BACKGROUND: By Minute Order dated May 1, 2012 (Agenda Item 3.26), the Board authorized the Clerk of the Board to advertise for the construction of Camino Real Resurfacing Project in the City of Jurupa Valley. Additionally, the specifications and plans were approved by the Board within this agenda item.

Bids for the project were opened in the office of the Director of Transportation and Land Management at 2:00 PM, Wednesday, May 16, 2012. Seven bids were received, ranging from \$1,570,000 to \$1,832,897. The basis for the selection of a contractor is the lowest responsive and responsible bid for all schedules of work. The lowest responsible bid was submitted by All American Asphalt of Corona, in the amount of \$1,570,000, which is \$130,000 (7.65%) below the Engineer's Estimate.

The agreement includes the following schedules of work:

Base Bid: Primary items of work on Camino Real.

Alternate Bid: Camino Real, adjustment of manholes, to be funded by Jurupa Community Services District (JCSD) under the terms of a Cooperative Agreement.

Alternate 1 is recommended to be awarded with the base bid contract. The utility owner, (JCSD), has concurred with bid prices, as bid by the apparent low bidder. The alternate bid schedule is included with the contract award and the costs for the work will be funded by that utility owner.

The County identified the need for pavement resurfacing on Camino Real, funds were budgeted and construction drawings were substantially prepared prior to incorporation of the City of Jurupa Valley. The City considers resurfacing of Camino Real as a priority and desires that the County continue as lead agency.

During preparation of plans, the City requested the following two segments of Camino Real be added to the project.

1. Camino Real: Linares Avenue to Limonite Avenue
2. Camino Real: Red Mountain Drive to 250' north of Whitney Drive

The Jurupa Valley City Council, at a special meeting on January 24, 2012, discussed the urgency and their financial participation of the project and directed the City staff to work with the County for the Costs Sharing Agreement. While the City and County have been working to finalize the Cooperative Agreement, the City requested that the County move forward with the award of the contract to begin construction as soon as possible. The City of Jurupa Valley has also indicated intent to make payments to the County in future years as compensation for the added work, which is outlined in the attached Resolution. The City's financial participation of the project is \$750,000.

The Contractor will execute the contract and provide bonds and insurance documents after Board approval. The Contractor is qualified to perform the work as outlined in the bid.

8 WHEREAS, the City of Jurupa Valley was incorporated on July 1, 2011, as a general law
9 city of the State of California; and

10 WHEREAS, the County may agree to provide services at less than full cost to the City on
11 such terms and conditions as the parties may approve in accord with the provisions of Section 57384(c) of
12 the California Government; and

13 WHEREAS, the City of Jurupa Valley during a special meeting on January 24, 2012
14 considered the Camino Real Resurfacing project (the "Project") as a priority, which involves the
15 resurfacing of the full width of Camino Real from Limonite Avenue to 263 feet north of Blackhills Drive
16 and resurfacing the west one half of Camino Real from Red Mountain Drive to 250 feet north of Whitney
17 Drive and by reconstructing the full width from Linares Avenue to Limonite Avenue, and instructed City
18 staff to work with the County regarding the construction of this Project and the City's financial
19 participation; and

20 WHEREAS, City staff by letter dated June 25, 2102 has confirmed the City's desire to work
21 with County to move forward with Project;

22 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Supervisors of the County of
23 Riverside assembled in regular session on July 17, 2012 that the County hereby agrees to move forward
24 with the construction of Project at a full cost of One Million, Seven Hundred Twenty-Seven Thousand
25 Dollars (\$1,727,000), for which the City shall provide a financial participation of Seven Hundred Fifty
26 Thousand Dollars (\$750,000) towards the construction cost of the Project; and

27 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT the County hereby agrees to defer the financial
28 participation from the City of Jurupa Valley towards the Project and will accept such payment over a period
not to exceed four fiscal years, with four equal payments of One Hundred Eighty-Seven Thousand Five

AGREEMENT

THIS AGREEMENT is entered into at Riverside, California as of the date set forth below is between County of Riverside hereafter called "County" and **All American Asphalt**, hereafter called "Contractor".

