**BACKGROUND:** By Minute Order dated July 31, 2012 (Agenda Item 3.76), the Board authorized the Clerk of the Board to advertise the Limonite Avenue resurfacing project within the jurisdictional boundaries of the cities of Eastvale and Jurupa Valley, additionally, the specifications and plans were approved by that Board action.

Bids for the project were opened in the office of the Director of Transportation and Land Management at 2:00 PM, Wednesday, August 22, 2012. Four bids were received, ranging from \$357,100 to \$396,374. The basis for the selection of a contractor is the lowest responsive and responsible bid. The lowest responsible bid was submitted by All American Asphalt of Corona, in the amount of \$357,100, which is \$96,900 (21.34%) below the Engineer's Estimate.

The project was programmed based on strong community concerns from both cities to provide relief from deteriorating pavement conditions. This project will improve the pavement conditions between Hamner Avenue and Wineville Avenue, and this project will also improve safety conditions by constructing a raised median island from Pat's Ranch Road to Interstate 15 (I-15) northbound ramps and restrict left-turn movements from the Park and Ride facility and from Pat's Ranch shopping center.

The County identified the need for pavement resurfacing on Limonite Avenue, funds were budgeted and construction drawings were substantially prepared prior to incorporation of the City of Jurupa Valley. During the design phase, the City of Jurupa Valley requested to add a raised median island within their jurisdictional boundaries and agreed to pay for that improvements. The City and County staff have been working to finalize the Cooperative Agreement that will provide the mechanism for the City of Jurupa Valley to reimburse the County. This agreement was approved by the City Council on September 6, 2012 and will be coming before the Board at a future meeting. The City of Eastvale has also agreed to contribute funding for the improvements within their City limits. The Eastvale City Council has executed the Cooperative Agreement on September 12, 2012, for their share of the project costs and the agreement will be going to the Board for approval at a future meeting.

The proposed road improvements include, cold plane the existing pavement, placing new asphalt concrete pavement. Additional improvements include, place slurry seal installation of new detector loops, striping, thermoplastic pavement markings, construction of a median island, and other associated work. The Cities of Eastvale and Jurupa Valley concur with the proposed improvements.

The estimated total project expenses are expected to be less than the proposed project budget base on the above mentioned agreements with the cities, as shown on Attachment A.

The Contractor will execute the contract and provide bonds and insurance documents after Board approval. The Contractor is qualified to perform the work as outlined in the bid.

14 the Limonite Resurfacing project (the "Project") as a priority, which involves the resurfacing of the full  
15 width of Limonite Avenue between Hamner Avenue and Wineville Avenue inclusive of constructing a  
16 raised median island from Pat's Ranch Road to Interstate 15 (I-15) northbound ramps, and instructed City  
17 staff to work with the County regarding the construction of this Project and the City's financial  
18 participation; and

19 WHEREAS, City staff by letter dated August 28, 2102 has confirmed the City's desire to  
20 work with County to move forward with Project;

21 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Supervisors of the County of  
22 Riverside assembled in regular session on September 25, 1012 that the County hereby agrees to move  
23 forward with the construction of Project at a full cost of Three Hundred Fifty-Seven Thousand One  
24 Hundred Dollars (\$357,100), for which the City will provide a financial participation of Seventy-Four  
25 Thousand Eight Hundred Twenty-Five Dollars (\$74,825) towards the construction cost of the Project; and

**AGREEMENT**

THIS AGREEMENT is entered into at Riverside, California as of the date set forth below is between County of Riverside hereafter called "County" and **All American Asphalt** hereafter called "Contractor".

W I T N E S S E T H

RECITALS:

1. Contractor has submitted to County his Contractor's Proposal for the construction of County Project, **Limonite Avenue Resurfacing Project from Hamner Avenue to Wineville Avenue in the Cities of Jurupa Valley and Eastvale, Riverside County Project No. C2-0131**, in strict accordance with the Contract Documents identified below and County has accepted said Proposal.
2. Contractor states that he has reexamined his Contractor's Proposal and found it to be correct, has ascertained that his subcontractors are properly licensed and possess the requisite skill and forces, has reexamined the site and Contract Documents and is of the opinion that he can presently do the work in accordance with the Contract Documents for the money set forth in his Proposal to be paid as provided in the Contract Documents.

