Background continued:

- 2. September 4, 2012: Award a consultant contract to the most qualified applicant to work on the EMS Plan. The Agreement was approved by the Board of Supervisors on November 20, 2012.
- 3. March 3, 2014: Consider and approve a final EMS Plan to go out to bid. The Department expects to meet this deadline.
- 4. June 1, 2014: The Board of Supervisors will have a public hearing to choose a provider or providers for County-wide ambulance services. The Department expects to meet this deadline.
- 5. New contract to begin July 1, 2015. The Department expects to meet this deadline.

The EMS system evaluation will be conducted using a four-pronged approach. This approach includes convening a steering committee, a broad stakeholders group, key informant interviews and stakeholder focus groups in order to be inclusive, transparent and to obtain broad input.

The stakeholders meetings are anticipated to commence in January 2013.

The Department will provide a monthly update to the Board of Supervisors.
