Now that these vehicles have all been delivered, the Sheriff's Department needs to store them indoors, in a secure location, to preserve their serviceability and the County's investment through FY 13/14. To that end, the Department had asked County Facilities Management Real Estate Division/EDA to search for leased warehouse space to store and protect these vehicles until they are used as replacements. No County owned warehouse space is available. County Fleet has a limited number of suitable parking spaces.

The Sheriff's Department has the following space requirements for the leased storage:

Indoor parking space of 60,000 square feet for the first year; 40,000 square feet at the beginning of the second year and decreasing to 20,000 square feet at the end of year two. A two-year lease with an option for an additional six months (30 month lease) would be appropriate to meet our storage needs.

Sheriff's staff has determined that it will have adequate funds for this leased space for the remainder of FY 2011-12 due to savings of the County Fleet Administrative Fees which are not being collected for the vehicles in storage and from lower than budgeted vehicle lease payments. County Fleet secured a lower interest rate for the 359 Crown Vics than expected, which resulted in a \$40 per month per vehicle savings.

Sheriff's staff has already located two separate locations that will work within its budget. One location is in the city of Perris, the other in Mira Loma. Both landlords are willing to reduce the lease cost as the Sheriff's space need decreases, as described above.
