BACKGROUND:

The Department of Health Care Services (DHCS) released program applications for all eligible entities to participate in the Low Income Health Program (LIHP), which provides entities the opportunity to help build the bridge to health care reform in 2014. The LIHP consists of the Medicaid Coverage Expansion (MCE) and the Health Care Coverage Initiative (HCCI) programs. These programs provide health care benefits to eligible persons in accordance with the Welfare & Institutions Code (WIC) Section 15909 -15915 (Chapter 723, Statutes of 2010, Assembly Bill 342), and the Special Terms and Conditions (STCs) of the federal section 1115 (a) California Bridge to Reform Demonstration. To meet the requirements of participation for this program various departments of the County, including the Community Health Agency/Department of Public Health, Department of Mental Health, Department of Public Social Services, Riverside County Regional Medical Center (RCRMC) and the Office on Aging, have combined their resources to ensure that the County has a financially viable model for an integrated, quality, responsive, patient-centered health care system meeting the needs of county residents. These departments have partnered with Inland Empire Health Plan (IEHP) as a third party administrator in administering the service which implements the requirements of LIHP. Through this collaboration partnership, the requirements for the LIHP were developed and incorporated for Riverside County HealthCare (RCHC). RCHC is Riverside County's new health care program to help bridge to the health care reform in 2014. Patients eligible to participate in RCHC will have the opportunity to RCHC expects approximately 38,000 eligible receive services through specific referrals. participants/patients to participate in the health care program.

Each of these Home Health Care providers are certified to provide Home Health Services for the Medicare and Medi-Cal programs and provide home health services in limited areas of the County or have a service area encompassing the entire County of Riverside. While the County has competitively bid contracts in place for most of these services, additional resources are needed to provide for the increase in patients, areas of coverage and a few special Services. RCRMC researched additional service providers and these home health care agencies have agreed to rates that are equal to or lower than competitively bid contract rates with the awarded vendor for the RCHC program. The referral requirements for the Low Income Health Program and the rapid growth of membership make it is essential to maintain an adequate number of conveniently provide home health services for the RCHC program

HOME HEALTH SERVICES AGREEMENT BETWEEN COUNTY OF RIVERSIDE AND 81 HOME HEALTH CARE CORPORATION

This Agreement is made and entered into by and between the County of Riverside, a political subdivision of the State of California, and 81 Home Health Care Corporation dba 81 Home Health Services (CONTRACTOR). COUNTY and CONTRACTOR are referred to herein as Parties.

WHEREAS, the COUNTY has agreed to provide "medically necessary" Health Care Services in accordance with the Welfare and Institutions Code Section 15909 – 15915 (Chapter 723, Statutes of 2010, Assembly Bill 342), and the Special Term and Conditions (STCs of the federal section 1115 (a_ California Bridge to Reform as part of the Low Income Health Program (LIHP) Medicaid Coverage Expansion (MCE) program; and;

WHEREAS, "Riverside County HealthCare ("RCHC") means a county-based elective program developed as part of the Medicaid Coverage Expansion, a component of the Section 1115-(a) Comprehensive Demonstration Waiver which expands health coverage to low income uninsured adult who are not eligible for Medi-Cal or Healthy Families; and;

WHEREAS, COUNTY desires to arrange for the provision of certain health care services for its members by entering into service agreements with various health care service providers; and

WHEREAS, CONTRACTOR has the expertise, special skills, knowledge and experience to perform the duties set out herein;

NOW THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual promises, covenants representations and conditions hereinafter contained, the PARTIES hereto mutually agree as follows.

1.0 DESCRIPTION OF SERVICES:

CONTRACTOR will provide Home Health Services as outlined in Attachment A, attached hereto and made part of the Agreement.

2.0 TERM AND TERMINATION:

- 2.1 TERM. This Agreement shall be effective as of May 1, 2012 through December 31, 2013, unless terminated as specified below in Section 2.2 or as otherwise specified herein.
- 2.2 TERMINATION WITHOUT CAUSE. Either party may terminate this Agreement with or without cause by giving ninety (90) days prior written notice to the other party.
- 2.2.1 In the event of termination of this Agreement, CONTRACTOR shall continue to provide and be compensated for Home Health Services under the terms of this Agreement to patients who have been authorized for treatment on the date of termination until the effective date of discharge of care or the safe transfer of such patients to another Health Care Service Provider, or a period of ninety (90) days, whichever comes first.
- 2.3 NON-AVAILABILITY OF FUNDS. In the event of non-availability of COUNTY funds, this Agreement shall be deemed terminated and of no further force and effect immediately on receipt of COUNTY's notification to CONTRACTOR.

3.0 COMPENSATION:

- 3.1 In consideration of services provided by CONTRACTOR pursuant to this Agreement, CONTRACTOR shall be entitled to receive payment in accordance with RCHC Program policy and procedure. CONTRACTOR shall submit clean, complete and accurate claims to RCHC Program within one hundred eighty (180) days from the date of service. Claims must be submitted on a HCFA 1500 claim or its successor claim form (or via electronic form) and shall contain a minimum of the following information: Patient Name, Patient ID#, date of birth, authorization number, item description, quantity and unit pricing. CONTRACTOR shall not seek payment for claims not submitted after one hundred and eighty (180) days from the date of service. Any claims received after the billing deadline will not be considered for payment. CONTRACTOR shall accept the payments for services as described above in Section 1.0 and specified in Attachment A, attached hereto, as payment in full.
- 3.2 Maximum payments to CONTRACTOR shall not exceed one hundred thousand (\$100,000) dollars for the term of this agreement. Payments to CONTRACTOR shall be made within forty-five (45) working days of receipt from CONTRACTOR of an uncontested claim which is accurate, complete and otherwise in accordance with Section 3.1.

4.0 HOLD HARMLESS-INDEPENDENT CONTRACTOR:

4.1 CONTRACTOR shall indemnify and hold harmless all Agencies, Districts, Special Districts and Departments of the County of Riverside, their respective directors, officers, Board of Supervisors, elected and appointed officials, employees, agents and representatives from any liability whatsoever, based or asserted upon any services of CONTRACTOR, its officers, employees,

subcontractors, agents or representatives arising out of or in any way relating to this Agreement, including but not limited to property damage, bodily injury, or death or any other element of any kind or nature whatsoever and resulting from any reason whatsoever arising from the performance of CONTRACTOR, its officers, agents, employees, subcontractors, agents or representatives from this Agreement; CONTRACTOR shall defend, at its sole expense, all costs and fees including but not limited to attorney fees, cost of investigation, defense and settlements or awards all Agencies, Districts, Special Districts and Departments of the County of Riverside, their respective directors, officers, Board of Supervisors, elected and appointed officials, employees, agents and representatives in any claims or action based upon such alleged acts or omissions.

4.2 With respect to any action or claim subject to indemnification herein by CONTRACTOR, CONTRACTOR shall, at their sole cost, have the right to use counsel of their own choice and shall have the right to adjust, settle, or compromise any such action or claim without the prior consent of COUNTY; provided, however, that any such adjustment, settlement or compromise in no manner whatsoever limits or circumscribes CONTRACTOR'S indemnification to COUNTY as set forth herein.

CONTRACTOR'S obligation to defend, indemnify and hold harmless COUNTY shall be subject to COUNTY having given CONTRACTOR written notice within a reasonable period of time of the claim or the commencement of the related action, as the case may be, and information and reasonable assistance, at CONTRACTOR'S expense, for the defense or settlement thereof.

CONTRACTOR'S obligation hereunder shall be satisfied when CONTRACTOR has provided to COUNTY the appropriate form of dismissal relieving COUNTY from any liability for the action or claim involved.

- 4.3 The specified insurance limits required in this Agreement shall in no way limit or circumscribe CONTRACTOR'S obligation to indemnify and hold harmless the COUNTY herein from third party claims.
- 4.4 In the event there is conflict between this clause and California Civil Code Section 2782, this clause shall not be interpreted to comply with Civil Code 2782. Such interpretation shall not relieve the CONTRACTOR from indemnifying the COUNTY to the fullest extent allowed by law.
- 4.5 Liability resulting from Professional acts of the CONTRACTOR shall be subject to the terms of Section 5.5, below.

5.0 **INSURANCE**:

5.1 Without limiting or diminishing the CONTRACTOR'S obligation to indemnify or hold the COUNTY harmless, CONTRACTOR shall procure and maintain or cause to be maintained, at its sole cost and expense, the following insurance and/or self- insurance coverages during the term of this Agreement.

