3. Award the contract to Hillcrest Contracting, Inc. of Corona, CA and authorize the Chairman of the Board to execute the contract documents.
4. Approve the proposed project budget as shown on Attachment "A".

BACKGROUND:

By Minute Order dated August 28, 2012 (Agenda Item 3.104), the Board authorized the Clerk of the Board to advertise for the construction of a traffic signal and associated improvements at the intersection of Harrison Street and 66th Avenue in the Coachella Valley area.

Bids for the project were opened in the office of the Director of Transportation at 2:00 p.m., Wednesday, September 19, 2012. Seven bids were received, ranging from \$821,663 to \$1,266,000.

The basis for the selection of a contractor is the lowest responsive and responsible bid for all schedules of work. The lowest bid was submitted by STI, Inc. Trucking and Materials (STI); however, the Transportation Department considers this bidder to be non-responsive. STI failed to submit required contract documents within the prescribed period of time, resulting in the rescission of the Notice of Acceptance and Intent to Award.

A Notice of Acceptance and Intent to Award letter was sent to STI on October 16, 2012 (see Attachment 1), in which the Contractor was requested to return, within ten working days, the executed construction agreement, performance bond, payment bond, and evidence of insurance as required in the contract documents.

After the expiration of the prescribed document submittal period as set forth in the Instruction to Bidders, Section 12, a Final Notice to Request Contract Documents Submittal letter was sent to STI on November 7, 2012 (see Attachment 2). STI failed to provide the contract document submittals.

Additionally, the County sent a letter dated November 21, 2012, to notify STI regarding the County's action to rescind the Intent to Award issued to their company, select the second low bidder to award this contract, and make a claim against STI's bid bond as set forth in the bid documents for damages in the amount of the difference between STI's bid and the next low bidder's bid amount (see Attachment 3).

Due to the lack of response from the low bidder consistent with the Instructions to Bidders, Section 12, the Transportation Department recommends that the Notice of Acceptance and Intent to Award to STI be rescinded. The Transportation Department further recommends that the second low bid, which was submitted by the firm of Hillcrest Contracting, Inc., be accepted and that the contract be awarded to that firm.

The next lowest responsive bid was submitted by the second low bidder, Hillcrest Contracting, Inc., in the amount of \$1,006,307. The bid is \$132,817 (15.2%) more than the Engineer's Estimate.

The Transportation Improvement Program provides for the construction of the subject improvements.

Reasonable care has been taken during the design phase to determine the location of underground utilities, including research of information from the local utility providers and communication with the utility owners. Given the uncertainties associated with doing undergrounding work, there is a potential for additional costs during construction to locate conflicting utilities via pot-holing and excavating and to make field construction changes as needed to avoid utilities. A contingency has been included in the construction budget, to be utilized only if deemed necessary by the Transportation Department, to cover the costs of resolving utility conflicts.

The traffic signal will improve traffic operation and pedestrian safety at the intersection. This project will also provide striping and signing improvements at the intersection, roadway widening, and drainage improvements.

Annual traffic signal operation and maintenance costs are estimated at \$5,500 for this location, which will be funded from gas tax.

Due to time constraints on this project caused by the failure of STI to timely submit contract documents, Hillcrest Contracting, Inc. will be requested to execute the contract and provide bonds and insurance documents after Board approval. The contractor is qualified.

AGREEMENT

THIS AGREEMENT is entered into at Riverside, California as of the date set forth below is between County of Riverside hereafter called "County" and **HILLCREST CONTRACTING, INC.** hereafter called "Contractor".

WITNESSETH

RECITALS:

1. Contractor has submitted to County his Contractor's Proposal for the construction of County Project, **Harrison Street & 66th Avenue Street Improvements, Storm Drain & Traffic Signal Project, Coachella Valley Area, Project No. B2-0439**, in strict accordance with the Contract Documents identified below and County has accepted said Proposal.
2. Contractor states that he has reexamined his Contractor's Proposal and found it to be correct, has ascertained that his subcontractors are properly licensed and possess the requisite skill and forces, has reexamined the site and Contract Documents and is of the opinion that he can presently do the work in accordance with the Contract Documents for the money set forth in his Proposal to be paid as provided in the Contract Documents.