AGREEMENT:

IT IS AGREED BY THE PARTIES AS FOLLOWS:

1. Contract Documents. The entire contract consists of the following: (a) The Agreement. (b) The Notice Inviting Bids. (c) The Instruction to Bidders. (d) The Contractor's Proposal. (e) The Bid Bond. (f) The Payment Bond. (g) The Performance Bond. (h) The General Conditions. (i) The Special Provisions. (j) The Standard Specifications of the State of California Department of Transportation edition of May 2006 as modified in other portions of the Contract Documents. (k) The Standard Plans of the Department of Transportation identified on the plans or in the Special Provisions. (l) The Plans. (m) Addenda No. **(none)**. (n) The Determination of Prevailing Wage Rates for Public Work. (o) Any Change Orders issued. (p) Any additional or supplemental specifications, notice, instructions and drawings issued in accordance with the provisions of the Contract Documents. All of said Documents presently in existence are by this reference incorporated herein with like effect as if here set forth in full and upon the proper issuance of other documents they shall likewise be deemed incorporated. The Bid Bond is exonerated upon execution of this Agreement and the Payment Bond and Faithful Performance Bond.
2. The Work. Contractor shall do all things necessary to construct the work generally described in Recital No. 1 in accordance with the Contract Documents.

3. Liquidated Damages and Time of Completion. Attention is directed to the provisions in Section 8-1.06, "Time of Completion", and in Section 8-1.07, "Liquidated Damages", of the Standard Specifications and these Special Provisions.

The Contractor shall begin work within 15 days of the date stated within the written "Notice to Proceed".

The Contractor shall notify the Engineer, in writing, of his intent to begin work at least 72 hours before work is begun. The notice shall be delivered to the Transportation Department's Construction Engineer and shall specify the date the Contractor intends to start. If the project has more than one location of work, a separate notice shall be given for each location.

Should the Contractor begin work in advance of receiving a written "Notice to Proceed", any work performed by him in advance of the date stated in the "Notice to Proceed" shall be considered as having been done by him at his own risk and as a volunteer and subject to the following:

- (1) The Contractor shall, on commencing operations, take all precautions required for public safety and shall observe all the provisions in the Specifications and the Special Provisions.
  - (2) All work done according to the contract prior to the issuance of the "Notice to Proceed", will be considered authorized work and will be paid for as provided in the contract.
  - (3) The Contractor shall not be entitled to any additional compensation or an extension of time for any delay, hindrance or interference caused by or attributable to commencement of work prior to the issuance of the "Notice to Proceed".
4. Compensation. Contractor shall be paid in the manner set forth in the Contract Documents the amount of his Proposal as accepted by County, the above rates, subject to additions and deductions as provided in the Contract Documents. Said Proposal is on file in the Office of the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors of County.

**BACKGROUND:** By Minute Order dated July 31, 2012 (Agenda Item 3.76), the Board authorized the Clerk of the Board to advertise the Limonite Avenue resurfacing project within the jurisdictional boundaries of the cities of Eastvale and Jurupa Valley, additionally, the specifications and plans were approved by that Board action.

Bids for the project were opened in the office of the Director of Transportation and Land Management at 2:00 PM, Wednesday, August 22, 2012. Four bids were received, ranging from \$357,100 to \$396,374. The basis for the selection of a contractor is the lowest responsive and responsible bid. The lowest responsible bid was submitted by All American Asphalt of Corona, in the amount of \$357,100, which is \$96,900 (21.34%) below the Engineer's Estimate.

The project was programmed based on strong community concerns from both cities to provide relief from deteriorating pavement conditions. This project will improve the pavement conditions Hamner Avenue to Wineville Avenue, and this project will also improve safety conditions by constructing a raised median island from Pat's Ranch Road to Interstate 15 (I-15) northbound ramps and restrict left-turn movements from the Park and Ride facility and from Pat's Ranch shopping center.