WITNESSETH

RECITALS:

1. Contractor has submitted to County his Contractor's Proposal for the construction of County Project, **Camino Real Resurfacing Project in the City of Jurupa Valley, Project No. C1-0503**, in strict accordance with the Contract Documents identified below and County has accepted said Proposal.
2. Contractor states that he has reexamined his Contractor's Proposal and found it to be correct, has ascertained that his subcontractors are properly licensed and possess the requisite skill and forces, has reexamined the site and Contract Documents and is of the opinion that he can presently do the work in accordance with the Contract Documents for the money set forth in his Proposal to be paid as provided in the Contract Documents.

AGREEMENT:

IT IS AGREED BY THE PARTIES AS FOLLOWS:

1. Contract Documents. The entire contract consists of the following: (a) The Agreement. (b) The Notice Inviting Bids. (c) The Instruction to Bidders. (d) The Contractor's Proposal. (e) The Bid Bond. (f) The Payment Bond. (g) The Performance Bond. (h) The General Conditions. (i) The Special Provisions. (j) The Standard Specifications of the State of California Department of Transportation edition of May 2006 as modified in other portions of the Contract Documents. (k) The Standard Plans of the Department of Transportation identified on the plans or in the Special Provisions. (l) The Plans. (m) Addenda (**none**). (n) The Determination of Prevailing Wage Rates for Public Work. (o) Any Change Orders issued. (p) Any additional or supplemental specifications, notice, instructions and drawings issued in accordance with the provisions of the Contract Documents. All of said Documents presently in existence are by this reference incorporated herein with like effect as if here set forth in full and upon the proper issuance of other documents they shall likewise be deemed incorporated. The Bid Bond is exonerated upon execution of this Agreement and the Payment Bond and Faithful Performance Bond.
2. The Work. Contractor shall do all things necessary to construct the work generally described in Recital No. 1 in accordance with the Contract Documents.

3. Liquidated Damages and Time of Completion. Attention is directed to the provisions in Section 8-1.06, "Time of Completion", and in Section 8-1.07, "Liquidated Damages", of the Standard Specifications and these Special Provisions.

The Contractor shall begin work within 15 days of the date stated within the written "Notice to Proceed".

The Contractor shall notify the Engineer, in writing, of his intent to begin work at least 72 hours before work is begun. The notice shall be delivered to the Transportation Department's Construction Engineer and shall specify the date the Contractor intends to start. If the project has more than one location of work, a separate notice shall be given for each location.

Should the Contractor begin work in advance of receiving a written "Notice to Proceed", any work performed by him in advance of the date stated in the "Notice to Proceed" shall be considered as having been done by him at his own risk and as a volunteer and subject to the following:

- (1) The Contractor shall, on commencing operations, take all precautions required for public safety and shall observe all the provisions in the Specifications and the Special Provisions.
 - (2) All work done according to the contract prior to the issuance of the "Notice to Proceed", will be considered authorized work and will be paid for as provided in the contract.
 - (3) The Contractor shall not be entitled to any additional compensation or an extension of time for any delay, hindrance or interference caused by or attributable to commencement of work prior to the issuance of the "Notice to Proceed".
4. Compensation. Contractor shall be paid in the manner set forth in the Contract Documents the amount of his Proposal as accepted by County, the above rates, subject to additions and deductions as provided in the Contract Documents. Said Proposal is on file in the Office of the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors of County.

