BACKGROUND: The Assistance League of Riverside annually provides food, clothing and shoes for over 1,950 disadvantaged children in the 5th District. The Assistance League of Temecula Valley provided food clothing and shoes for over 1,700 in the Menifee Union School District. The 21st Annual Palm Springs Festival of Lights Parade entertains 90,000 with over 100 holiday floats. The Mission Inn Foundation provides docent training and tours as well as reading programs and high quality exhibits of this national historic landmark. These funds improve the quality of life throughout the 5th district and I urge the Board to approve these uses of the Community Improvement Designation funds.