AGREEMENT:

IT IS AGREED BY THE PARTIES AS FOLLOWS:

1. Contract Documents. The entire contract consists of the following: (a) The Agreement. (b) The Notice Inviting Bids. (c) The Instruction to Bidders. (d) The Contractor's Proposal. (e) The Bid Bond. (f) The Payment Bond. (g) The Performance Bond. (h) The General Conditions. (i) The Special Provisions. (j) The Standard Specifications of the State of California Department of Transportation edition of May 2006 as modified in other portions of the Contract Documents. (k) The Standard Plans of the Department of Transportation identified on the plans or in the Special Provisions. (l) The Plans. (m) Addenda No. **(None)**. (n) The Determination of Prevailing Wage Rates for Public Work. (o) Any Change Orders issued. (p) Any additional or supplemental specifications, notice, instructions and drawings issued in accordance with the provisions of the Contract Documents. All of said Documents presently in existence are by this reference incorporated herein with like effect as if here set forth in full and upon the proper issuance of other documents they shall likewise be deemed incorporated. The Bid Bond is exonerated upon execution of this Agreement and the Payment Bond and Faithful Performance Bond.
2. The Work. Contractor shall do all things necessary to construct the work generally described in Recital No. 1 in accordance with the Contract Documents.

3. Liquidated Damages and Time of Completion. Attention is directed to the provisions in Section 8-1.06, "Time of Completion", and in Section 8-1.07, "Liquidated Damages", of the Standard Specifications and these Special Provisions.

The Contractor shall begin work within 15 days of the date stated within the written "Notice to Proceed".

The Contractor shall notify the Engineer, in writing, of his intent to begin work at least 72 hours before work is begun. The notice shall be delivered to the Transportation Department's Construction Engineer and shall specify the date the Contractor intends to start. If the project has more than one location of work, a separate notice shall be given for each location.

Should the Contractor begin work in advance of receiving a written "Notice to Proceed", any work performed by him in advance of the date stated in the "Notice to Proceed" shall be considered as having been done by him at his own risk and as a volunteer and subject to the following:

- (1) The Contractor shall, on commencing operations, take all precautions required for public safety and shall observe all the provisions in the Specifications and the Special Provisions.
- (2) All work done according to the contract prior to the issuance of the "Notice to Proceed", will be considered authorized work and will be paid for as provided in the contract.
- (3) The Contractor shall not be entitled to any additional compensation or an extension of time for any delay, hindrance or interference caused by or attributable to commencement of work prior to the issuance of the "Notice to Proceed".

4. Compensation. Contractor shall be paid in the manner set forth in the Contract Documents the amount of his Proposal as accepted by County, the above rates, subject to additions and deductions as provided in the Contract Documents. Said Proposal is on file in the Office of the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors of County.