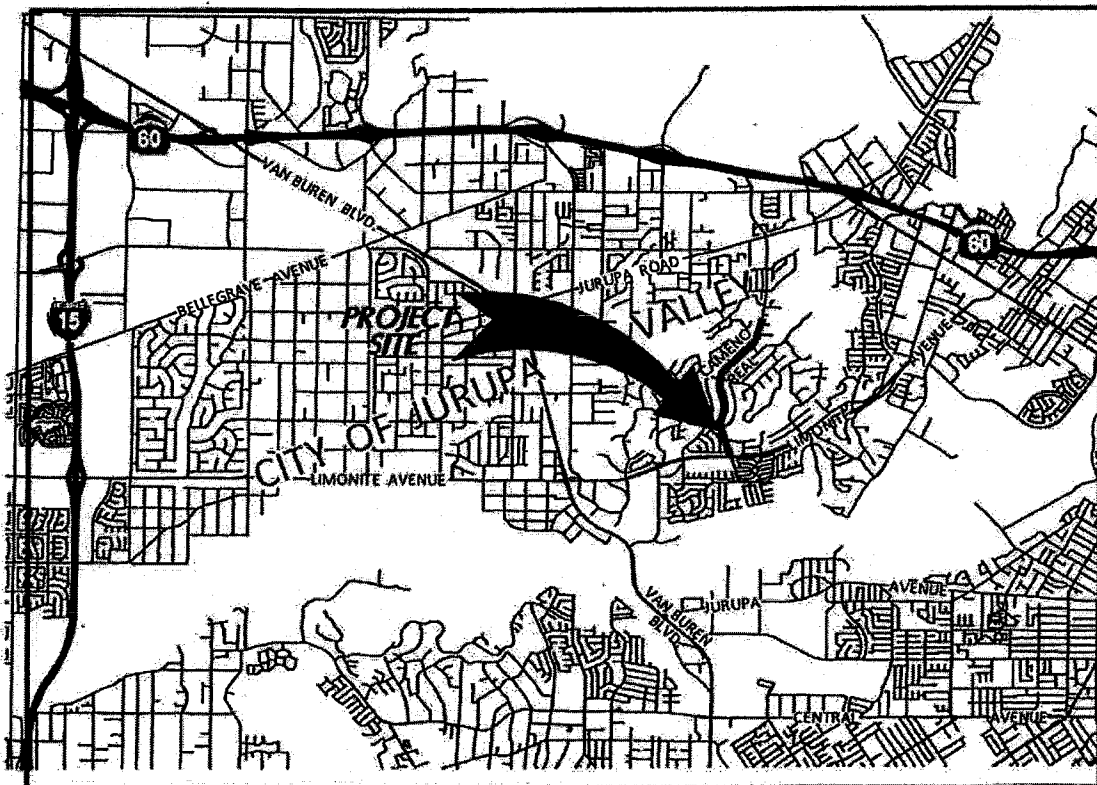
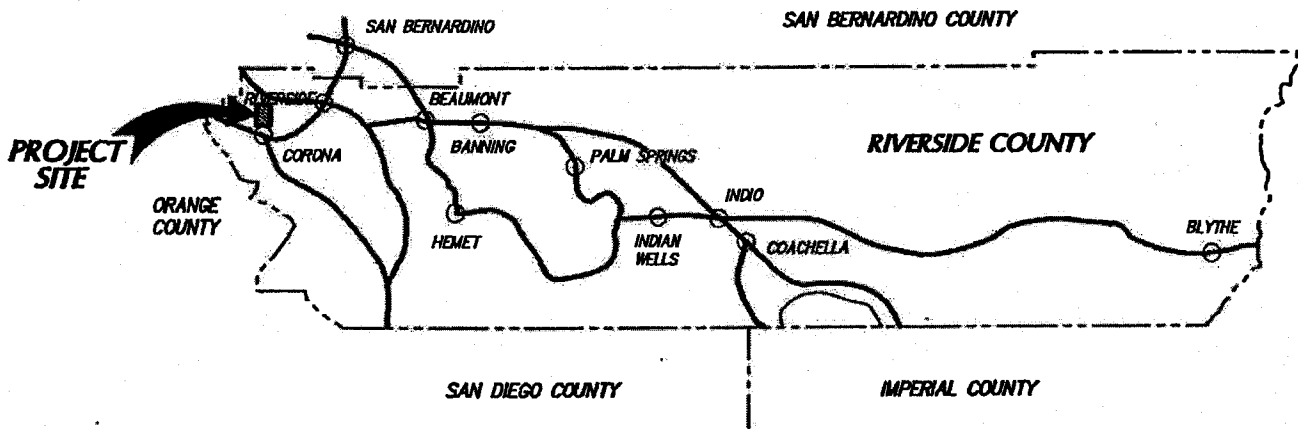