5.2 WORKERS' COMPENSATION

If the CONTRACTOR has employees as defined by the State of California, the CONTRACTOR shall maintain statutory Workers' Compensation Insurance (Coverage A) and/or self insurance as prescribed by the laws of the State of California. Policy shall include Employers' Liability (Coverage B) including Occupational Disease with limits not less than \$1,000,000 per person per accident. The policy shall be endorsed to waive subrogation in favor of The

County of Riverside, and, if applicable, to provide a Borrowed Servant/Alternate Employer Endorsement.

5.3 COMMERCIAL GENERAL LIABILITY

Commercial General Liability insurance coverage, including but not limited to, premises liability, contractual liability, products and completed operations liability, personal and advertising injury covering claims which may arise from or out of CONTRACTOR'S performance of its obligations hereunder. Policy shall name all Agencies, Districts, Special Districts, and Departments of the County of Riverside, their respective directors, officers, Board of Supervisors, employees, elected or appointed officials, agents or representatives as Additional Insured. Policy's limit of liability shall not be less than \$1,000,000 per occurrence combined single limit. If such insurance contains a general aggregate limit, it shall apply separately to this agreement or be no less than two (2) times the occurrence limit.

5.4 <u>VEHICLE LIABILITY</u>

If CONTRACTOR'S vehicles or mobile equipment are used in the performance of the obligations under this Agreement, then CONTRACTOR shall maintain liability insurance and/or self-insurance for all owned, non-owned or hired vehicles so used in an amount not less than \$1,000,000 per occurrence combined single limit. If such insurance contains a general aggregate limit, it shall apply separately to this Agreement or be no less than two (2) times the occurrence limit. Policy shall name all Agencies, Districts, Special Districts, and Departments of the County of Riverside, their respective directors, officers, Board of Supervisors, employees, elected or appointed officials, agents or representatives as Additional Insured.

5.5 PROFESSIONAL LIABILITY INSURANCE

coverage for the Contractor's performance of work included within this Agreement, with a limit of liability of not less than \$1,000,000 per occurrence and \$2,000,000 annual aggregate. If Contractor's Professional Liability Insurance is written on a claims made basis rather than an occurrence basis, such insurance shall continue through the term of this Agreement and CONTRACTOR shall purchase at his sole expense either 1) an Extended Reporting Endorsement (also known as Tail Coverage); or 2) Prior Dates Coverage from new insurer with a retroactive date back to the date of, or prior to, the inception of this Agreement; 3) demonstrate through Certificates of Insurance that CONTRACTOR has maintained continuous coverage with the same or original insurer. Coverage provided under items; 1), 2) or 3) will continue for a period of five (5) years beyond the termination of this Agreement.

5.6 GENERAL INSURANCE PROVISIONS – ALL LINES

- 1) Any insurance carrier providing insurance coverage hereunder shall be admitted to the State of California and have an A M BEST rating of not less than A: VIII (A:8) unless such requirements are waived, in writing, by the County Risk Manager. If the County's Risk Manager waives a requirement for a particular insurer such waiver is only valid for that specific insurer and only for one policy term.
- 2) The CONTRACTOR'S insurance carrier(s) must declare its insurance deductibles. If such deductibles or self-insured retentions exceed \$500,000 per occurrence such deductibles and/or retentions shall have the prior written consent of the County Risk Manager before the commencement

of operations under this Agreement. Upon notification of deductibles unacceptable to the COUNTY, and at the election of the Country's Risk Manager, CONTRACTOR'S carriers shall either; 1) reduce or eliminate such deductibles as respects this Agreement with the RCHC Program, or 2) procure a bond, which guarantees payment of losses and related investigations, claims administration, and defense costs and expenses.

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3) CONTRACTOR shall cause CONTRACTOR'S insurance carrier(s) to furnish the County of Riverside with either 1) a properly executed original Certificate(s) of Insurance and certified original copies of Endorsements effecting coverage as required herein, or 2) if requested to do so orally or in writing by the County Risk Manager, provide original Certified copies of policies including all Endorsements and all attachments thereto, showing such insurance is in full force and effect. Further, said Certificate(s) and policies of insurance shall contain the covenant of the insurance carrier(s) that thirty (30) days written notice shall be given to the County of Riverside prior to any material modification, cancellation, expiration or reduction in coverage of such insurance. In the event of a material modification, cancellation, expiration, or reduction in coverage, this Agreement shall terminate forthwith, unless the County of Riverside receives, prior to such effective date, another properly executed original Certificate of Insurance and original copies of endorsements or certified original policies, including all endorsements and attachments thereto evidencing coverage's set forth herein and the insurance required herein is in full force and effect. CONTRACTOR shall not commence operations until the COUNTY has been furnished original Certificate (s) of Insurance and certified original copies of endorsements or policies of insurance including all endorsements and any and all other attachments as required in this Section. An individual authorized by the insurance carrier to do so on its behalf shall sign the original endorsements for each policy and the Certificate of Insurance.

- 4) It is understood and agreed to by the parties hereto and the insurance company(s), that the Certificate(s) of Insurance and policies shall so covenant and shall be construed as primary insurance, and the RCHC's insurance and/or deductibles and/or self-insured retention's or self-insured programs shall not be construed as contributory.
- during the term of this Agreement or any extension thereof, there is a material change in the scope of services; or, there is a material change in the equipment to be used in the performance of the scope of work (such as the use of aircraft or watercraft) the COUNTY reserves the right to adjust the types of insurance required under this Agreement and the monetary limits of liability for the insurance coverage's currently required herein, if; in the County Risk Manager's reasonable judgment, the amount or type of insurance carried by the CONTRACTOR has become inadequate.
- 6) CONTRACTOR shall pass down the insurance obligations contained herein to all tiers of subcontractors working under this Agreement.
- 7) The insurance requirements contained in this Agreement may be met with a program(s) of self-insurance acceptable to the COUNTY

6.0 RECORDS AND DOCUMENTS:

- 6.1 CONTRACTOR shall make available, upon written request by and duly authorized Federal, State or COUNTY agency, a copy of this Agreement and such books, documents and records as are necessary to certify the nature and extent of the costs of the services provided by CONTRACTOR. CONTRACTOR shall maintain books and records for at least five (5) years from the termination of this Agreement.
- 6.2 CONTRACTOR agrees to provide RCHC Program with reports and information relative to this Agreement and in accordance with terms set forth herein, as may be requested by RCHC Program.

7.0 **CONFIDENTIALITY:**

CONTRACTOR agrees to protect from unauthorized disclosure names and other identifying information concerning either persons receiving services under this Agreement or persons whose names or other identifying information becomes known to CONTRACTOR as a result of services performed under this Agreement, except statistical information not identifying any such person.

- 7.1 CONTRACTOR shall not disclose, except as otherwise specifically permitted by this Agreement or authorized by the client or client's representative, any such identifying information to anyone other than authorized RCHC Program personnel without prior written authorization from the RCHC Program.
- 7.2 For the purpose of this paragraph, "identify" shall include, but not be limited to, name, identifying number, symbol, or other identifying particular assigned to the individual, such as finger or voiceprint or photograph.

7.3 CONTRACTOR shall observe all Federal, State and COUNTY laws and regulations, including, but not limited to, the Health Insurance Portability and Accountability Act (HIPPA) of 1996, concerning the security and privacy of patient records and information.

8.0 LICENSE:

CONTRACTOR shall, through the Term of this Agreement, maintain all licenses necessary for the provision of the services hereunder and required by the laws and regulations of the United States, the State of California, County of Riverside, and all other governmental agencies. CONTRACTOR shall notify RCHC Program immediately, in writing, of inability to obtain or maintain such license. Said inability shall be cause for termination of this Agreement.

- 8.1 CONTRACTOR shall ensure that CONTRACTOR'S employees, agents, and subcontractors performing services under the terms of this Agreement are in compliance with all relative licensing requirements. CONTRACTOR hereby agrees to notify RCHC Program immediately, in writing, of inability of CONTRACTOR or any of CONTRACTOR'S employees, agents and subcontractors to obtain or maintain such license(s). Said inability shall be cause for termination of this Agreement.
- 8.2 COPY REQUIRED. A copy of each such license, permit, approval, waiver, exemption, registration, accreditation, and certificate shall be provided to Contracts Administration, upon request.
- 8.3 Further, CONTRACTOR hereby agrees to abide by the standards of the medical practice of the profession when performing services hereunder.

9.0 NONDISCRIMINATION AND ELIGIBILITY:

The CONTRACTOR shall not discriminate in the provision of services, allocation of benefits, accommodation in facilities, or employment of personnel, on the basis of ethnic group identification, race, color, creed, ancestry, religion, national origin, sexual preference, sex, age (over 40), marital status, medical attention, or physical or mental handicap, and shall comply with all other requirements of law regarding non discrimination and affirmative action including those laws pertaining to the prohibition of discrimination against qualified handicapped persons in all programs or activities.

