BACKGROUND: The Riverside County Anti-Terrorism Approval Authority (ATTA) has recommended funding a Sheriff's Department project request submitted in response to the Riverside County Operational Area 2011 Homeland Security Grant Program. The ATTA has allocated to the Sheriff's Department \$490,000 for the project. The Department is now required to submit a grant application to the California Emergency Management Agency (Cal-EMA).
