SUBJECT: Amended Standard Agreement No. 11-0297-SA Providing for Glassy-Winged Sharpshooter Treatments.

RECOMMENDED MOTION: That the Board of Supervisors:

- 1) Approve Amended Standard Agreement No. 11-0297-SA in the amount of \$50,000; and
- 2) Authorize the chairman to sign the agreement.

BACKGROUND: Agricultural production in Riverside County contributes an estimated \$1.3 billion to the local and regional economy. Among the rich and varied assortment of agricultural commodities produced in Riverside County, nursery stock production alone represents approximately 20% of the county's total value.

Due to the presence of Glassy-Winged Sharpshooter (GWSS) populations in local nursery operations that ship plants to uninfested areas of the state, the California Department of Food and Agriculture has approved this specific treatment funding.

This agreement provides \$50,000 to reimburse participating pest control operator costs associated with the treatment of nursery stock to control GWSS populations. The Agricultural Commissioner will administer the reimbursements via a "pass through" account established with the assistance of the Auditor Controller's Office. This agreement was approved as to form by County Counsel.