The County identified the need for pavement resurfacing on Limonite Avenue, funds were budgeted and construction drawings were substantially prepared prior to incorporation of the City of Jurupa Valley. During the design phase, the City of Jurupa Valley requested to add a raised median island within their jurisdictional boundaries and agreed to pay for that improvements. The City and County staff have been working to finalize the Cooperative Agreement that will provide the mechanism for the City of Jurupa Valley to reimburse the County. This agreement is scheduled to be at the City Council Agenda on September 6, 2012. In the meantime, City of Jurupa Valley requested that the County move forward with the award of the contract to begin construction as soon as possible. The City of Eastvale has also agreed to contribute funding for the improvements within their City limits. The Eastvale City Council has executed the Cooperative Agreement for their share of the project costs, and that agreement will be on the Board Agenda concurrent with this item.

The proposed road improvements include, cold plane the existing pavement, placing new asphalt concrete pavement. Additional improvements include, place slurry seal installation of new detector loops, striping, thermoplastic pavement markings, construction of a median island, and other associated work. The Cities of Eastvale and Jurupa Valley concur with the proposed improvements.

The estimated total project expenses are expected to be less than the proposed project budget base on the above mentioned agreements with the cities, as shown on Attachment A.

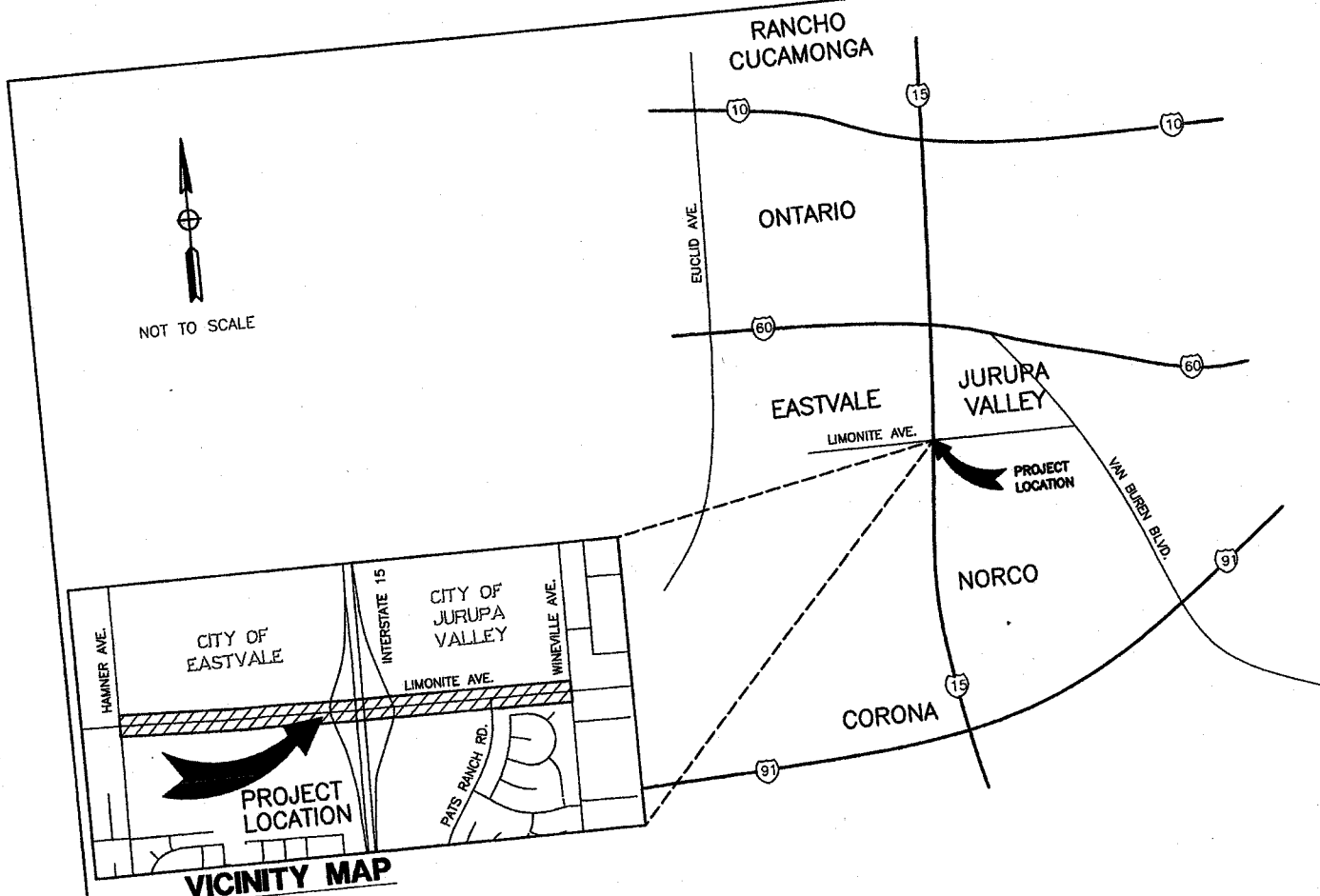
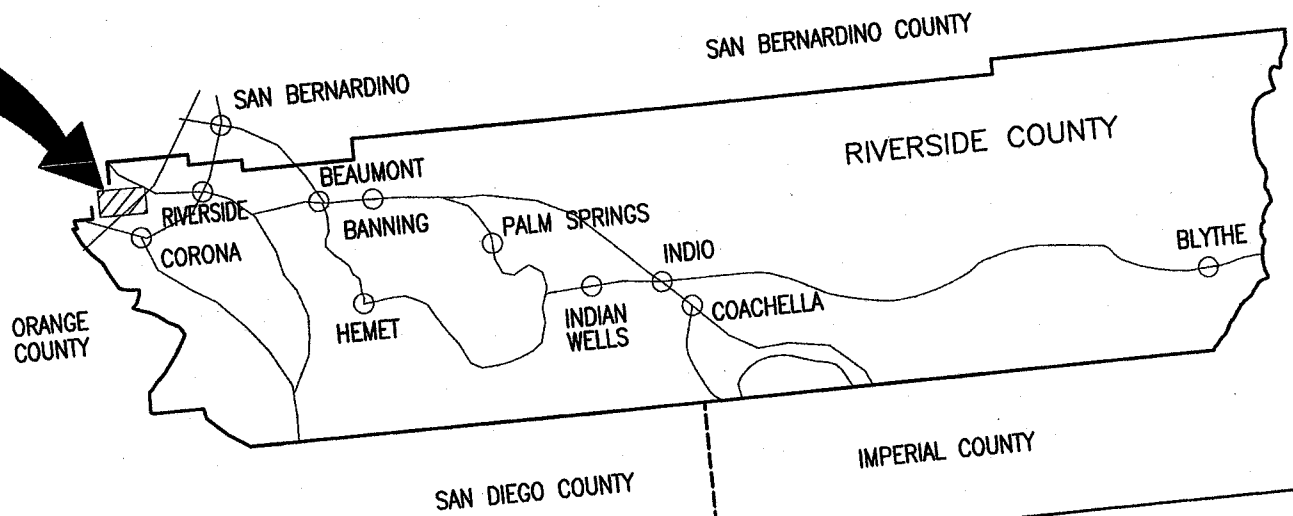

