**SUBJECT:** In-Principle approval for lease or purchase of new space for the Riverside County Department of Mental Health for a new Temecula Valley Mental Health Adult Clinic. [DISTRICT 3]

**RECOMMENDED MOTION:** Move that the Board of Supervisors authorize in-principle, the Economic Development Agency (EDA) to seek office space for lease or purchase of approximately 13,000 square feet of space for a new Temecula Valley Mental Health Adult Clinic.

BACKGROUND: The Riverside County Department of Mental Health (RCDMH) must relocate the adult mental health programs from the existing Temecula Mental Health Clinic due to the inadequate size of the existing location. In addition to the space concerns for current staff and consumers, RCDMH is seeking additional space in preparation for integrated healthcare. Therefore, in order to improve consumer care and provide adequate staff space, new office space in the Temecula area of Riverside County is being sought.

**SUBJECT:** In-Principle approval for lease or purchase of new space for the Riverside County Department of Mental Health for a new Temecula Valley Mental Health Adult Clinic. [DISTRICT 3]

### **BACKGROUND: (Continued)**

The RCDMH will need approximately 13,000 square feet of space to accommodate approximately 29 licensed professional, paraprofessional and clerical mental health staff. The new location must provide space for the expansion of existing programs and integrated healthcare. Finally, the new facility should be close to public transportation to allow consumers who utilize public transportation access to services. Below is a brief description of the services that will be provided at the new Temecula Valley Mental Health Adult Clinic:

- Adult Mental Health: A community-based outpatient mental health clinic providing a range of mental health services. Services are provided for adults who have a diagnosis of a severe mental illness.
- Integrated Healthcare: Providing a full array of primary care, medical, and substance abuse services. Substance Abuse provides prevention and treatment services and administers the Drinking Drive and PC 1000 programs. Additional Substance Abuse services include detoxification, residential treatment, outpatient services, Narcotics Treatment Program (Methadone), prevention and referrals to other ancillary services.
- Jefferson Transitional Program: Under contract with the RCDMH, JTP offers a
  peer-operated program of integrated services to current or former adult and/or
  transitional aged youth consumers of the RCDMH. Services include a Resource
  Center with information on housing options, employment opportunities, and
  educational opportunities.

### FINANCIAL INFORMATION

There are sufficient funds in the RCDMH FY 12/13 budget to fund this additional space. No additional County funds are required.
