17 **WHEREAS**, at the time and place of said public hearing, as set forth in Resolution No. 2012-141, the
18 Board of Supervisors held the public hearing and afforded all interested persons an opportunity to testify
19 and be heard, and considered all oral statements and all written protests or communications made or filed
20 by any interested persons and at the conclusion of said hearing determined that a majority protest had not
21 been received; and

22 **WHEREAS**, the Board of Supervisors may proceed, pursuant to Section 22631 of the Streets and
23 Highways Code, to adopt a resolution confirming the diagram and assessment, either as originally
24 proposed, or as changed by it, and the adoption of such a resolution shall constitute the levy of an
25 assessment on all assessable lots and parcels of land within L&LMD No. 89-1-C for FY 2012-13.

WHEREAS, it is necessary that the Board of Supervisors adopt a resolution of intention pursuant to Section 22624 of the Streets and Highways Code, which fixes and gives notice, pursuant to Section 22626(a) of the Streets and Highways Code, of the time and place of a public hearing on said Report and the annual assessments for fiscal year 2012-13;