### VICINITY MAP

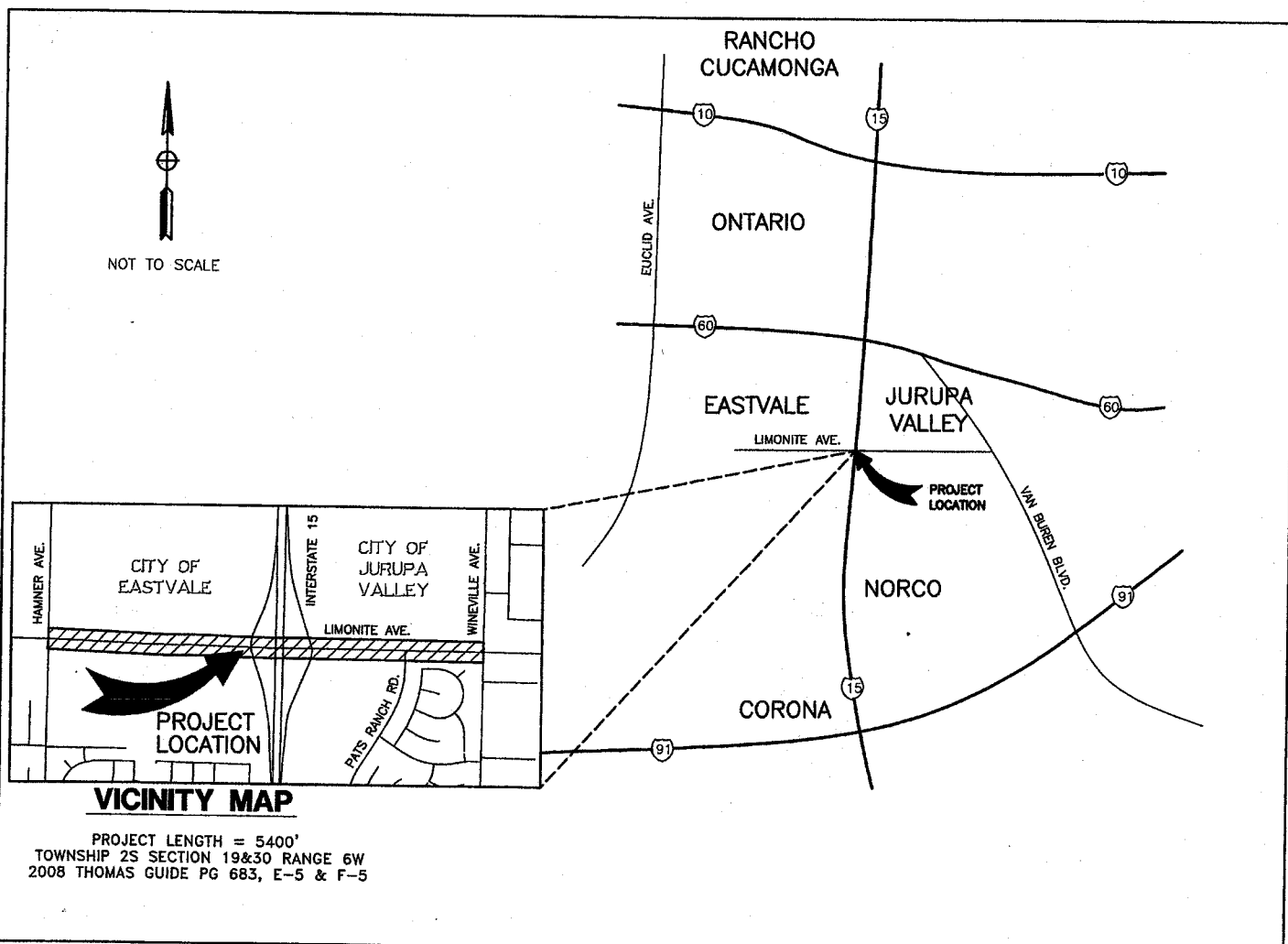
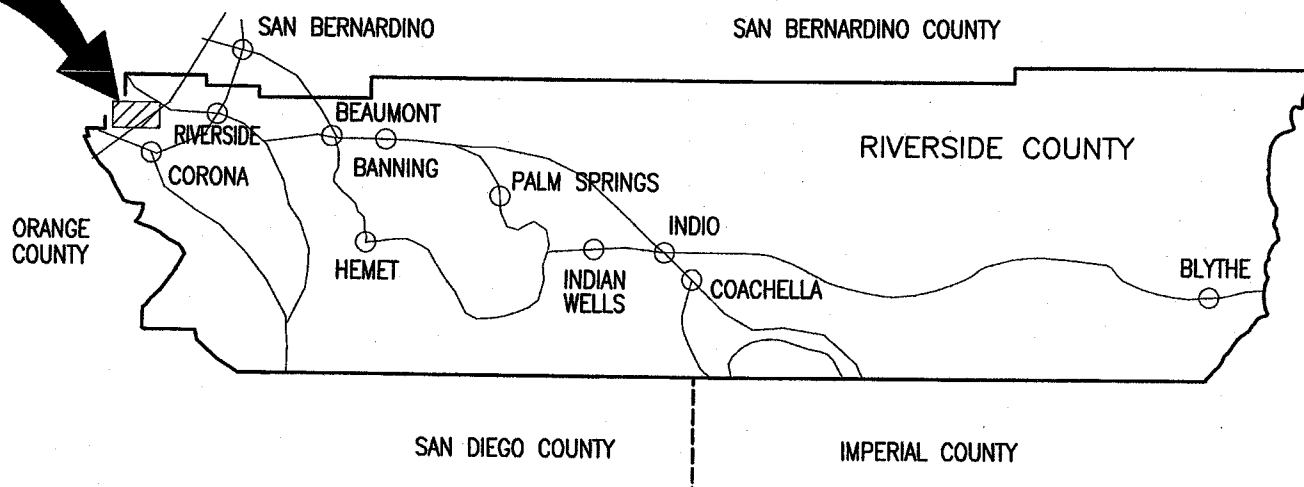

