

BACKGROUND: In 1996, CAP Riverside established the RCMC, a countywide partnership of over 50 mentor programs that assists, supports, and encourages safe, positive mentor-protégé relationships by recruiting volunteers, providing referrals to families and technical assistance to mentors and mentor-trainers. Since 1996, RCMC has been a member of the California Governor's Mentoring Partnership.
