An instrumental force in the community, he served as President of the California Wheat Growers and Chairman of the ASCS County Committee in addition to being an active member of his church.

Michael was a loving husband to his wife Elese of 39 years and a devoted father, grandfather, son, brother, and friend whose "greatest joys were going to tractor shows and pulls, restoring antiques, giving tours, and going to lunch."
