BACKGROUND: In 1992, the County executed a cooperative agreement with the City of Palm Desert and Palm Desert Redevelopment Agency that provided for payment quarterly to the County an amount equal to the sales and use taxes paid to the City on the shopping center at the intersection of Monterey Avenue and Dinah Shore Drive for the purpose of addressing unmet health, mental health, and juvenile services in eastern Riverside County. In 1993, the County executed a contract with the Regional Access Project, Inc. (RAP), a non-profit foundation, to use those proceeds to provide such services. Renegotiation of the agreement with RAP, concurrent with dissolution of the Palm Desert Redevelopment Agency, provided the opportunity to realign flow of this revenue during FY 11/12. The recommended adjustments establish a FY 12/13 budget from which to allocate this estimated revenue to RAP.
