1) Approve the First Amendment to Agreement No.11-128 between Animal Samaritans SPCA, Inc. and the County of Riverside Department of Animal Services, to increase the amount of compensation by \$20,000 for a total of \$90,000 for the current fiscal year; and
- 2) Authorize the Chairman to execute three (3) original copies of the First Amendment on behalf of the County of Riverside.

BACKGROUND: Since July 2002 the Riverside County Department of Animal Services has contracted with Animal Samaritans SPCA, Inc., a non-profit spay, neuter and adoption facility in Thousand Palms, to perform spay, neuter surgeries and other clinical services for the animals adopted from the County-run Thousand Palms and Blythe shelters. On September 13, 2011 this Agreement was approved in the amount of \$70,000 for the current fiscal year. An increase in the amount of \$20,000 is required to maintain necessary spay, neuter and other clinical services for the shelter animals.

BACKGROUND (Continued):

The Riverside County Department of Animal Services does not have the facility or staffing to perform spay/neuter surgery in the Coachella Valley and the number of dogs and cats requiring surgery has exceeded the initially budgeted capacity.

AB 1856 Vincent, has required since 1/1/2000 that "no public animal control agency or shelter.... shall sell or give away to a new owner any dog (or cat) that has not been spayed or neutered." This additional funding will provide sterilization services for all the pets adopted from the Coachella Valley Animal Campus until the end of the current fiscal year.

PRICE REASONABLENESS:

The price rendered by Animal Samaritans for spay and neuter services is considered to be fair and reasonable based on their pricing being lower than normal for-profit veterinary clinics in the surrounding area. Animal Samaritans is associated with the Society for the Prevention of Cruelty to Animals (SPCA) and is a certified non-profit agency. Pricing for spay, neuter procedure for a canine is \$75.00, and for a feline is \$50.00. This compares favorably against for-profit clinics which charge significantly above \$100.00 for a canine or feline procedure, on average. Based on this comparison, the price is deemed to be fair and reasonable.

FINANCIAL:

There is no additional impact on the general fund as this funding has been included in the department's budget.

 as follows:


- 10 • To increase the amount of compensation for July 1, 2011 to June 30, 2012 from seventy
 11 thousand dollars (\$70,000) to ninety thousand dollars (\$90,000).
- 12 • All other terms and conditions of this Agreement are to remain unchanged.