THIS AGREEMENT is entered into at Riverside, California as of the date set forth below is between County of Riverside hereafter called "County" and **All American Asphalt** hereafter called "Contractor".

## W I T N E S S E T H

### RECITALS:

1. Contractor has submitted to County his Contractor's Proposal for the construction of County Project, **Limonite Avenue Resurfacing Project from Hamner Avenue to Wineville Avenue in the Cities of Jurupa Valley and Eastvale, Riverside County Project No. C2-0131**, in strict accordance with the Contract Documents identified below and County has accepted said Proposal.
2. Contractor states that he has reexamined his Contractor's Proposal and found it to be correct, has ascertained that his subcontractors are properly licensed and possess the requisite skill and forces, has reexamined the site and Contract Documents and is of the opinion that he can presently do the work in accordance with the Contract Documents for the money set forth in his Proposal to be paid as provided in the Contract Documents.

### AGREEMENT:

#### IT IS AGREED BY THE PARTIES AS FOLLOWS:

1. Contract Documents. The entire contract consists of the following: (a) The Agreement. (b) The Notice Inviting Bids. (c) The Instruction to Bidders. (d) The Contractor's Proposal. (e) The Bid Bond. (f) The Payment Bond. (g) The Performance Bond. (h) The General Conditions. (i) The Special Provisions. (j) The Standard Specifications of the State of California Department of Transportation edition of May 2006 as modified in other portions of the Contract Documents. (k) The Standard Plans of the Department of Transportation identified on the plans or in the Special Provisions. (l) The Plans. (m) Addenda No. **(none)**. (n) The Determination of Prevailing Wage Rates for Public Work. (o) Any Change Orders issued. (p) Any additional or supplemental specifications, notice, instructions and drawings issued in accordance with the provisions of the Contract Documents. All of said Documents presently in existence are by this reference incorporated herein with like effect as if here set forth in full and upon the proper issuance of other documents they shall likewise be deemed incorporated. The Bid Bond is exonerated upon execution of this Agreement and the Payment Bond and Faithful Performance Bond.
2. The Work. Contractor shall do all things necessary to construct the work generally described in Recital No. 1 in accordance with the Contract Documents.



3. Liquidated Damages and Time of Completion. Attention is directed to the provisions in Section 8-1.06, "Time of Completion", and in Section 8-1.07, "Liquidated Damages", of the Standard Specifications and these Special Provisions.

The Contractor shall begin work within 15 days of the date stated within the written "Notice to Proceed".

The Contractor shall notify the Engineer, in writing, of his intent to begin work at least 72 hours before work is begun. The notice shall be delivered to the Transportation Department's Construction Engineer and shall specify the date the Contractor intends to start. If the project has more than one location of work, a separate notice shall be given for each location.

Should the Contractor begin work in advance of receiving a written "Notice to Proceed", any work performed by him in advance of the date stated in the "Notice to Proceed" shall be considered as having been done by him at his own risk and as a volunteer and subject to the following:

- (1) The Contractor shall, on commencing operations, take all precautions required for public safety and shall observe all the provisions in the Specifications and the Special Provisions.
- (2) All work done according to the contract prior to the issuance of the "Notice to Proceed", will be considered authorized work and will be paid for as provided in the contract.
- (3) The Contractor shall not be entitled to any additional compensation or an extension of time for any delay, hindrance or interference caused by or attributable to commencement of work prior to the issuance of the "Notice to Proceed".

4. Compensation. Contractor shall be paid in the manner set forth in the Contract Documents the amount of his Proposal as accepted by County, the above rates, subject to additions and deductions as provided in the Contract Documents. Said Proposal is on file in the Office of the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors of County.
