Ernie was born and raised in New York and came to California in 1969. Even though he didn't graduate college, he successfully enrolled in law school and finished 13th in his graduating class of 1979, despite working two jobs as a waiter and running a real estate office during the day.

A sophisticated business and land-use attorney, Ernie worked closely with members of the Agua Caliente Band of Cahuilla Indians and had tremendous knowledge and expertise about Indian land. As a developer, he built the office building that houses the Agua Caliente Tribal Headquarters on Dinah Shore and the center that houses the Indian Gaming Commission on Crossley Road.

Ernie was a tireless supporter of young children and the elderly, serving on the Barbara Sinatra Children's Foundation and Mizell Senior Center's board of directors. Last Christmas, he organized a lunch at the Mizell Center for war veterans and Marines from the Marine Corps Air Ground Combat Center in Twentynine Palms.

Ernie is survived by his wife Carolyn, twin sons Michael A. Noia and Richard A. Noia, his sister Karen Livingston and her husband Jerry. His memory and passionate spirit will live forever in the hearts of those who knew and loved him. He will be dearly missed.

The Board of Supervisors commemorates his service to the County of Riverside.
