#### **BACKGROUND:**

Real property interests were acquired for the Oak Street Channel project which consisted of the construction and subsequent operation and maintenance of a concrete rectangular channel and reinforced concrete boxes. The facility was originally constructed in 1993. These properties are located at the end of E Street in the City of Corona and adjacent to the Oak Street Channel. Now, certain portions of these real property interests acquired for the Oak Street Channel are no longer needed for this purpose and the District desires to declare as surplus and dispose of the surplus land.

Pursuant to California Surplus Lands Act (Government Code Section 54220 et seq) and prior to disposing of any real property declared as surplus, a local agency shall send written offers to sell the property to other public agencies who may be interested in acquiring such surplus real property unless it is deemed exempt from this requirement. Surplus property that is less than 5,000 square feet in size is exempt from this requirement and may be disposed of without sending out any written offers to sell to other public agencies. This District-owned parcel (Assessor's Parcel No. 118-201-011) consists of approximately 3,790 square feet of land (Exempt Property), is irregular in shape, has no legal access for ingress or egress, is zoned multiple family residential and has been encroached upon by the adjacent apartment complex. As a result, the District is not required to send written offers to other public agencies and may proceed with disposing of this property. The District may dispose of real property of every kind within or without the District necessary and convenient to the full exercise of its powers after adoption of a resolution declaring that a real property interest is no longer necessary to be retained for District uses or purposes pursuant to California Water Code Appendix Sections 48-9 and 48-13. This Exempt Property is no longer necessary to be retained for the Oak Street Channel or any District uses or purposes; therefore, staff is recommending the adoption of Resolution No. F2012-23 to declare this property surplus and dispose of the Exempt Property.

Resolution No. F2012-23 has been approved as to form by County Counsel.

#### FINANCIAL:

The appraised value of the property is \$22,740. Based upon this appraisal, less \$8,200 in costs, the sale is expected to generate approximately \$14,540 which will be deposited in the District's Zone 2 fund. The sale will also relieve the District of any future maintenance responsibilities.

#### RESOLUTION NO. F2012-23

#### DECLARATION OF EXEMPT SURPLUS REAL PROPERTY AND NOTICE OF INTENT TO SELL A PORTION OF DISTRICT OWNED REAL PROPERTY

WHEREAS, the Riverside County Flood Control and Water Conservation District (District) is the owner of certain real property, consisting of approximately 3,790 square feet of land, located at the end of E Street in the City of Corona, County of Riverside, Assessor's Parcel Number 118-201-011 (Exempt Property); and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the California Surplus Lands Act (the "Act", Government Code Section 54220, et seq.) any real property that is less than 5,000 square feet of land is deemed exempt under the Act and the requirements provided in Section 54222 do not apply; and

WHEREAS, the District may proceed with the sale of this Exempt Property without first providing written offers to sell to other public agencies or housing sponsors; and

WHEREAS, the District may dispose of real property of every kind within or without the District necessary and convenient to the full exercise of its powers after adoption of a resolution declaring that a real property interest is no longer necessary to be retained for District uses or purposes; and

WHEREAS, the District further finds that the sale of this Exempt Property offers the best economic return and reduces the District's real property maintenance responsibilities.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, DETERMINED AND ORDERED by the Board of Supervisors of the Riverside County Flood Control and Water Conservation District in regular session assembled on July 31, 2012, that the Exempt Property with Riverside County Assessor's Parcel Number 118-201-011, located in the City of Corona, County of Riverside, State of California, described in Exhibit "A" and shown on Exhibit "B", attached hereto and made a part hereof, is no longer necessary to be retained by District for public purposes.

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that it is the intention of the Board to sell the Exempt Property as provided in California Water Code Appendix Sections 48-9 and 48-13, upon the following terms and conditions:

- 1. The nature and condition of the Exempt Property to be sold is a parcel of unimproved land, in its "as-is" condition, consisting of approximately 3,790 square feet located at the end of E Street in the City of Corona, County of Riverside, State of California.
- 2. The purchase price will be the negotiated amount between the District and a buyer representing fair market value.
- 3. The District will not pay a broker's or agent's commission. All amounts specified herein shall be exclusive of any commission the bidder may elect to pay a broker.
- 4. The District will convey, remit and release all right, title and interest which it owns in the Exempt Property and title conveyed shall be subject to all liens and encumbrances, easements, rights of way, taxes and assessments, if any, and deed and tract covenants, conditions and restrictions, whether recorded or not.
- 5. It is the responsibility of a buyer to perform its own due diligence concerning the Exempt Property.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that notice of this intent to sell shall be given by posting copies of this Resolution signed by the Chairman of the Board of the Riverside County Flood Control and Water Conservation District in three (3) public places in the County, for no less than fifteen (15) days.


## Oak Street Channel Parcel 2070-115B