- 9.1 For the purpose of this Agreement, distinctions on the grounds of race, religion, color, sex, national origin, age, or physical or mental handicap include but at not limited to the following:
- 1. Denying an eligible person or providing to an eligible person any services or benefit which is different, or is provided in a different manner or at a different time from that provided to other eligible persons under this Agreement.
- 2. Subjecting an eligible person to segregation or separate treatment in any matter related to receipt of any service, except when necessary for infection control.
- Restricting an eligible person differently in any way in the enjoyment of any advantage or privilege enjoyed by others receiving similar service or benefit.
- 4. Treating an eligible person differently from others in determining whether he/she satisfied any eligibility, membership, or other requirement or condition which individuals must meet in order to be provided a

similar service or benefit.

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CONTRACTOR and CONTRACTOR'S employees shall have no interest, and shall not acquire any interest, direct or indirect, which will conflict in any manner or degree with the performance of services required under this Agreement.

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11.0 **ASSIGNMENT:**

CONTRACTOR may not delegate the obligations hereunder, either in whole or in part, without prior written consent of the COUNTY and the RCHC Program provided, however, obligations undertaken by CONTRACTOR pursuant to this Agreement may be carried out by means of subcontracts if approved by RCHC Program. No subcontract shall terminate or alter the responsibilities of the CONTRACTOR to the RCHC Program pursuant to this Agreement. CONTRACTOR may not assign the rights hereunder, either in whole or in part, without prior written consent of the COUNTY. Any attempted assignment or delegation in derogation of this paragraph shall be void. A change in the business structure of CONTRACTOR, including but not limited to, change in the majority ownership, change in the form of CONTRACTOR'S business organization, management of CONTRACTOR, CONTRACTOR'S ownership of other business dealing with CONTRACTOR under this Agreement, or filing of reorganization or bankruptcy by CONTRACTOR, shall be deemed an assignment for purposes of this paragraph.

12.0 ADMINISTRATION:

The RCHC Governing Board (or designee) shall administer this Agreement on behalf of the COUNTY.

13.0 **WAIVER**:

Any waiver by COUNTY of any breach of any one or more of the terms of this Agreement shall not be construed to be a waiver of any subsequent or other breach of the same or of any other term thereof. Failure on the part of the COUNTY to require exact, full and complete compliance with any terms of this Agreement shall not be construed as in any manner changing the terms or stopping the COUNTY from enforcement hereof.

14.0 JURISDICTION, VENUE, ATTORNEY FEES:

This Agreement and interpretation as to the validity, performance and breach shall be construed under the laws of the State of California. Any legal action related to the Agreement shall be filed in the appropriate courts in the County of Riverside, State of California.

15.0 SEVERABILITY:

In the event any provision in this Agreement is held by a court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, void or unenforceable, the remaining provisions will nevertheless continue in full force without being impaired or invalidated in any way.

16.0 CAPTIONS AND PARAGRAPH HEADINGS:

Captions and paragraph headings used in this Agreement are for convenience only and are not a part of this Agreement and shall not be used in construing this Agreement.

17.0 **NOTICES**:

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All correspondence and notices required or contemplated by this

Agreement shall be delivered to the respective parties at the addresses set forth

18.0 <u>Independent Contractor</u>

The CONTRACTOR is, for purposes arising out of this contract, an Independent Contractor and shall not be deemed an employee of the County. It is expressly understood and agreed that the CONTRACTOR shall in no event, as a result of this Agreement, be entitled to any benefits to which COUNTY employees are entitled, including but limited to overtime, any retirement benefits, Worker's Compensation benefits and injury leave or other leave benefits. CONTRACTOR hereby holds COUNTY harmless from any and all claims that may be made against COUNTY based upon any contention by any third party that an employer-employee relationship exists by reason of this Agreement.

18.1 It is further understood and agreed by the parties hereto that CONTRACTOR in the performance of its obligation hereunder is subject to the control or direction of COUNTY merely as to the result to be accomplished by the services hereunder agreed to be rendered and performed

and not as to the means and methods for accomplishing the results.

19.0 Subcontract for Work or Services

No contract shall be made by the CONTRACTOR with any party for furnishing any of the work or services contained herein without the prior written approval of the COUNTY Contract Administrator, but this provision shall not require the approval of contracts of employment between the CONTRACTOR and personnel assigned for services hereunder, or for parties named in the proposal and agreed to under any resulting contract.

20.0 Interest of Contractor

The CONTRACTOR covenants that it presently has no interest, Including, but not limited to, other projects or independent contracts, and shall not acquire any such interest, direct or indirect, which would conflict in any manner or degree with the performance of services required to be performed under this Agreement. The CONTRACTOR further covenants that in the performance of this Agreement, no person having such interest shall be employed or retained by it under this Agreement.

21.0 Conduct of Contractor

- The CONTRACTOR agrees to inform the COUNTY of all the CONTRACTOR'S interest, if any, which are or which the CONTRACTOR believes to be incompatible with any interest of the COUNTY.
- 2) The CONTRACTOR shall not, under circumstances, which might reasonably be interpreted as an attempt to influence the recipient in the conduct of his duties, accept any gratuity or special favor from individuals or organizations with whom the CONTRACTOR is doing business or proposing to do business, in accomplishing the work under the contract.

3) The CONTRACTOR shall not use for personal gain or make other improper use of privileged information, which is acquired in connection with this Agreement. In this connection, the term "privileged information" includes, but is not limited to, unpublished information relating to technological and scientific development; medical, personnel, or security records of the individuals; anticipated materials requirement or pricing actions; and knowledge of selection of CONTRACTORS or SUBCONTRACTORS in advance of official announcement.

4) The CONTRACTOR or employees thereof shall not offer gifts, gratuity, favors, and entertainment directly or indirectly to COUNTY employees.

22.0 Disallowance

In the event the CONTRACTOR receives payment for services under this Agreement, which is later disallowed for nonconformance with the terms and conditions herein by the COUNTY, the CONTRACTOR shall promptly refund the disallowed amount to the COUNTY on request, or at its option, the COUNTY may offset the amount disallowed for any payment due to the CONTRACTOR under any contract with the COUNTY.

23.0 Right to Acquire Equipment and Services

Nothing in this Agreement shall prohibit the COUNTY from acquiring the same type or equivalent equipment and/or services from other sources, when deemed by the COUNTY to be in its best interest.

24.0 Force Majeure

Neither party shall be liable nor deemed to be in default for any delay or failure in performance under this Agreement or other interruption of service or employment deemed resulting, directly or indirectly, from acts of God,

acts of war, civil disorders, or other similar acts.

25.0 EDD Reporting Requirements

In order to comply with child support enforcement requirements of the State of California, the County of Riverside may be required to submit a Report of Independent Contractor(s) form **DE 542** to the Employment Development Department. The selected Contractor agrees to furnish the required Contractor data and certifications to the County of Riverside within ten (10) days of notification of award of contract when required by the **EDD**.

It is expressly understood that this data will be transmitted to governmental agencies charged with the establishment and enforcement of child support orders and for no other purposes and will be held confidential by those agencies. Failure of the CONTRACTOR to timely submit the data and/or certificates required may result in an Agreement being awarded to another CONTRACTOR. In the event an Agreement has been issues, failure of the CONTRACTOR to comply with all federal and state reporting requirements for child support enforcement or to comply with all lawfully served Wage and Earnings Assignments Orders and Notices of Assignment shall constitute a material breach of Agreement. Failure to cure such breach within sixty (60) calendar days of notice from the County shall constitute grounds for termination of the Agreement.

HOME HEALTH SERVICES AGREEMENT BETWEEN COUNTY OF RIVERSIDE AND GOOD HOPE HEALTH CARE, INC.

This Agreement is made and entered into by and between the County of Riverside, a political subdivision of the State of California, and Good Hope Home Health Care, Inc. (CONTRACTOR). COUNTY and CONTRACTOR are referred to herein as Parties.

WHEREAS, the COUNTY has agreed to provide "medically necessary" Health Care Services in accordance with the Welfare and Institutions Code Section 15909 – 15915 (Chapter 723, Statutes of 2010, Assembly Bill 342), and the Special Term and Conditions (STCs of the federal section 1115 (a_ California Bridge to Reform as part of the Low Income Health Program (LIHP) Medicaid Coverage Expansion (MCE) program; and;

WHEREAS, "Riverside County HealthCare ("RCHC") means a county-based elective program developed as part of the Medicaid Coverage Expansion, a component of the Section 1115-(a) Comprehensive Demonstration Waiver which expands health coverage to low income uninsured adult who are not eligible for Medi-Cal or Healthy Families; and;

WHEREAS, COUNTY desires to arrange for the provision of certain health care services for its members by entering into service agreements with various health care service providers; and

WHEREAS, CONTRACTOR has the expertise, special skills, knowledge and experience to perform the duties set out herein;

NOW THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual promises, covenants representations and conditions hereinafter contained, the PARTIES hereto mutually agree as follows.

