### A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNTY OF RIVERSIDE ADJUSTING

### WASTE HAULER FEES FOR THE COMMUNITY OF DESERT CENTER IN FRANCHISE AREA 13

WHEREAS, California Government Code section 25827 authorizes the Board of Supervisors to prescribe terms and conditions for the collection of solid waste in the unincorporated areas of Riverside County; and

WHEREAS, California Public Resources Code section 40059 authorizes the County of Riverside to determine all aspects of solid waste handling which are of local concern, including whether the services are to be provided by nonexclusive franchise, and the charges and fees for such service; and

WHEREAS, Riverside County Ordinance 745 has established that a solid waste hauler, duly permitted or franchised by the County of Riverside pursuant to the provisions of Riverside County Ordinance No. 657, shall be entitled to payment for services rendered in the amounts as specified in a Resolution adopted by the Board of Supervisors; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors recognizes the benefits of entering into Waste Hauler Franchise Agreements for the efficiency of solid waste management; and

WHEREAS, the County of Riverside has entered into Waste Hauler Franchise Agreements with the waste haulers that covers the Desert Center community of Franchise Areas 13; and

WHEREAS, the County subsidy to provide low cost waste collection service in the Desert Center community shall end;

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors acknowledges the need for the increase of 4.85% of the residential rate for the next seven years in addition to the usual annual Consumer Price Index (CPI) increase to lessen the effect of the end of the subsidy on the residents;

BE IT RESOLVED AND ORDERED that the Board of Supervisors of the County of Riverside, State of California, in regular session assembled on <u>June 5, 2012</u>, finds that the residential waste hauler fees in the community of Desert Center in Franchise Area 13 shall receive an increase of 4.85% to the service component of their fees beginning fiscal year 2012-2013 and for the next seven fiscal years;

- The commercial monthly rates for non state agencies will not change. However, these rates are still subject to annual adjustment based on the the CPI each year (including July 1, 2012) as determined by the Board of Supervisors in regard to the County Franchise Agreements.
- 4) The commercial monthly rates for state agencies will remain unchanged and will not be subject to adjustment by the CPI until such time as the non-state agency commercial rates reach the same rate as the state agency commercial rates.
- Notwithstanding the changes listed above, all residential and commercial rates (whether state agency or non-state agency) are subject to be increased based on an increase in the landfill disposal fee charged by the Department of Waste Management as determined by the Board of Supervisors (such an increase is planned to occur on July 1, 2012).

County staff attended the Riverside County Service Area (CSA) 51 Advisory Committee meeting on March 15, 2012, and discussed the proposed change to the Desert Center Area trash service.

Related Changes to the Exclusive Waste Delivery Agreement for Franchise Area 13 are minor and have been made on the attached Second Amended Exclusive Waste Delivery Agreement.

Pursuant to CEQA Guidelines Section 15273 (Rates, Tolls, Fares, and Charges), the proposed amendment to the Waste Delivery Agreement is found to be statutorily exempt from CEQA. A Notice of Exemption to this effect will be filed with the County Clerk upon Board of Supervisors approval.