ESCROW AGREEMENT FOR
SECURITY DEPOSITS IN LIEU OF RETENTION

THIS ESCROW AGREEMENT FOR SECURITY DEPOSITS IN LIEU OF RETENTION (hereinafter called the "Agreement") is made and entered into on this **31** day of **July**, **2012**, by and between **County of Riverside**, whose address is 3525 14th Street, Riverside, CA 92501 (hereinafter called "Owner"), **All American Asphalt**, whose address is P.O. Box 2229, Corona, CA 92878 (hereinafter called "Contractor"), and **Community Bank**, a California banking corporation, whose address is 505 E. Colorado Boulevard, Pasadena, California 91101 (hereinafter called "Escrow Agent").

WHEREAS, the parties desire to establish an escrow account with Escrow Agent (the "Escrow Account") pursuant to the provisions of Section 22300 of the California Public Contract Code.

NOW, THEREFORE, for the consideration hereinafter set forth, the Owner, Contractor, and Escrow Agent agree as follows:

1. Pursuant to Section 22300 of the Public Contract Code of the State of California, the Contractor has the option to deposit securities with Escrow Agent as a substitute for retention earnings required to be withheld by the Owner pursuant to the Construction Contract entered into between the Owner and the Contractor, for **Camino Real Resurfacing Project in the City of Jurupa Valley Project No. C1-0503** in the amount of **\$1,570,000.00** (hereinafter referred to as the "Contract"). Alternatively, **on written request of the Contractor, the Owner shall make payments of the retention earnings directly to the Escrow Agent.** When the Contractor deposits the securities as a substitute for Contract earnings, the Escrow Agent shall notify the Owner within ten (10) days of the deposit. The market value of the securities at the time of the substitution shall be at least equal to the cash amount then required to be withheld as retention under the terms of the Contract between the Owner and the Contractor. Securities shall be held in the name of **County of Riverside**, and shall designate the Contractor as the beneficial owner.

2. The Owner shall make progress payments to the Contractor for those funds which otherwise would be withheld from progress payments pursuant to the Contract provisions, provided that the Escrow Agent holds securities in the form and amount specified above.

3. When the Owner makes payment of the retentions earned directly to the Escrow Agent, the Escrow Agent shall hold them for the benefit of the Contractor until the time that the escrow created under this Agreement is terminated. The Contractor may direct the investment of the payments into securities. All terms and conditions of this Agreement and the rights and responsibilities of the parties shall be equally applicable and binding when the Owner pays the Escrow Agent directly.

4. The Contractor shall be responsible for paying all fees for the expenses incurred by the Escrow Agent in administering the Escrow Account and all expenses of the Owner. These expenses and payment terms shall be determined by the Owner, the Contractor and the Escrow Agent.

5. The interest earned on the securities or the money market accounts held in escrow and all interest earned on that interest shall be for the sole account of the Contractor and shall be subject to withdrawal by the Contractor at any time and from time to time without notice to the Owner.

6. The Contractor shall have the right to withdraw all or any part of the principal in the Escrow Account only by written notice to the Escrow Agent accompanied by written authorization from the Owner to the Escrow Agent that the Owner consents to the withdrawal of the amount sought to be withdrawn by the Contractor.

7. The Owner shall have a right to draw upon the securities in the event of default by the Contractor. Upon seven days' written notice to the Escrow Agent from the Owner of the default, the Escrow Agent shall immediately convert the securities to cash and shall distribute the cash as instructed by the Owner.

8. Upon receipt of written notification from the Owner certifying that the Contract is final and complete, and that the Contractor has complied with all requirements and procedures applicable to the Contract, the Escrow Agent shall release to the Contractor all securities and interest on deposit less escrow fees and charges of the Escrow Account. The escrow shall be closed immediately upon disbursement of all moneys and securities on deposit and payments of fees and charges.






