WHEREAS, the Hospital cost will increase in Fiscal Year 2012/2013;

WHEREAS, the billing rates are used to obtain reimbursement from third-parties and patients for these costs;

BACKGROUND:

This action is to approve the Medical Center's rate adjustment for the 2012/2013 Fiscal Year. The Hospital's Charge Description Master (CDM) contains the billing Current Procedural Terminology (CPT), Health Care Common Procedure Coding System (HCPCS), revenue codes and retail charges for over 20,000 patient supplies, procedures, daily room rates and clinic rates for services rendered or performed at and billed by the Hospital. Implementation of these rate changes will still leave RCRMC's average charge below the average charge of other hospitals in the area.
