- Approve and authorize the Purchasing Agent to execute a one (1) year Sole Source Agreement for maintenance, service, and repair of vehicles manufactured by Kovatch Mobile Equipment Corporation from KME Fire Apparatus estimated at \$ 150,000 annually without seeking competitive bids, which includes an option to renew the agreement for four (4) additional one-year periods; and,
- 2. Authorize Purchasing Agent, in accordance with Ordinance No. 459, to exercise the renewal option, based on the availability of fiscal funding; and,
- 3. Authorize the Purchasing Agent to enter into Amendments staying within 10% of the contract maximum.