1.0 <u>DESCRIPTION OF SERVICES:</u>

CONTRACTOR will provide Home Health Services as outlined in Attachment A, attached hereto and made part of the Agreement.

2.0 TERM AND TERMINATION:

- 2.1 TERM. This Agreement shall be effective as of May 1, 2012 through December 31, 2013, unless terminated as specified below in Section 2.2 or as otherwise specified herein.
- 2.2 TERMINATION WITHOUT CAUSE. Either party may terminate this Agreement with or without cause by giving ninety (90) days prior written notice to the other party.
- 2.2.1 In the event of termination of this Agreement, CONTRACTOR shall continue to provide and be compensated for Home Health Services under the terms of this Agreement to patients who have been authorized for treatment on the date of termination until the effective date of discharge of care or the safe transfer of such patients to another Health Care Service Provider, or a period of ninety (90) days, whichever comes first.
- 2.3 NON-AVAILABILITY OF FUNDS. In the event of non-availability of COUNTY funds, this Agreement shall be deemed terminated and of no further force and effect immediately on receipt of COUNTY's notification to CONTRACTOR.

3.0 COMPENSATION:

- pursuant to this Agreement, CONTRACTOR shall be entitled to receive payment in accordance with RCHC Program policy and procedure. CONTRACTOR shall submit clean, complete and accurate claims to RCHC Program within one hundred eighty (180) days from the date of service. Claims must be submitted on a HCFA 1500 claim or its successor claim form (or via electronic form) and shall contain a minimum of the following information: Patient Name, Patient ID#, date of birth, authorization number, item description, quantity and unit pricing. CONTRACTOR shall not seek payment for claims not submitted after one hundred and eighty (180) days from the date of service. Any claims received after the billing deadline will not be considered for payment. CONTRACTOR shall accept the payments for services as described above in Section 1.0 and specified in Attachment A, attached hereto, as payment in full.
- 3.2 Maximum payments to CONTRACTOR shall not exceed one hundred thousand (\$100,000) dollars for the term of this agreement. Payments to CONTRACTOR shall be made within forty-five (45) working days of receipt from CONTRACTOR of an uncontested claim which is accurate, complete and otherwise in accordance with Section 3.1.

4.0 HOLD HARMLESS-INDEPENDENT CONTRACTOR:

4.1 CONTRACTOR shall indemnify and hold harmless all Agencies, Districts, Special Districts and Departments of the County of Riverside, their respective directors, officers, Board of Supervisors, elected and appointed officials, employees, agents and representatives from any liability whatsoever, based or asserted upon any services of CONTRACTOR, its officers, employees,

subcontractors, agents or representatives arising out of or in any way relating to this Agreement, including but not limited to property damage, bodily injury, or death or any other element of any kind or nature whatsoever and resulting from any reason whatsoever arising from the performance of CONTRACTOR, its officers, agents, employees, subcontractors, agents or representatives from this Agreement; CONTRACTOR shall defend, at its sole expense, all costs and fees including but not limited to attorney fees, cost of investigation, defense and settlements or awards all Agencies, Districts, Special Districts and Departments of the County of Riverside, their respective directors, officers, Board of Supervisors, elected and appointed officials, employees, agents and representatives in any claims or action based upon such alleged acts or omissions.

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4.2 With respect to any action or claim subject to indemnification herein by CONTRACTOR, CONTRACTOR shall, at their sole cost, have the right to use counsel of their own choice and shall have the right to adjust, settle, or compromise any such action or claim without the prior consent of COUNTY; provided, however, that any such adjustment, settlement or compromise in no manner whatsoever limits or circumscribes CONTRACTOR'S indemnification to COUNTY as set forth herein.

CONTRACTOR'S obligation to defend, indemnify and hold harmless COUNTY shall be subject to COUNTY having given CONTRACTOR written notice within a reasonable period of time of the claim or the commencement of the related action, as the case may be, and information and reasonable assistance, at CONTRACTOR'S expense, for the defense or settlement thereof.

- 4.3 The specified insurance limits required in this Agreement shall in no way limit or circumscribe CONTRACTOR'S obligation to indemnify and hold harmless the COUNTY herein from third party claims.
- 4.4 In the event there is conflict between this clause and California Civil Code Section 2782, this clause shall not be interpreted to comply with Civil Code 2782. Such interpretation shall not relieve the CONTRACTOR from indemnifying the COUNTY to the fullest extent allowed by law.
- 4.5 Liability resulting from Professional acts of the CONTRACTOR shall be subject to the terms of Section 5.5, below.

5.0 INSURANCE:

5.1 Without limiting or diminishing the CONTRACTOR'S obligation to indemnify or hold the COUNTY harmless, CONTRACTOR shall procure and maintain or cause to be maintained, at its sole cost and expense, the following insurance and/or self- insurance coverages during the term of this Agreement.

5.2 WORKERS' COMPENSATION

If the CONTRACTOR has employees as defined by the State of California, the CONTRACTOR shall maintain statutory Workers' Compensation Insurance (Coverage A) and/or self insurance as prescribed by the laws of the State of California. Policy shall include Employers' Liability (Coverage B) including Occupational Disease with limits not less than \$1,000,000 per person per accident. The policy shall be endorsed to waive subrogation in favor of The

County of Riverside, and, if applicable, to provide a Borrowed Servant/Alternate Employer Endorsement.

5.3 COMMERCIAL GENERAL LIABILITY

Commercial General Liability insurance coverage, including but not limited to, premises liability, contractual liability, products and completed operations liability, personal and advertising injury covering claims which may arise from or out of CONTRACTOR'S performance of its obligations hereunder. Policy shall name all Agencies, Districts, Special Districts, and Departments of the County of Riverside, their respective directors, officers, Board of Supervisors, employees, elected or appointed officials, agents or representatives as Additional Insured. Policy's limit of liability shall not be less than \$1,000,000 per occurrence combined single limit. If such insurance contains a general aggregate limit, it shall apply separately to this agreement or be no less than two (2) times the occurrence limit.

5.4 <u>VEHICLE LIABILITY</u>

If CONTRACTOR'S vehicles or mobile equipment are used in the performance of the obligations under this Agreement, then CONTRACTOR shall maintain liability insurance and/or self-insurance for all owned, non-owned or hired vehicles so used in an amount not less than \$1,000,000 per occurrence combined single limit. If such insurance contains a general aggregate limit, it shall apply separately to this Agreement or be no less than two (2) times the occurrence limit. Policy shall name all Agencies, Districts, Special Districts, and Departments of the County of Riverside, their respective directors, officers, Board of Supervisors, employees, elected or appointed officials, agents or representatives as Additional Insured.

5.5 PROFESSIONAL LIABILITY INSURANCE

coverage for the Contractor's performance of work included within this Agreement, with a limit of liability of not less than \$1,000,000 per occurrence and \$2,000,000 annual aggregate. If Contractor's Professional Liability Insurance is written on a claims made basis rather than an occurrence basis, such insurance shall continue through the term of this Agreement and CONTRACTOR shall purchase at his sole expense either 1) an Extended Reporting Endorsement (also known as Tail Coverage); or 2) Prior Dates Coverage from new insurer with a retroactive date back to the date of, or prior to, the inception of this Agreement; 3) demonstrate through Certificates of Insurance that CONTRACTOR has maintained continuous coverage with the same or original insurer. Coverage provided under items; 1), 2) or 3) will continue for a period of five (5) years beyond the termination of this Agreement.

5.6 GENERAL INSURANCE PROVISIONS - ALL LINES

- hereunder shall be admitted to the State of California and have an A M BEST rating of not less than A: VIII (A:8) unless such requirements are waived, in writing, by the County Risk Manager. If the County's Risk Manager waives a requirement for a particular insurer such waiver is only valid for that specific insurer and only for one policy term.
- 2) The CONTRACTOR'S insurance carrier(s) must declare its insurance deductibles. If such deductibles or self-insured retentions exceed \$500,000 per occurrence such deductibles and/or retentions shall have the prior written consent of the County Risk Manager before the commencement

of operations under this Agreement. Upon notification of deductibles unacceptable to the COUNTY, and at the election of the Country's Risk Manager, CONTRACTOR'S carriers shall either; 1) reduce or eliminate such deductibles as respects this Agreement with the RCHC Program, or 2) procure a bond, which guarantees payment of losses and related investigations, claims administration, and defense costs and expenses.

