





ORDINANCE NO. 452.232

AN ORDINANCE OF THE COUNTY OF RIVERSIDE
AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 452
RELATING TO PRIMA FACIE SPEED LIMITS

The Board of Supervisors of the County of Riverside ordains as follows:

Section 1. Section 2.3 of Ordinance No. 452, entitled "Thirty-five miles per hour," is amended to add new subsection 113 thereto to read as follows:

"113. On Rose Quartz Drive between the centerline of Piedras Road and the centerline of El Nido Road, a total distance of approximately 0.4 miles, in the Gavilan Hills area."

Section 2. Section 2.4 of Ordinance No. 452, entitled "Forty miles per hour," is amended to add new subsections 131 and 132 thereto to read as follows:

"131. Carroll Street between the centerline of Martin Street and the centerline of Kuder Avenue, a total distance of approximately 1.5 miles, in the Mead Valley area.

132. Darby Road between the City of La Quinta and the centerline of Adams Street, a total distance of approximately 0.7 miles, in the Bermuda Dunes area."

Section 3. Section 2.5 of Ordinance No. 452, entitled "Forty-five miles per hour," is amended to add new subsection 153 thereto to read as follows:

"153. On Desert Moon Drive between the centerline of Ramon Road and the centerline of 30th Avenue, a total distance of approximately 1.0 mile, in the Thousand Palms area."

Section 4. Subsection 34 of Section 2.3 of Ordinance No. 452 adopted on February 4, 2003, pursuant to Ordinance No. 452.214, is repealed in its entirety. Subsection 34 of Section 2.3 established a thirty-five miles per hour speed limit on Darby Road between a point approximately one-quarter mile east of Washington Street (City of La Quinta city limit) and the centerline of Adams Street.

Section 5. This ordinance shall take effect 30 days after its adoption.
