BACKGROUND:

By Minute Order dated March 20, 2012 (agenda item 3.21), the Board authorized the Clerk of the Board to advertise for the countywide Traffic Signal battery backup system and LED modules improvement project at various locations, Phase 2. The list of various locations is attached herewith. Additionally, the specifications were approved by the Board within this agenda item.

During the advertisement period, two addenda were issued to all registered plan holders as a supplement to the specifications and special provisions. Bidders are required to acknowledge the addenda on their Contractor's Proposal, and are also required to take all addenda into account, to be considered for award. The addenda were issued to clarify and modify the approved contract documents. The addenda are attached as Addendum No. 1, and Addendum No. 2.

Bids for the project were opened in the office of the Director of Transportation at 2:00 PM, Wednesday, April 11, 2012. Ten bids were received. The basis for the selection of a contractor is the lowest responsive and responsible bid. The lowest responsive and responsible bid was submitted by Republic Intelligent Transportation Services, Inc. of Anaheim, CA, in the amount of \$249,954 which is \$14,870 (6.33%) above the Engineer's Estimate. This bid amount is slightly above the bid target range of 5%.

This project includes replacing existing green and red traffic signal indications with new LED modules and installing battery backup systems throughout Riverside County at various signalized intersections in three phases. Phase 1 is in construction and near completion. There are 47 locations being retrofitted throughout the County with phase 1. Phase 2 includes 37 locations and a list of these locations is attached. Phase 3 locations are planned for subsequent years. Countywide, yellow traffic signal indications are being retrofitted with LED modules under a separate project which is federally funded by the Energy Efficiency and Conservation Block Grant (EECBG) program.

The replacement of old LED indications with more energy efficient LED indications will reduce power consumption and prolong traffic signal operation when operating on battery power.

The Contractor has executed the contract and provided bonds documents.