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CONTRACTOR shall cause CONTRACTOR'S 3) insurance carrier(s) to furnish the County of Riverside with either 1) a properly executed original Certificate(s) of Insurance and certified original copies of Endorsements effecting coverage as required herein, or 2) if requested to do so orally or in writing by the County Risk Manager, provide original Certified copies of policies including all Endorsements and all attachments thereto, showing such insurance is in full force and effect. Further, said Certificate(s) and policies of insurance shall contain the covenant of the insurance carrier(s) that thirty (30) days written notice shall be given to the County of Riverside prior to any material modification, cancellation, expiration or reduction in coverage of such insurance. In the event of a material modification, cancellation, expiration, or reduction in coverage, this Agreement shall terminate forthwith, unless the County of Riverside receives, prior to such effective date, another properly executed original Certificate of Insurance and original copies of endorsements or certified original policies, including all endorsements and attachments thereto evidencing coverage's set forth herein and the insurance required herein is in full force and effect. CONTRACTOR shall not commence operations until the COUNTY has been furnished original Certificate (s) of Insurance and certified original copies of endorsements or policies of insurance including all endorsements and any and all other attachments as required in this Section. An individual authorized by the insurance carrier to do so on its behalf shall sign the original endorsements for each policy and the Certificate of Insurance.

- 4) It is understood and agreed to by the parties hereto and the insurance company(s), that the Certificate(s) of Insurance and policies shall so covenant and shall be construed as primary insurance, and the RCHC's insurance and/or deductibles and/or self-insured retention's or self-insured programs shall not be construed as contributory.
- 5) The COUNTY'S Reserved Rights-Insurance. If, during the term of this Agreement or any extension thereof, there is a material change in the scope of services; or, there is a material change in the equipment to be used in the performance of the scope of work (such as the use of aircraft or watercraft) the COUNTY reserves the right to adjust the types of insurance required under this Agreement and the monetary limits of liability for the insurance coverage's currently required herein, if; in the County Risk Manager's reasonable judgment, the amount or type of insurance carried by the CONTRACTOR has become inadequate.
- 6) CONTRACTOR shall pass down the insurance obligations contained herein to all tiers of subcontractors working under this Agreement.
- 7) The insurance requirements contained in this Agreement may be met with a program(s) of self-insurance acceptable to the COUNTY

6.0 RECORDS AND DOCUMENTS:

- 6.1 CONTRACTOR shall make available, upon written request by and duly authorized Federal, State or COUNTY agency, a copy of this Agreement and such books, documents and records as are necessary to certify the nature and extent of the costs of the services provided by CONTRACTOR. CONTRACTOR shall maintain books and records for at least five (5) years from the termination of this Agreement.
 - 6.2 CONTRACTOR agrees to provide RCHC Program with reports and information relative to this Agreement and in accordance with terms set forth herein, as may be requested by RCHC Program.

7.0 CONFIDENTIALITY:

CONTRACTOR agrees to protect from unauthorized disclosure names and other identifying information concerning either persons receiving services under this Agreement or persons whose names or other identifying information becomes known to CONTRACTOR as a result of services performed under this Agreement, except statistical information not identifying any such person.

- 7.1 CONTRACTOR shall not disclose, except as otherwise specifically permitted by this Agreement or authorized by the client or client's representative, any such identifying information to anyone other than authorized RCHC Program personnel without prior written authorization from the RCHC Program.
- 7.2 For the purpose of this paragraph, "identify" shall include, but not be limited to, name, identifying number, symbol, or other identifying particular assigned to the individual, such as finger or voiceprint or photograph.

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7.3 CONTRACTOR shall observe all Federal, State and COUNTY laws and regulations, including, but not limited to, the Health Insurance Portability and Accountability Act (HIPPA) of 1996, concerning the security and privacy of patient records and information.

8.0 LICENSE:

CONTRACTOR shall, through the Term of this Agreement, maintain all licenses necessary for the provision of the services hereunder and required by the laws and regulations of the United States, the State of California, County of Riverside, and all other governmental agencies. CONTRACTOR shall notify RCHC Program immediately, in writing, of inability to obtain or maintain such license. Said inability shall be cause for termination of this Agreement.

- that CONTRACTOR'S 8.1 CONTRACTOR shall ensure employees, agents, and subcontractors performing services under the terms of this Agreement are in compliance with all relative licensing requirements. CONTRACTOR hereby agrees to notify RCHC Program immediately, in writing, of inability of CONTRACTOR or any of CONTRACTOR'S employees, agents and subcontractors to obtain or maintain such license(s). Said inability shall be cause for termination of this Agreement.
- COPY REQUIRED. A copy of each such license, permit, 8.2 approval, waiver, exemption, registration, accreditation, and certificate shall be provided to Contracts Administration, upon request.
- Further, CONTRACTOR hereby agrees to abide by the 8.3 standards of the medical practice of the profession when performing services hereunder.

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9.0 NONDISCRIMINATION AND ELIGIBILITY:

The CONTRACTOR shall not discriminate in the provision of services, allocation of benefits, accommodation in facilities, or employment of personnel, on the basis of ethnic group identification, race, color, creed, ancestry, religion, national origin, sexual preference, sex, age (over 40), marital status, medical attention, or physical or mental handicap, and shall comply with all other requirements of law regarding non discrimination and affirmative action including those laws pertaining to the prohibition of discrimination against qualified handicapped persons in all programs or activities.

- 9.1 For the purpose of this Agreement, distinctions on the grounds of race, religion, color, sex, national origin, age, or physical or mental handicap include but at not limited to the following:
- 1. Denying an eligible person or providing to an eligible person any services or benefit which is different, or is provided in a different manner or at a different time from that provided to other eligible persons under this Agreement.
- Subjecting an eligible person to segregation or separate treatment in any matter related to receipt of any service, except when necessary for infection control.
- 3. Restricting an eligible person differently in any way in the enjoyment of any advantage or privilege enjoyed by others receiving similar service or benefit.
- 4. Treating an eligible person differently from others in determining whether he/she satisfied any eligibility, membership, or other requirement or condition which individuals must meet in order to be provided a

similar service or benefit.

5. The assignment of times or places for the provision of services on the basis of race, religion, color, sex, national origin, age, or physical or mental handicap of the eligible person to be served.

10.0 CONFLICT OF INTEREST:

CONTRACTOR and CONTRACTOR'S employees shall have no interest, and shall not acquire any interest, direct or indirect, which will conflict in any manner or degree with the performance of services required under this Agreement.

11.0 ASSIGNMENT:

CONTRACTOR may not delegate the obligations hereunder, either in whole or in part, without prior written consent of the COUNTY and the RCHC Program provided, however, obligations undertaken by CONTRACTOR pursuant to this Agreement may be carried out by means of subcontracts if approved by RCHC Program. No subcontract shall terminate or alter the responsibilities of the CONTRACTOR to the RCHC Program pursuant to this Agreement. CONTRACTOR may not assign the rights hereunder, either in whole or in part, without prior written consent of the COUNTY. Any attempted assignment or delegation in derogation of this paragraph shall be void. A change in the business structure of CONTRACTOR, including but not limited to, change in the majority ownership, change in the form of CONTRACTOR'S business organization, management of CONTRACTOR, CONTRACTOR'S ownership of other business dealing with CONTRACTOR under this Agreement, or filing of reorganization or bankruptcy by CONTRACTOR, shall be deemed an assignment for purposes of this paragraph.

12.0 ADMINISTRATION:

The RCHC Governing Board (or designee) shall administer this Agreement on behalf of the COUNTY.

13.0 **WAIVER**:

Any waiver by COUNTY of any breach of any one or more of the terms of this Agreement shall not be construed to be a waiver of any subsequent or other breach of the same or of any other term thereof. Failure on the part of the COUNTY to require exact, full and complete compliance with any terms of this Agreement shall not be construed as in any manner changing the terms or stopping the COUNTY from enforcement hereof.

14.0 JURISDICTION, VENUE, ATTORNEY FEES:

This Agreement and interpretation as to the validity, performance and breach shall be construed under the laws of the State of California. Any legal action related to the Agreement shall be filed in the appropriate courts in the County of Riverside, State of California.

15.0 SEVERABILITY:

In the event any provision in this Agreement is held by a court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, void or unenforceable, the remaining provisions will nevertheless continue in full force without being impaired or invalidated in any way.

16.0 CAPTIONS AND PARAGRAPH HEADINGS:

Captions and paragraph headings used in this Agreement are for convenience only and are not a part of this Agreement and shall not be used in construing this Agreement.

