On motion of Supervisor Ashley, seconded by Supervisor Tavaglione, and duly carried by unanimous vote, IT WAS ORDERED that the meeting of Tuesday, March 27, 2012, be adjourned in memory of Frances Eleanor Underwood, a 98-year-old prominent resident of Sun City who owned and operated "Fran's Dress Shop" in Sun City for 35 years and whose family farm has been in Perris Valley since the 1940's. As the "matriarch" of her family, she will always be remembered as an "upbeat and positive woman" who was "full of life, wisdom, kindness, and fun."

Fran was preceded in death by her loving husband of 59<sup>a</sup> years, Ford P. Underwood, and is survived by her daughter Judith (Richard) Haglund and sons Thomas (Ruby) Underwood and James (Mary) Underwood. She also has 10 grandchildren, 18 great-grandchildren, and 4 great-great grandchildren. Her memory and passionate spirit will live forever in the hearts of those who knew and loved her. She will be dearly missed.
