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BACKGROUND:

Operation SafeHouse (OSH) provides emergency shelter and supportive services to youth ages 12-17 (CS-02081-02) in Riverside Metro Area and the Coachella Valley, and transitional housing to youth ages 18-21 (HO-02420) in the Riverside Metro Area. DPSS contracts with OSH in support of these services and has agreements in place for FY 12/13. Operation SafeHouse has requested a one-time cash advance to support operations. Based on past experience, OSH will provide services that will far exceed the advance. As a result, DPSS recommends approval of this request.

DPSS will recapture the advanced funds by the end of the Agreement terms (June 30, 2013 for CS-02081-02 and February 28, 2013 for HO-02420) by offsetting a portion of the monthly billings submitted for actual services provided during the year.