17.0 NOTICES:

All correspondence and notices required or contemplated by this

18.0 <u>Independent Contractor</u>

The CONTRACTOR is, for purposes arising out of this contract, an Independent Contractor and shall not be deemed an employee of the County. It is expressly understood and agreed that the CONTRACTOR shall in no event, as a result of this Agreement, be entitled to any benefits to which COUNTY employees are entitled, including but limited to overtime, any retirement benefits, Worker's Compensation benefits and injury leave or other leave benefits. CONTRACTOR hereby holds COUNTY harmless from any and all claims that may be made against COUNTY based upon any contention by any third party that an employer-employee relationship exists by reason of this Agreement.

18.1 It is further understood and agreed by the parties hereto that CONTRACTOR in the performance of its obligation hereunder is subject to the control or direction of COUNTY merely as to the result to be accomplished by the services hereunder agreed to be rendered and performed

and not as to the means and methods for accomplishing the results.

19.0 Subcontract for Work or Services

No contract shall be made by the CONTRACTOR with any party for furnishing any of the work or services contained herein without the prior written approval of the COUNTY Contract Administrator, but this provision shall not require the approval of contracts of employment between the CONTRACTOR and personnel assigned for services hereunder, or for parties named in the proposal and agreed to under any resulting contract.

20.0 Interest of Contractor

The CONTRACTOR covenants that it presently has no interest, Including, but not limited to, other projects or independent contracts, and shall not acquire any such interest, direct or indirect, which would conflict in any manner or degree with the performance of services required to be performed under this Agreement. The CONTRACTOR further covenants that in the performance of this Agreement, no person having such interest shall be employed or retained by it under this Agreement.

21.0 Conduct of Contractor

- The CONTRACTOR agrees to inform the COUNTY of all the CONTRACTOR'S interest, if any, which are or which the CONTRACTOR believes to be incompatible with any interest of the COUNTY.
- 2) The CONTRACTOR shall not, under circumstances, which might reasonably be interpreted as an attempt to influence the recipient in the conduct of his duties, accept any gratuity or special favor from individuals or organizations with whom the CONTRACTOR is doing business or proposing to do business, in accomplishing the work under the contract.

- 3) The CONTRACTOR shall not use for personal gain or make other improper use of privileged information, which is acquired in connection with this Agreement. In this connection, the term "privileged information" includes, but is not limited to, unpublished information relating to technological and scientific development; medical, personnel, or security records of the individuals; anticipated materials requirement or pricing actions; and knowledge of selection of CONTRACTORS or SUBCONTRACTORS in advance of official announcement.
- 4) The CONTRACTOR or employees thereof shall not offer gifts, gratuity, favors, and entertainment directly or indirectly to COUNTY employees.

22.0 Disallowance

In the event the CONTRACTOR receives payment for services under this Agreement, which is later disallowed for nonconformance with the terms and conditions herein by the COUNTY, the CONTRACTOR shall promptly refund the disallowed amount to the COUNTY on request, or at its option, the COUNTY may offset the amount disallowed for any payment due to the CONTRACTOR under any contract with the COUNTY.

23.0 Right to Acquire Equipment and Services

Nothing in this Agreement shall prohibit the COUNTY from acquiring the same type or equivalent equipment and/or services from other sources, when deemed by the COUNTY to be in its best interest.

24.0 Force Majeure

Neither party shall be liable nor deemed to be in default for any delay or failure in performance under this Agreement or other interruption of service or employment deemed resulting, directly or indirectly, from acts of God,

acts of war, civil disorders, or other similar acts.

25.0 EDD Reporting Requirements

In order to comply with child support enforcement requirements of the State of California, the County of Riverside may be required to submit a Report of Independent Contractor(s) form **DE 542** to the Employment Development Department. The selected Contractor agrees to furnish the required Contractor data and certifications to the County of Riverside within ten (10) days of notification of award of contract when required by the **EDD**.

It is expressly understood that this data will be transmitted to governmental agencies charged with the establishment and enforcement of child support orders and for no other purposes and will be held confidential by those agencies. Failure of the CONTRACTOR to timely submit the data and/or certificates required may result in an Agreement being awarded to another CONTRACTOR. In the event an Agreement has been issues, failure of the CONTRACTOR to comply with all federal and state reporting requirements for child support enforcement or to comply with all lawfully served Wage and Earnings Assignments Orders and Notices of Assignment shall constitute a material breach of Agreement. Failure to cure such breach within sixty (60) calendar days of notice from the County shall constitute grounds for termination of the Agreement.

26.0 Entire Agreement

This Agreement constitutes the entire agreement of the parties hereto with respect to its subject matter and supersedes all prior and contemporaneous representations, proposals, discussions and communications, whether oral or in writing. This contract may be modified only in writing and shall be enforceable in accordance with its terms when signed by each of the parties hereto.

HOME HEALTH SERVICES AGREEMENT BETWEEN COUNTY OF RIVERSIDE AND HEMET HOME HEALTH CARE

This Agreement is made and entered into by and between the County of Riverside, a political subdivision of the State of California, and New Era Ultimate Investment, Inc., dba Hemet Home Health Care (CONTRACTOR). COUNTY and CONTRACTOR are referred to herein as Parties.

WHEREAS, the COUNTY has agreed to provide "medically necessary" Health Care Services in accordance with the Welfare and Institutions Code Section 15909 – 15915 (Chapter 723, Statutes of 2010, Assembly Bill 342), and the Special Term and Conditions (STCs of the federal section 1115 (a_ California Bridge to Reform as part of the Low Income Health Program (LIHP) Medicaid Coverage Expansion (MCE) program; and;

WHEREAS, "Riverside County HealthCare ("RCHC")" means a county-based elective program developed as part of the Medicaid Coverage Expansion, a component of the Section 1115-(a) Comprehensive Demonstration Waiver which expands health coverage to low income uninsured adult who are not eligible for Medi-Cal or Healthy Families; and;

WHEREAS, COUNTY desires to arrange for the provision of certain health care services for its members by entering into service agreements with various health care service providers; and

WHEREAS, CONTRACTOR has the expertise, special skills, knowledge and experience to perform the duties set out herein;

NOW THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual promises, covenants representations and conditions hereinafter contained, the PARTIES hereto mutually agree as follows.

1.0 DESCRIPTION OF SERVICES:

CONTRACTOR will provide Home Health Services as outlined in Attachment A, attached hereto and made part of the Agreement.

2.0 TERM AND TERMINATION:

- 2.1 TERM. This Agreement shall be effective as of May 1, 2012 through December 31, 2013, unless terminated as specified below in Section 2.2 or as otherwise specified herein.
- 2.2 TERMINATION WITHOUT CAUSE. Either party may terminate this Agreement with or without cause by giving ninety (90) days prior written notice to the other party.
- 2.2.1 In the event of termination of this Agreement, CONTRACTOR shall continue to provide and be compensated for Home Health Services under the terms of this Agreement to patients who have been authorized for treatment on the date of termination until the effective date of discharge of care or the safe transfer of such patients to another Health Care Service Provider, or a period of ninety (90) days, whichever comes first.
- 2.3 NON-AVAILABILITY OF FUNDS. In the event of non-availability of COUNTY funds, this Agreement shall be deemed terminated and of no further force and effect immediately on receipt of COUNTY's notification to CONTRACTOR.

3.0 COMPENSATION:

pursuant to this Agreement, CONTRACTOR shall be entitled to receive payment in accordance with RCHC Program policy and procedure. CONTRACTOR shall submit clean, complete and accurate claims to RCHC Program within one hundred eighty (180) days from the date of service. Claims must be submitted on a HCFA 1500 claim or its successor claim form (or via electronic form) and shall contain a minimum of the following information: Patient Name, Patient ID#, date of birth, authorization number, item description, quantity and unit pricing. CONTRACTOR shall not seek payment for claims not submitted after one hundred and eighty (180) days from the date of service. Any claims received after the billing deadline will not be considered for payment. CONTRACTOR shall accept the payments for services as described above in Section 1.0 and specified in Attachment A, attached hereto, as payment in full.

3.2 Maximum payments to CONTRACTOR shall not exceed one hundred thousand (\$100,000) dollars for the term of this agreement. Payments to CONTRACTOR shall be made within forty-five (45) working days of receipt from CONTRACTOR of an uncontested claim which is accurate, complete and otherwise in accordance with Section 3.1.

