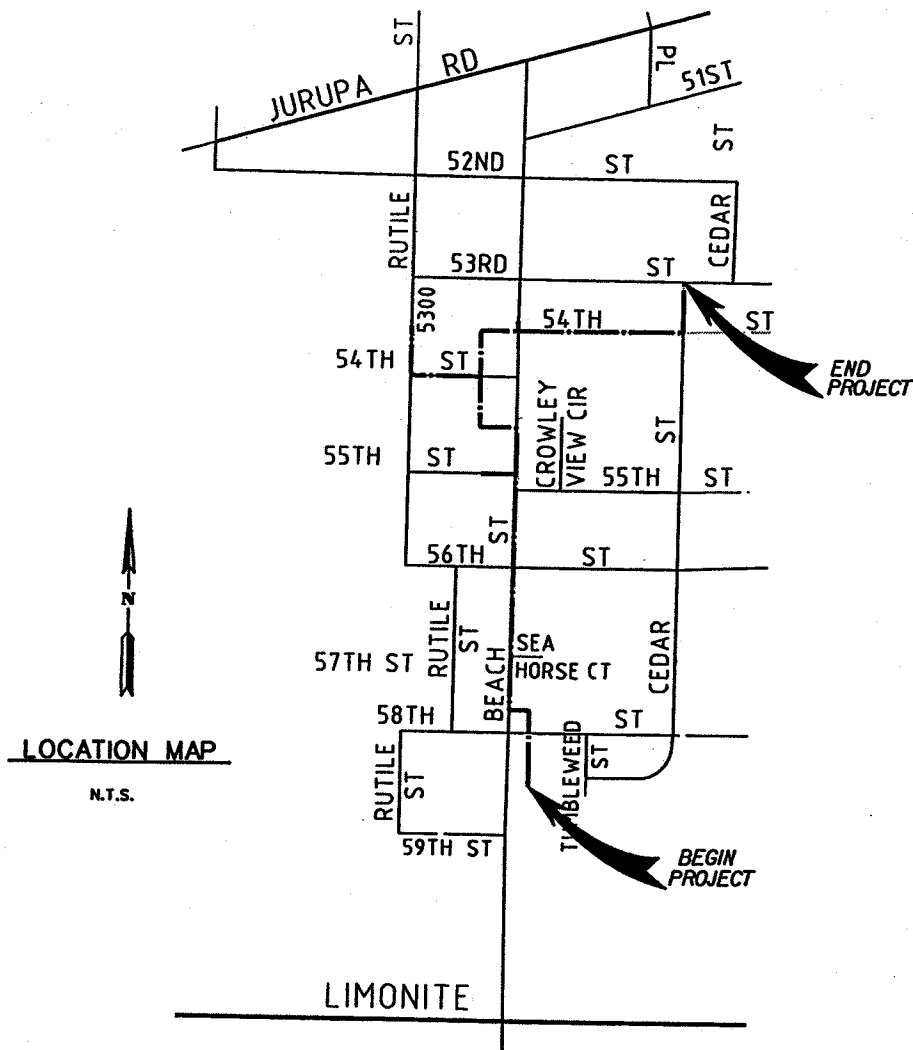

The project site is located along Beach Street between 59th Street and 53th Street, along Rutile Street, 54th Street and will end at Cedar Street.
