SUBJECT: In-Principle approval for lease or purchase of new space for the Riverside County Department of Mental Health for a new Palm Springs/Cathedral City Mental Health Clinic. [District 4]

RECOMMENDED MOTION: Move that the Riverside County Board of Supervisors authorize, in-principle, the Economic Development Agency (EDA) to seek office space for lease or purchase of approximately 25,000 square feet of space for a new Palm Springs/Cathedral City Mental Health Clinic.

BACKGROUND: The Riverside County Department of Mental Health's (RCDMH) must reestablish the Palm Springs/Cathedral City Mental Health Clinic due to service needs based on population demands and the expansion of mental health services. Additionally, the RCDMH is seeking space in preparation for integrated healthcare. Therefore, in order to improve consumer care and provide adequate staff space, new office space in the Palm Springs/Cathedral City area of Riverside County is being sought. (Continued on page 2)

BACKGROUND: (Continued)

Until 2008, the RCDMH had a Palm Springs/Cathedral City Mental Health clinic servicing approximately seven-hundred consumers. Due to budget cuts, the clinic was forced to close. The existing RCDMH clinics in Indio, Banning and Blythe do not provide reasonable access via public transportation to the western Coachella Valley without a commute of two to three hours therefore; the RCDMH is seeking to re-establish more easily accessible services in the Palm Springs/Cathedral City area. In addition, the RCDMH anticipates consumer growth due to the conversion of Riverside County Health Care (RCHC) consumers to Medi-cal in 2014.

The RCDMH will need approximately 25,000 square feet of space to accommodate approximately 60 licensed professional, paraprofessional and clerical mental health staff. Below is a brief description of the programs that will be housed at the new location:

- Adult Mental Health: A community-based outpatient mental health clinic providing a range of mental health services. Services are provided for adults who have a diagnosis of a severe mental illness.
- Adult Full Service Partnership (FSP): Serves adults between the ages of 18 and 59
 with severe and persistent mental illness who are homeless or at risk of
 homelessness.
- Children's Service's: Provides assessment, treatment, case management, and support services for emotionally disturbed children and adolescents birth to18 years. Supportive Services (Parent Support) are also available to consumers and their families including networking and parent to parent support.
- Older Adult Mental Health (Wellness & Recovery for Mature Adults): For older adults, age 60 years and above. Focuses upon wellness, recovery, and resiliency. Provides assessment, recovery goals, medication services, placement needs, and assistance with housing.
- Integrated Healthcare: Providing a full array of primary care, medical, and substance abuse services. Substance Abuse provides prevention and treatment services and administers the Drinking Drive and PC 1000 programs. Additional Substance Abuse services include detoxification, residential treatment, outpatient services, Narcotics Treatment Program (Methadone), prevention and referrals to other ancillary services.

FINANCIAL INFORMATION

There are sufficient funds in the RCDMH FY 12/13 budget to fund this additional space. No additional County funds are required.