4.0 HOLD HARMLESS-INDEPENDENT CONTRACTOR:

4.1 CONTRACTOR shall indemnify and hold harmless all Agencies, Districts, Special Districts and Departments of the County of Riverside, their respective directors, officers, Board of Supervisors, elected and appointed officials, employees, agents and representatives from any liability whatsoever, based or asserted upon any services of CONTRACTOR, its officers, employees,

subcontractors, agents or representatives arising out of or in any way relating to this Agreement, including but not limited to property damage, bodily injury, or death or any other element of any kind or nature whatsoever and resulting from any reason whatsoever arising from the performance of CONTRACTOR, its officers, agents, employees, subcontractors, agents or representatives from this Agreement; CONTRACTOR shall defend, at its sole expense, all costs and fees including but not limited to attorney fees, cost of investigation, defense and settlements or awards all Agencies, Districts, Special Districts and Departments of the County of Riverside, their respective directors, officers, Board of Supervisors, elected and appointed officials, employees, agents and representatives in any claims or action based upon such alleged acts or omissions.

4.2 With respect to any action or claim subject to indemnification herein by CONTRACTOR, CONTRACTOR shall, at their sole cost, have the right to use counsel of their own choice and shall have the right to adjust, settle, or compromise any such action or claim without the prior consent of COUNTY; provided, however, that any such adjustment, settlement or compromise in no manner whatsoever limits or circumscribes CONTRACTOR'S indemnification to COUNTY as set forth herein.

CONTRACTOR'S obligation to defend, indemnify and hold harmless COUNTY shall be subject to COUNTY having given CONTRACTOR written notice within a reasonable period of time of the claim or the commencement of the related action, as the case may be, and information and reasonable assistance, at CONTRACTOR'S expense, for the defense or settlement thereof.

CONTRACTOR'S obligation hereunder shall be satisfied when CONTRACTOR has provided to COUNTY the appropriate form of dismissal relieving COUNTY from any liability for the action or claim involved.

- 4.3 The specified insurance limits required in this Agreement shall in no way limit or circumscribe CONTRACTOR'S obligation to indemnify and hold harmless the COUNTY herein from third party claims.
- 4.4 In the event there is conflict between this clause and California Civil Code Section 2782, this clause shall not be interpreted to comply with Civil Code 2782. Such interpretation shall not relieve the CONTRACTOR from indemnifying the COUNTY to the fullest extent allowed by law.
- 4.5 Liability resulting from Professional acts of the CONTRACTOR shall be subject to the terms of Section 5.5, below.

5.0 INSURANCE:

5.1 Without limiting or diminishing the CONTRACTOR'S obligation to indemnify or hold the COUNTY harmless, CONTRACTOR shall procure and maintain or cause to be maintained, at its sole cost and expense, the following insurance and/or self- insurance coverages during the term of this Agreement.

5.2 <u>WORKERS' COMPENSATION</u>

If the CONTRACTOR has employees as defined by the State of California, the CONTRACTOR shall maintain statutory Workers' Compensation Insurance (Coverage A) and/or self insurance as prescribed by the laws of the State of California. Policy shall include Employers' Liability (Coverage B) including Occupational Disease with limits not less than \$1,000,000 per person per accident. The policy shall be endorsed to waive subrogation in favor of The

County of Riverside, and, if applicable, to provide a Borrowed Servant/Alternate Employer Endorsement.

5.3 COMMERCIAL GENERAL LIABILITY

Commercial General Liability insurance coverage, including but not limited to, premises liability, contractual liability, products and completed operations liability, personal and advertising injury covering claims which may arise from or out of CONTRACTOR'S performance of its obligations hereunder. Policy shall name all Agencies, Districts, Special Districts, and Departments of the County of Riverside, their respective directors, officers, Board of Supervisors, employees, elected or appointed officials, agents or representatives as Additional Insured. Policy's limit of liability shall not be less than \$1,000,000 per occurrence combined single limit. If such insurance contains a general aggregate limit, it shall apply separately to this agreement or be no less than two (2) times the occurrence limit.

5.4 <u>VEHICLE LIABILITY</u>

If CONTRACTOR'S vehicles or mobile equipment are used in the performance of the obligations under this Agreement, then CONTRACTOR shall maintain liability insurance and/or self-insurance for all owned, non-owned or hired vehicles so used in an amount not less than \$1,000,000 per occurrence combined single limit. If such insurance contains a general aggregate limit, it shall apply separately to this Agreement or be no less than two (2) times the occurrence limit. Policy shall name all Agencies, Districts, Special Districts, and Departments of the County of Riverside, their respective directors, officers, Board of Supervisors, employees, elected or appointed officials, agents or representatives as Additional Insured.

5.5 PROFESSIONAL LIABILITY INSURANCE

coverage for the Contractor's performance of work included within this Agreement, with a limit of liability of not less than \$1,000,000 per occurrence and \$2,000,000 annual aggregate. If Contractor's Professional Liability Insurance is written on a claims made basis rather than an occurrence basis, such insurance shall continue through the term of this Agreement and CONTRACTOR shall purchase at his sole expense either 1) an Extended Reporting Endorsement (also known as Tail Coverage); or 2) Prior Dates Coverage from new insurer with a retroactive date back to the date of, or prior to, the inception of this Agreement; 3) demonstrate through Certificates of Insurance that CONTRACTOR has maintained continuous coverage with the same or original insurer. Coverage provided under items; 1), 2) or 3) will continue for a period of five (5) years beyond the termination of this Agreement.

5.6 GENERAL INSURANCE PROVISIONS – ALL LINES

- 1) Any insurance carrier providing insurance coverage hereunder shall be admitted to the State of California and have an A M BEST rating of not less than A: VIII (A:8) unless such requirements are waived, in writing, by the County Risk Manager. If the County's Risk Manager waives a requirement for a particular insurer such waiver is only valid for that specific insurer and only for one policy term.
- 2) The CONTRACTOR'S insurance carrier(s) must declare its insurance deductibles. If such deductibles or self-insured retentions exceed \$500,000 per occurrence such deductibles and/or retentions shall have the prior written consent of the County Risk Manager before the commencement

of operations under this Agreement. Upon notification of deductibles unacceptable to the COUNTY, and at the election of the Country's Risk Manager, CONTRACTOR'S carriers shall either; 1) reduce or eliminate such deductibles as respects this Agreement with the RCHC Program, or 2) procure a bond, which guarantees payment of losses and related investigations, claims administration, and defense costs and expenses.

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CONTRACTOR shall cause CONTRACTOR'S 3) insurance carrier(s) to furnish the County of Riverside with either 1) a properly executed original Certificate(s) of Insurance and certified original copies of Endorsements effecting coverage as required herein, or 2) if requested to do so orally or in writing by the County Risk Manager, provide original Certified copies of policies including all Endorsements and all attachments thereto, showing such insurance is in full force and effect. Further, said Certificate(s) and policies of insurance shall contain the covenant of the insurance carrier(s) that thirty (30) days written notice shall be given to the County of Riverside prior to any material modification, cancellation, expiration or reduction in coverage of such insurance. In the event of a material modification, cancellation, expiration, or reduction in coverage, this Agreement shall terminate forthwith, unless the County of Riverside receives, prior to such effective date, another properly executed original Certificate of Insurance and original copies of endorsements or certified original policies, including all endorsements and attachments thereto evidencing coverage's set forth herein and the insurance required herein is in full force and effect. CONTRACTOR shall not commence operations until the COUNTY has been furnished original Certificate (s) of Insurance and certified original copies of endorsements or policies of insurance including all endorsements and any and all other attachments as required in this

Section. An individual authorized by the insurance carrier to do so on its

behalf shall sign the original endorsements for each policy and the

Certificate of Insurance.

- 4) It is understood and agreed to by the parties hereto and the insurance company(s), that the Certificate(s) of Insurance and policies shall so covenant and shall be construed as primary insurance, and the RCHC's insurance and/or deductibles and/or self-insured retention's or self-insured programs shall not be construed as contributory.
- during the term of this Agreement or any extension thereof, there is a material change in the scope of services; or, there is a material change in the equipment to be used in the performance of the scope of work (such as the use of aircraft or watercraft) the COUNTY reserves the right to adjust the types of insurance required under this Agreement and the monetary limits of liability for the insurance coverage's currently required herein, if; in the County Risk Manager's reasonable judgment, the amount or type of insurance carried by the CONTRACTOR has become inadequate.
- 6) CONTRACTOR shall pass down the insurance obligations contained herein to all tiers of subcontractors working under this Agreement.
- 7) The insurance requirements contained in this Agreement may be met with a program(s) of self-insurance acceptable to the COUNTY

 6.1 CONTRACTOR shall make available, upon written request by and duly authorized Federal, State or COUNTY agency, a copy of this Agreement and such books, documents and records as are necessary to certify the nature and extent of the costs of the services provided by CONTRACTOR. CONTRACTOR shall maintain books and records for at least five (5) years from the termination of this Agreement.

