FIRST AMENDMENT TO AGREEMENT FOR LAW ENFORCEMENT SERVICES BETWEEN COUNTY OF RIVERSIDE AND CITY OF TEMECULA

One (1) Deputy Sheriff (fully supported) position-Southwest Corridor Task Force






