BACKGROUND: (Continued)

Pursuant to the general conditions of the contract, the Economic Development Agency is currently retaining 10% of all progress payments to Tony Painting. The general conditions of the contract state that after the 50% completion point of the contract work, if satisfactory progress is being made the County has sole discretion to reduce the retention to a minimum of 5% of the contract. This Board action will release \$8,966 in retained funds to the contractor.