6.2 CONTRACTOR agrees to provide RCHC Program with reports and information relative to this Agreement and in accordance with terms set forth herein, as may be requested by RCHC Program.

7.0 CONFIDENTIALITY:

CONTRACTOR agrees to protect from unauthorized disclosure names and other identifying information concerning either persons receiving services under this Agreement or persons whose names or other identifying information becomes known to CONTRACTOR as a result of services performed under this Agreement, except statistical information not identifying any such person.

- 7.1 CONTRACTOR shall not disclose, except as otherwise specifically permitted by this Agreement or authorized by the client or client's representative, any such identifying information to anyone other than authorized RCHC Program personnel without prior written authorization from the RCHC Program.
- 7.2 For the purpose of this paragraph, "identify" shall include, but not be limited to, name, identifying number, symbol, or other identifying particular assigned to the individual, such as finger or voiceprint or photograph.

8.0 LICENSE:

CONTRACTOR shall, through the Term of this Agreement, maintain all licenses necessary for the provision of the services hereunder and required by the laws and regulations of the United States, the State of California, County of Riverside, and all other governmental agencies. CONTRACTOR shall notify RCHC Program immediately, in writing, of inability to obtain or maintain such license. Said inability shall be cause for termination of this Agreement.

CONTRACTOR shall observe all Federal, State and

Said inability shall be cause for termination of this Agreement.

- Further, CONTRACTOR hereby agrees to abide by the 8.3 standards of the medical practice of the profession when performing services hereunder.

9.0 NONDISCRIMINATION AND ELIGIBILITY:

The CONTRACTOR shall not discriminate in the provision of services, allocation of benefits, accommodation in facilities, or employment of personnel, on the basis of ethnic group identification, race, color, creed, ancestry, religion, national origin, sexual preference, sex, age (over 40), marital status, medical attention, or physical or mental handicap, and shall comply with all other requirements of law regarding non discrimination and affirmative action including those laws pertaining to the prohibition of discrimination against qualified handicapped persons in all programs or activities.

- 9.1 For the purpose of this Agreement, distinctions on the grounds of race, religion, color, sex, national origin, age, or physical or mental handicap include but at not limited to the following:
- 1. Denying an eligible person or providing to an eligible person any services or benefit which is different, or is provided in a different manner or at a different time from that provided to other eligible persons under this Agreement.
- 2. Subjecting an eligible person to segregation or separate treatment in any matter related to receipt of any service, except when necessary for infection control.
- Restricting an eligible person differently in any way in the enjoyment of any advantage or privilege enjoyed by others receiving similar service or benefit.

CONTRACTOR may not delegate the obligations hereunder, either in whole or in part, without prior written consent of the COUNTY and the RCHC Program provided, however, obligations undertaken by CONTRACTOR pursuant to this Agreement may be carried out by means of subcontracts if approved by RCHC Program. No subcontract shall terminate or alter the responsibilities of the CONTRACTOR to the RCHC Program pursuant to this Agreement. CONTRACTOR may not assign the rights hereunder, either in whole or in part, without prior written consent of the COUNTY. Any attempted assignment or delegation in derogation of this paragraph shall be void. A change in the business structure of CONTRACTOR, including but not limited to, change in the majority ownership, change in the form of CONTRACTOR'S business organization, management of CONTRACTOR, CONTRACTOR'S ownership of other business dealing with CONTRACTOR under this Agreement, or filing of reorganization or bankruptcy by CONTRACTOR, shall be deemed an assignment for purposes of this paragraph.

12.0 ADMINISTRATION:

The RCHC Governing Board (or designee) shall administer this Agreement on behalf of the COUNTY.

13.0 **WAIVER**:

Any waiver by COUNTY of any breach of any one or more of the terms of this Agreement shall not be construed to be a waiver of any subsequent or other breach of the same or of any other term thereof. Failure on the part of the COUNTY to require exact, full and complete compliance with any terms of this Agreement shall not be construed as in any manner changing the terms or stopping the COUNTY from enforcement hereof.

14.0 JURISDICTION, VENUE, ATTORNEY FEES:

This Agreement and interpretation as to the validity, performance and breach shall be construed under the laws of the State of California. Any legal action related to the Agreement shall be filed in the appropriate courts in the County of Riverside, State of California.

15.0 **SEVERABILITY**:

In the event any provision in this Agreement is held by a court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, void or unenforceable, the remaining provisions will nevertheless continue in full force without being impaired or invalidated in any way.

CONTRACTOR hereby holds COUNTY harmless from any and all claims that may be made against COUNTY based upon any contention by any third party that an employer-employee relationship exists by reason of this Agreement.

18.1 It is further understood and agreed by the parties hereto that CONTRACTOR in the performance of its obligation hereunder is subject to the control or direction of COUNTY merely as to the result to be accomplished by the services hereunder agreed to be rendered and performed

and not as to the means and methods for accomplishing the results.

19.0 Subcontract for Work or Services

No contract shall be made by the CONTRACTOR with any party for furnishing any of the work or services contained herein without the prior written approval of the COUNTY Contract Administrator, but this provision shall not require the approval of contracts of employment between the CONTRACTOR and personnel assigned for services hereunder, or for parties named in the proposal and agreed to under any resulting contract.

20.0 Interest of Contractor

The CONTRACTOR covenants that it presently has no interest, Including, but not limited to, other projects or independent contracts, and shall not acquire any such interest, direct or indirect, which would conflict in any manner or degree with the performance of services required to be performed under this Agreement. The CONTRACTOR further covenants that in the performance of this Agreement, no person having such interest shall be employed or retained by it under this Agreement.

21.0 Conduct of Contractor

- 1) The CONTRACTOR agrees to inform the COUNTY of all the CONTRACTOR'S interest, if any, which are or which the CONTRACTOR believes to be incompatible with any interest of the COUNTY.
- 2) The CONTRACTOR shall not, under circumstances, which might reasonably be interpreted as an attempt to influence the recipient in the conduct of his duties, accept any gratuity or special favor from individuals or organizations with whom the CONTRACTOR is doing business or proposing to do business, in accomplishing the work under the contract.

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The CONTRACTOR shall not use for personal gain or make 3) other improper use of privileged information, which is acquired in connection with this Agreement. In this connection, the term "privileged information" includes, but is not limited to, unpublished information relating to technological and scientific development; medical, personnel, or security records of the individuals; anticipated materials requirement or pricing actions; and knowledge of selection advance of official CONTRACTORS SUBCONTRACTORS in of or announcement.

The CONTRACTOR or employees thereof shall not offer gifts, gratuity, favors, and entertainment directly or indirectly to COUNTY employees.

22.0 Disallowance

In the event the CONTRACTOR receives payment for services under this Agreement, which is later disallowed for nonconformance with the terms and conditions herein by the COUNTY, the CONTRACTOR shall promptly refund the disallowed amount to the COUNTY on request, or at its option, the COUNTY may offset the amount disallowed for any payment due to the CONTRACTOR under any contract with the COUNTY.

Right to Acquire Equipment and Services 23.0

Nothing in this Agreement shall prohibit the COUNTY from acquiring the same type or equivalent equipment and/or services from other sources, when deemed by the COUNTY to be in its best interest.

24.0 **Force Majeure**

Neither party shall be liable nor deemed to be in default for any delay or failure in performance under this Agreement or other interruption of service or employment deemed resulting, directly or indirectly, from acts of God,

acts of war, civil disorders, or other similar acts.

25.0 EDD Reporting Requirements

In order to comply with child support enforcement requirements of the State of California, the County of Riverside may be required to submit a Report of Independent Contractor(s) form **DE 542** to the Employment Development Department. The selected Contractor agrees to furnish the required Contractor data and certifications to the County of Riverside within ten (10) days of notification of award of contract when required by the **EDD**.

It is expressly understood that this data will be transmitted to governmental agencies charged with the establishment and enforcement of child support orders and for no other purposes and will be held confidential by those agencies. Failure of the CONTRACTOR to timely submit the data and/or certificates required may result in an Agreement being awarded to another CONTRACTOR. In the event an Agreement has been issues, failure of the CONTRACTOR to comply with all federal and state reporting requirements for child support enforcement or to comply with all lawfully served Wage and Earnings Assignments Orders and Notices of Assignment shall constitute a material breach of Agreement. Failure to cure such breach within sixty (60) calendar days of notice from the County shall constitute grounds for termination of the Agreement.

26.0 Entire Agreement

This Agreement constitutes the entire agreement of the parties hereto with respect to its subject matter and supersedes all prior and contemporaneous representations, proposals, discussions and communications, whether oral or in writing. This contract may be modified only in writing and shall be enforceable in accordance with its terms when signed by each of the parties hereto.
