AN ORDINANCE OF THE COUNTY OF RIVERSIDE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 654 RELATING TO THE FEE SCHEDULE FOR SERVICES RENDERED BY THE OFFICE OF THE TREASURER-TAX COLLECTOR

The Board of Supervisors of the County of Riverside ordains as follows:

Section 1. Ordinance No. 654 is amended in its entirety to read as follows:

"ORDINANCE NO. 654

AN ORDINANCE OF THE COUNTY OF RIVERSIDE ESTABLISHING A FEE SCHEDULE FOR SERVICES RENDERED BY THE OFFICE OF THE TREASURER-TAX COLLECTOR

The Board of Supervisors of the County of Riverside ordains as follows:

<u>Section 1</u>. PURPOSE. The purpose of this ordinance is to establish a schedule of fees, otherwise authorized by law, in the amount reasonably necessary to recover the cost incurred by the County Treasurer-Tax Collector on behalf of the County in providing the products or services enumerated herein.

<u>Section 2</u>. AUTHORITY. The fees established herein are authorized by Government Code Sections 6157, 5077(b), 54985, 54986, 66010 et seq., 66016, and 66451.2, and Revenue and Taxation Code Sections 162, 2188.8(g), 2509.1, 2511.1, 2706, 2922, 3698.5, 3704.7, 4807, 4112, 4217, 4672.1, 4672.2, 4674, 4837.5 and 5832.
