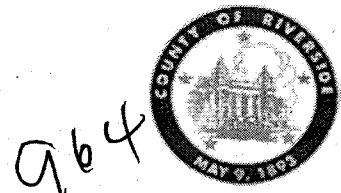

**SUBJECT:** Interim Chief Probation Officer

**RECOMMENDED MOTION:** Approve the Appointment of Interim Chief Probation Officer.

**BACKGROUND:** Chief Probation Officer Alan Crogan has announced his retirement effective December 26, 2012. To provide continuity in department operations while recruitment is conducted for this vacancy, an interim Chief Probation Officer needs to be appointed. It is anticipated to take approximately 90-120 days, while the recruitment, interview, nomination, and appointment process occurs, which requires participation from both the County of Riverside and the Superior Court of the State of California. Assistant Chief Probation Officer Mark Hake, with 23 years of service with the Probation Department, is recommended by both the County of Riverside and the Superior Court for this interim appointment which shall commence on December 26, 2012, and continue until a permanent replacement is appointed by the Court pursuant to the provisions of Welfare and Institutions Code, Section 270.

5 APPOINTMENT OF MARK A. HAKE AS  
6 INTERIM CHIEF PROBATION OFFICER  
7 OF RIVERSIDE COUNTY

8 The Court finds as follows:

9 On or about October 30, 2012, Alan M. Crogan announced his retirement and  
10 tendered his resignation as Chief Probation Officer for Riverside County, effective  
11 December 26, 2012.12 The County has publicly announced the opening of the position of Chief  
13 Probation Officer. The County and the Court are working together to solicit highly  
14 qualified applicants to be considered for the position. From the effective date of Chief  
15 Crogan's retirement, the County and the Court anticipate that approximately 90 – 120  
16 days will be required to complete the recruitment, interview, nomination and  
17 appointment processes.18 Time is of the essence as the County Probation Department cannot operate at  
19 efficiency levels required without the appointment of an Interim Chief Probation Officer.  
20 The imminent effective date of Chief Crogan's retirement does not allow the County and  
21 the Court a reasonable and sufficient amount of time to conduct a proper recruitment  
22 and appointment of a permanent replacement to Chief Crogan. Accordingly, given the  
23 foregoing, both the County and Court agree that Mark A. Hake, presently the Assistant  
24 Chief Probation Officer of Riverside County, has the requisite skills and qualifications,

1 and is willing to act in the capacity of Interim Chief Probation Officer until the recruitment  
2 and appointment process is completed.

3 Based on the foregoing, IT IS ORDERED:

- 4 1. Mark A. Hake, will serve as Interim Chief Probation Officer, commencing on  
5 December 26, 2012, and shall continue in that role until a permanent  
6 replacement is appointed by the Court pursuant to the provisions of Welfare  
7 and Institutions Code, section 270.
- 8 2. Mark A. Hake shall assume all of the duties and responsibilities of Chief  
9 Probation Officer of Riverside County during his tenure as Interim Chief  
10 Probation Officer.