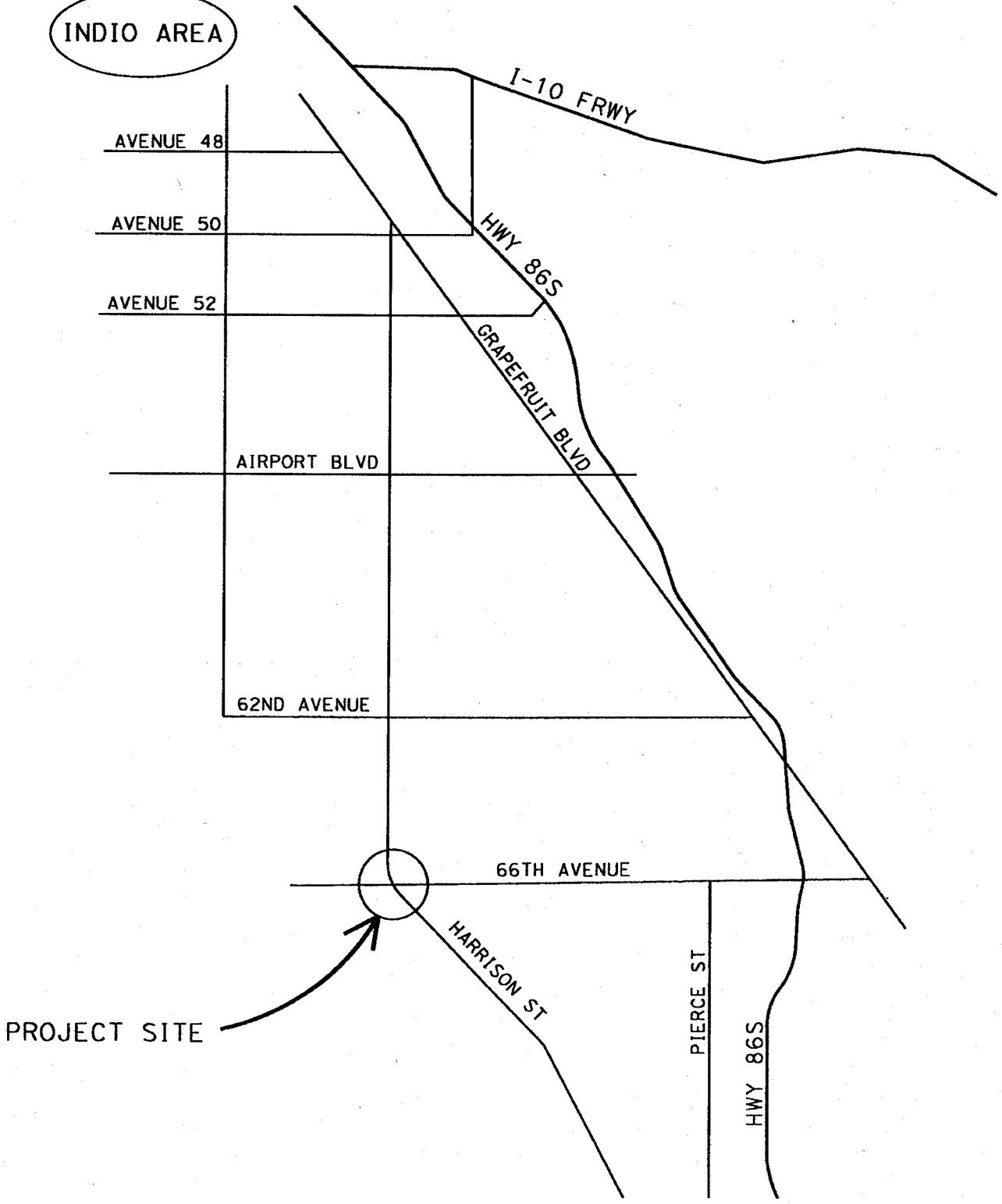

STI, Inc. of Riverside, CA was considered the apparent low bidder; however, the Transportation Department has rescinded the 'Notice of Acceptance of Proposal and Intent to Award' since STI, Inc has failed to submit Contract Documents within the prescribed period of time. The Department will accept and award the contract to the next responsive low bid.

Hillcrest Contracting, Inc of Corona, CA is the 2nd low bidder; their bid is not within the target price range, and is \$132,877 or 15.2% above the Engineer's Estimate.

Hillcrest has previously worked for the County on public work projects. There has been no 'debarment' found for Hillcrest Contracting, nor for the subcontractors listed on their proposal.

Hillcrest Contracting proposal has a combination of bid items above and below Engineer's Estimate. In comparison with Engineers Estimate, Hillcrest bid the following two items significantly ABOVE the engineer's estimate: Item 8- ROADWAY EXCAVATION and Item 11- HOT MIX ASPHALT.
